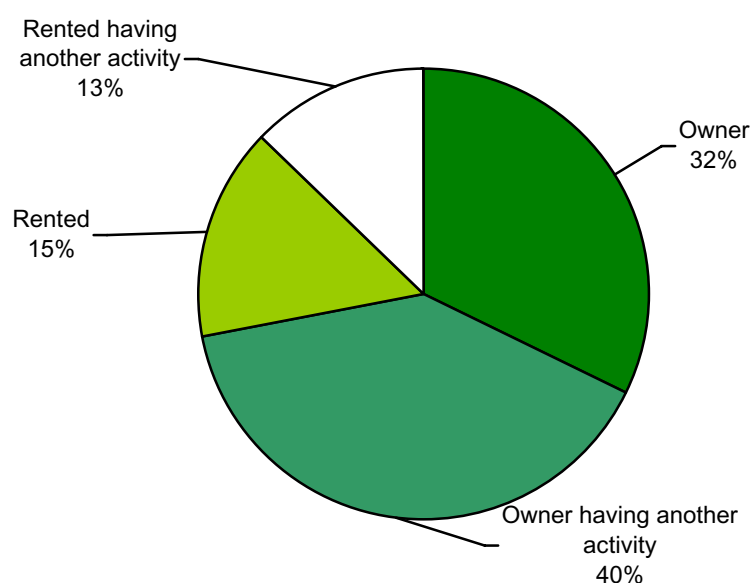

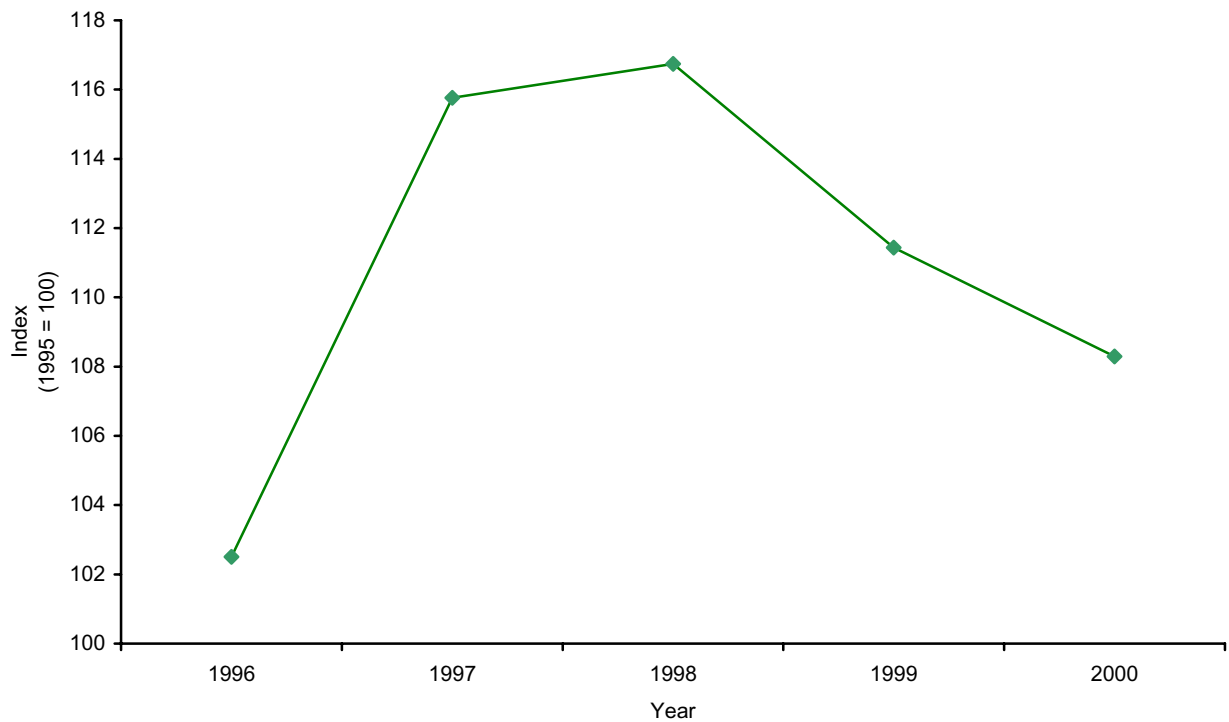

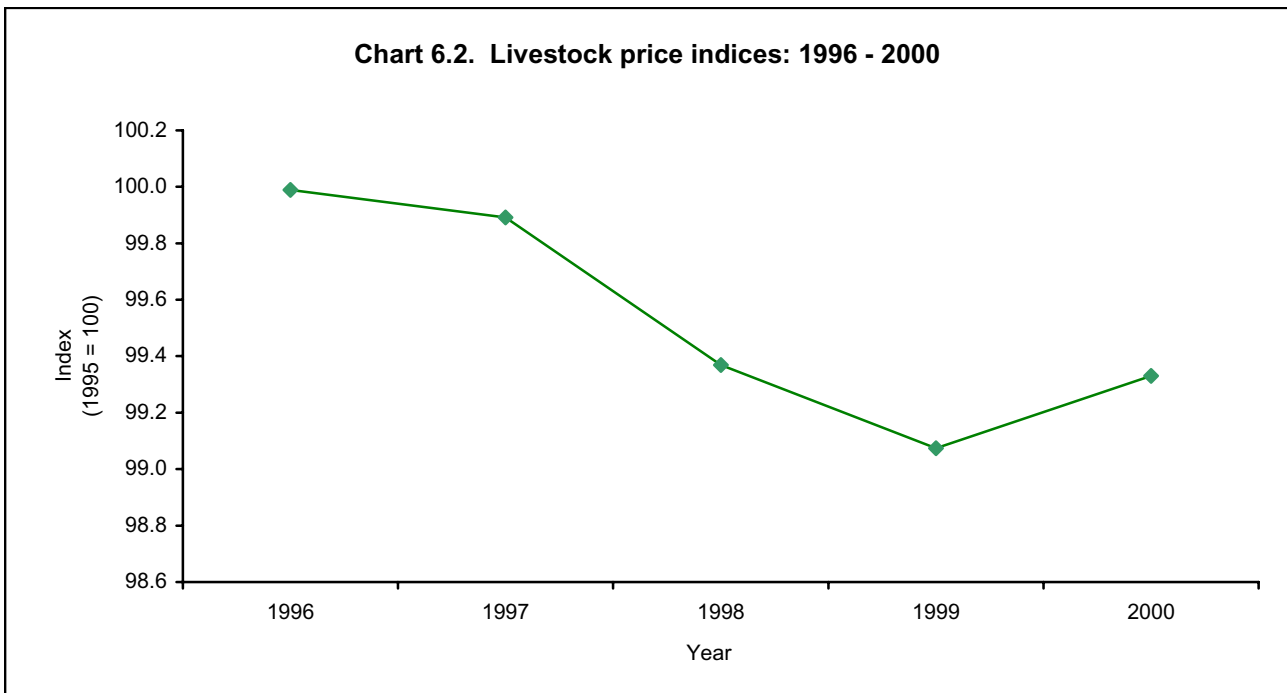
Chart 6.1. Slaughtering volume indices: 1996 - 2000

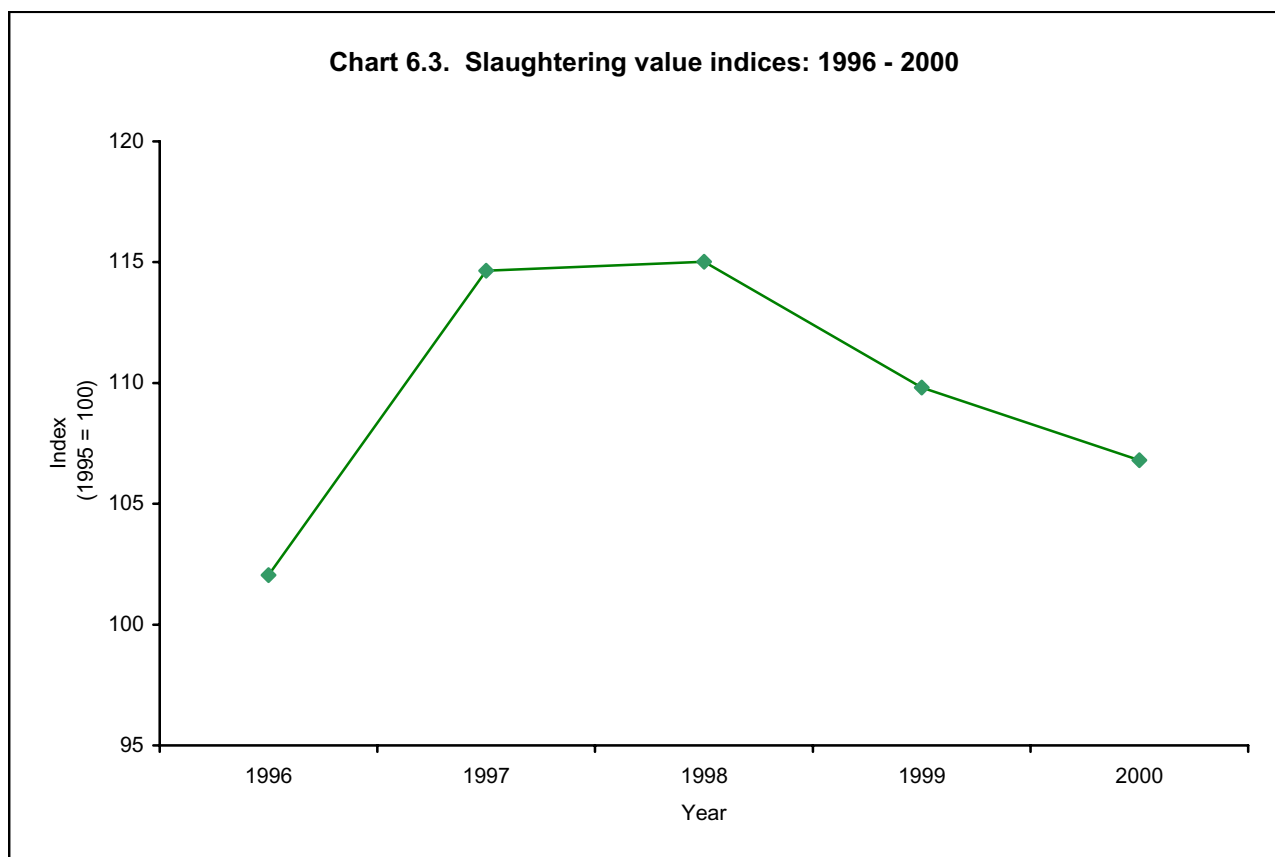

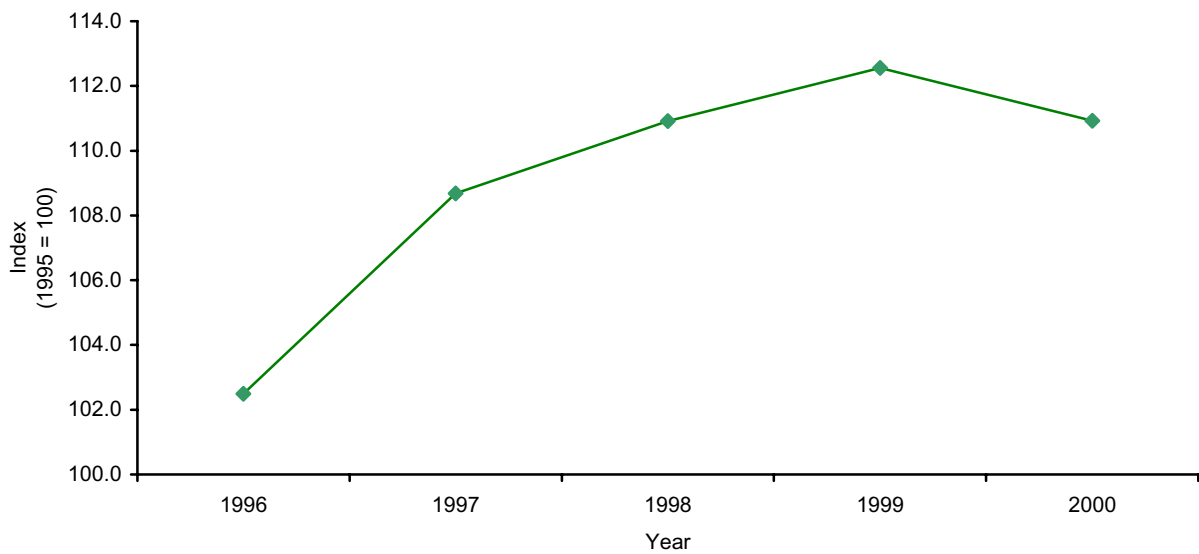
Chart 6.3. Slaughtering value indices: 1996 - 2000

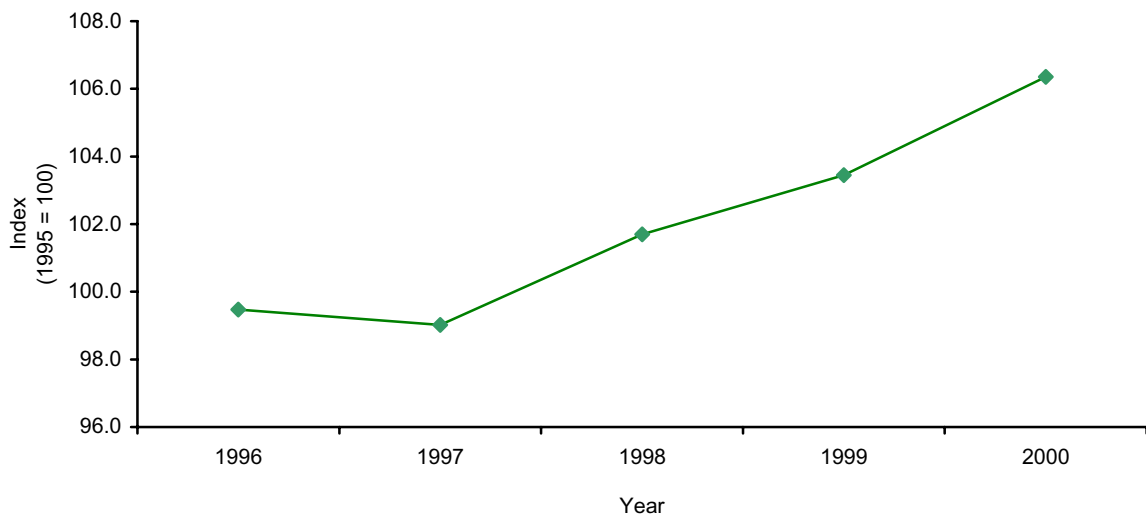
Chart 6.4. Milk volume index: 1996 - 2000

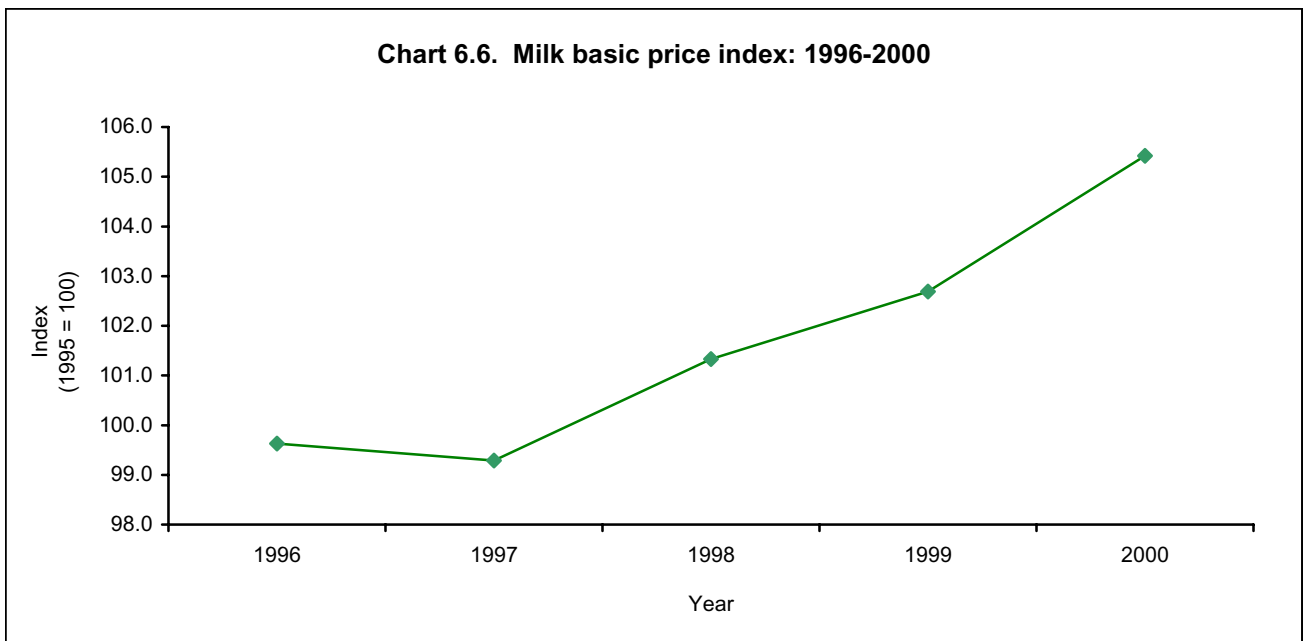

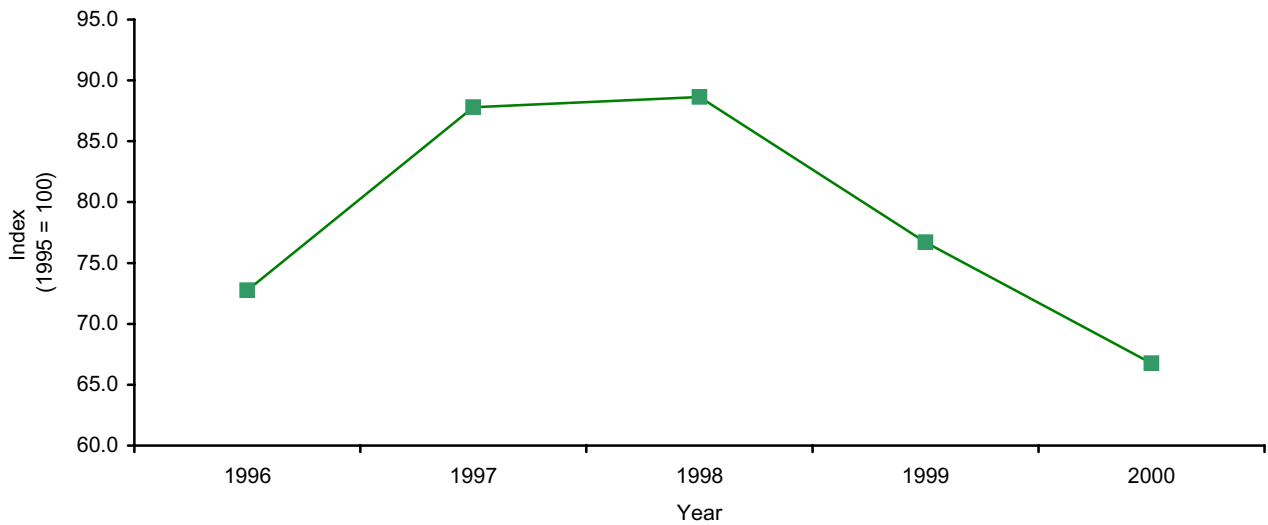

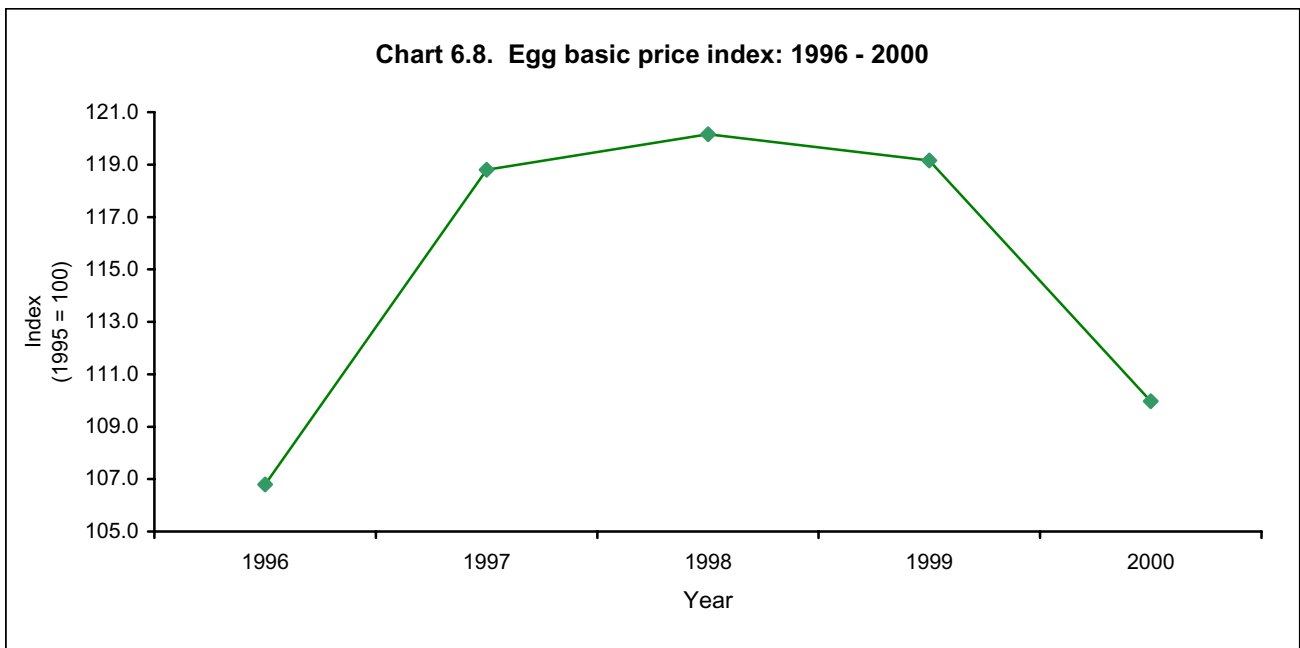

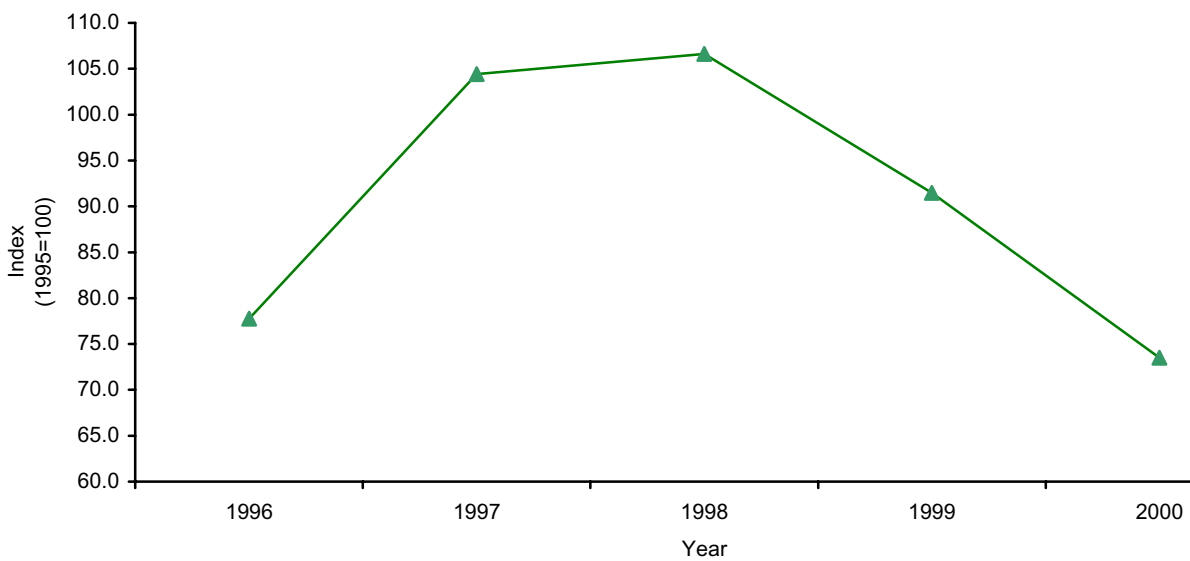
