Post of Information Security Manager with the National Statistics Office

Nomenclatures denoting the male gender include also the female gender.

The Chairman of the Malta Statistics Authority invites applications from interested candidates to apply for the vacant post of Information Security Manager within the National Statistics Office. The Malta Statistics Office is the regulatory body supervising official statistics in Malta. The National Statistics Office is the Executive Arm of the Malta Statistics Authority.

1. Terms and Conditions

1.1 This appointment is for a definite period of three years and subject to a probationary period of one (1) year.

1.2 The Malta Statistics Authority reserves the right to grant the incumbent an indefinite contract following the three-year period subject to a positive review by the Director General of the NSO.

1.3 The remuneration package for the post of Manager at the National Statistics Office is subject to the Collective agreement in force.

1.4 A manager at the National Statistics Office shall benefit from a gross salary of €39,133, an annual performance bonus which may range from 0-15 per cent, a communication allowance, an expense allowance, and health insurance policy.

1.5 The result of the interview will be valid for a period of one (1) year from the date of publication.

2. Duties

2.1 The post of Manager Information Security is a middle management post within the organisational hierarchy. The prospective employee shall report directly to the Director for Data Capability.

2.2 Information Security Governance ensures that all the structures, processes, roles and responsibilities related to information security are defined and aligned with NSO's objectives.

2.3 Further information about the role of the Information Security Manager is detailed in the job description and can be obtained from the Malta Statistics Authority.

3. Eligibility Requirements

3.1 The candidate must have:

- (i) An honours degree from a recognised university equivalent to Malta Qualification Framework (MQF) level 6 or above: in Computer Science, Information Technology, or any related field of study;
- (ii) A proven experience of at least three (3) years in an Information Security role or an IT-related field; and
- (iii) Sound knowledge of ISO 27001 and other related international standards.

3.2 In addition to the qualification and work experience stated hereabove the candidate must also demonstrate the following personal qualities:

- (i) Working knowledge and experience in the policy and regulatory environment of information security.
- (ii) Strong subject matter experience in applying security, vulnerability testing and development of a risk appetite.
- (iii) Able to work independently or with limited supervision as well as within a team in a multi-skilled working environment;
- (iv) Excellent presentation, communication and writing skills; and
- (v) Excellent influencing and problem-solving skills.

4. Procedures

4.1 Eligible applicants will be assessed by a selection board to determine their suitability for the post. The maximum mark for this selection process is 100% and the pass mark is 50%.

5. Other Regulations

5.1 Applications are to reach the Malta Statistics Authority Secretariat by no later than the 13th May, 2022. Late applications will not be accepted.

5.2 Prospective applicants should note that the selection board may request candidates to produce MQRIC recognition statements in respect of their qualifications from MQRIC, or other designated authorities, as applicable.

5.3 All applicants should produce a clean Police Conduct, issued by the respective authority no earlier than six months from the publication of this call.

5.4 Soliciting/Canvassing will lead to automatic disqualification.

6. Submission of Applications and documentation

6.1 Applicants are to address their application to The Chairman, Malta Statistics Authority by the 13th May, 2022 by noon Central European Time, on the following email address: msa@gov.mt

6.2 Applications received after closing date and time (i.e. late applications) will not be considered.

6.3 Acknowledgment of applications will be issued within reasonable time following receipt. However, it is the responsibility of the candidate to confirm that his or her application has been received by the Malta Statistics Secretariat.

6.4 Interested candidates are requested to submit:

- (i) A letter of application;
- (ii) A detailed curriculum vitae inclusive of three references;
- (iii) Scanned copies of qualification certificates (originals will be required at interviewing stage);
- (iv) A clean Police Conduct; and
- (v) Other supporting documents that candidates deem pertinent in support of their application.
