(Extract from the Malta Constitution Letters Patent, 1936.)

7. There shall be an Executive Council for Malta, and the said Council shall consist of such persons as We shall direct by Instructions under Our Sign Manual and Signet, or through one of Our Principal Secretaries of State and all such persons shall hold their places in the Executive Council during Our Pleasure and subject thereto for such period and upon such conditions as may be specified in any such Instructions.

(Extract from the Royal Instructions accompanying the Malta Constitution Letters Patent, 1936.)

4. The Executive Council of Malta shall consist of the persons for the time being lawfully discharging the functions of the respective offices of Lieutenant-Governor, of Legal Secretary, of Attorney General, of Treasurer and of Secretary to Government, who shall be styled *ex-officio* Members of the Executive Council, and of such other persons, not less than three in number at any one time, (hereinafter referred to as "Nominated Members") as the Governor, in pursuance of Instructions from Us through one of Our Principal Secretaries of State, may from time to time appoint.
