In October 2016, both registered full-time employment and part-time employment as a primary job increased by 5.0 per cent when compared to the corresponding month of the previous year.

## Gainfully Occupied Population: October 2016

Administrative data provided by Jobsplus show that, over a period of one year, the labour supply (excluding part-timers, see methodological note 5) increased by 3.9 per cent, reaching 186,336. This was mainly attributed to an increase in the full-time gainfully occupied population (8,773) and a drop in registered unemployment (1,750) (Table 1).

### Registered full-time employment

In October 2016, Arts, entertainment and recreation (NACE 90-93, +1,704) and Administrative and support service activities (NACE 77-82, +1,378) contributed mostly to the increase in employment, compared to October 2015 (Table 1). Registered full-time employment in the private sector went up by 8,155 persons to 138,001. Public sector full-time employment increased by 618 persons to 45,169 (Table 2).

The number of persons registered as full-time self-employed rose by 457 when compared to October 2015, while the number of persons registered as employees increased by 8,316 persons. Full-time employment for males and females went up by nearly 4.0 per cent and 6.9 per cent respectively over 2015 levels (Table 2).

### Registered part-time employment

Registered part-time employment in October 2016 went up by 5.2 per cent when compared to a year earlier. The sectors that contributed most to the overall increase were Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles (Nace 45-47, +736 persons), Transportation and storage (Nace 49-53, +364 persons) and Professional, scientific and technical activities (Nace 69-75, +332 persons) (Table 3).

The number of part-timers who also held a full-time job amounted to 24,311 up by 5.6 per cent (+1,281 persons) when compared to the corresponding month in 2015. Employed persons whose part-time job was their primary occupation totalled 35,373 up by 5.0 per cent (+1,690 persons) when compared to 2015 (Table 4) ■

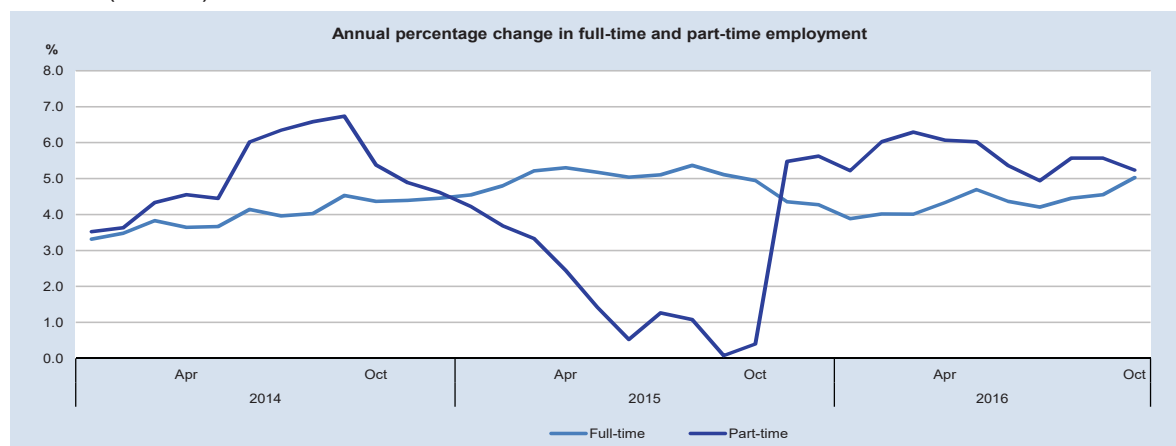

## Methodological Notes

1. The data provided in this release, including the relevant classifications, is based on administrative records held at the JobsPlus. The information contained in this release may be subject to revision. Monthly data is revised in the subsequent year.
2. The National Statistics Office publishes, on a quarterly basis, another set of statistics on employment and unemployment based on the Labour Force Survey (LFS). When compiling LFS statistics, the NSO adopts the International Labour Organisation (ILO) definition, an internationally agreed definition on employment and unemployment. This definition has also been adopted by Eurostat and is used by all EU Member States. More details regarding the methodology used for the compilation of employment and unemployment statistics from the LFS may be found in quarterly LFS news releases.

Since JobsPlus records and LFS results measure two different facets of employment and unemployment, these are not comparable. Users are therefore cautioned that these two sets of statistics should not be used interchangeably.

3. Full-time and part-time status is determined by the employer's declaration (or that made by a self-employed person) in the engagement form which is required to be sent to JobsPlus upon commencement of employment.
4. Apprentices are included under their respective economic activity.

### 5. Definitions:

- **Labour Supply:** Full-time gainfully occupied population and the registered unemployed population.
- **Apprentices, trainees and students:** Includes apprentices, trainees, Junior College and University students in the summer work-phase, undergraduate trainees, and trainees with fixed contracts.
- **Regional employment:** Data on Malta/Gozo employment differs on the basis of economic sector. Accordingly, the data on private sector employment depends on employee residence, whereas data for public sector depends on employer information on the location of its employees.
- **Full-time equivalent (FTE):** Employment in full-time equivalent is a conversion method used to measure the number of employees according to the number of hours worked. When using FTE a full-time employee working a 40 hour week is equivalent to 1.0, whereas a person who works 20 hours per week is equivalent to 0.5. Table 2 of this release includes persons who work full-time, persons on a full-time with reduced hours basis and full-time employees who are on unpaid leave. When converting these figures into FTE, full-time employees are considered as 1 whereas persons working full-time with reduced hours or who are on unpaid leave are considered according to the hours worked. FTE data is currently available in respect of public sector employment and is based on the administrative records of the People and Standards Division within the Office of the Prime Minister. FTE information for the private sector is not available.

FTE data are not being published in this release. FTE for October 2016 will be made available in the next Gainfully Occupied Population release.

- **Part 1 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 1 are either new job seekers who have left school, re-entrants into the labour market, or individuals who have been made redundant by their former employer.
  - **Part 2 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 2 are either workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work out of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities or were struck off the register after an inspection by the Law Enforcement personnel.
6. In 2015 JobsPlus adopted a revision in the economic activity classification of government entities, departments and ministries in collaboration with the People and Standards Division (OPM). This implies that from January 2015 the economic activity of public sector entities and units is assigned according to the true activity of the unit and not according to the economic activity of the Ministry under which each unit is attached.
  7. During the course of 2014 persons working with the public transport operator were shifted from the private sector to the public sector. Prior to 2014 and as from January 2015, these persons were considered to be part of the private sector.
  8. Public sector employees working in the economic activity: electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (NACE 35) have been reclassified to employment activities (NACE 78). In view of this reclassification, there was a shift in employment figures from the economic activity aggregate 'electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply' to the 'administrative and support service activities' aggregate. In line with other releases published by this Office, this reclassification was taken on board from August 2014 onwards.
  9. With regard to employment in the public sector, users are strongly advised to take into account the shifts referred to in methodological notes 6, 7 and 8 when analysing data longitudinally.
