

### NOTES ON THE COMPLETION OF THE SUPPLEMENTARY DECLARATION

Separate forms must be used for ARRIVALS (VAT/AS/101/2004) and DISPATCHES (VAT/DS/102/2004). Supplementary Declaration sheets are available at the VAT and Customs Department.

<b>Period (mm/yy)</b>	The period is the month and year to which the supplementary declaration refers, e.g. 01/04 for January 2004.
<b>No. of Lines</b>	Show the number of lines of data entered on each supplementary declaration including those on the continuation sheet/s if any.
<b>Sheet No. (Continuation Sheet)</b>	Show the order of the sheets i.e. 02.03 for continuation sheet two of a total of three sheets.
<b>Trader</b>	Enter your VAT number here.
<b>Agent</b>	This field should only be completed if an agent is completing the supplementary declaration on behalf of a trader, thus entering his VAT number.
<b>Commodity Code</b>	Goods must be classified according to the Combined Nomenclature (CN), using the appropriate CN code.
<b>Trade Licence No.</b>	Enter your trading licence number here if available.
<b>Country of Origin/Consignment/Destination</b>	See Table 3.
<b>Nature of Transaction</b>	See Table 1.
<b>Mode of Transport</b>	Sea transport = 1, Air transport = 4, Consignments by post = 5. Fixed Transport Installations = 7. Own propulsion = 9.
<b>Terms of Delivery</b>	See Table 2.
<b>Invoice Value</b>	Show the amount as per invoice in euro currency rounded up to the nearest euro(Exclusive of VAT). Do not include the (€) symbol.
<b>Statistical Value</b>	As above. This amount should include invoice value inclusive of freight and insurance if any(Exclusive of VAT).
<b>Net Mass</b>	This amount refers to the net weight in <b>kilograms</b> for the respective commodity code. If not available please give estimate. <b>Show rounded up numbers only.</b>
<b>Supplementary Quantity</b>	Complete this box for each commodity code as indicated in the Combined Nomenclature list.
<b>Supplementary Unit Type</b>	Use this box to define the supplementary quantity (For example litre, number of pairs, square metre, gram, number of items, etc.).
<b>Transport Document I.D.</b>	This number must be entered here for each consignment.
<b>Airway Bill/Bill of Lading No.</b>	The airway bill or bill of lading number in respect of each consignment must be entered here.
<b>Supplier's/Consignee's VAT Identification No.</b>	Insert your Supplier's or Consignee's VAT identification No. Here.
