## Commentary

### Population

The total population of Malta at the end of 2007, estimated using the 2005 Population and Housing Census figures as basis, stood at 410,290 – an increase of nearly 2,500 persons when compared to the previous year. Females accounted for 50.3 per cent of the total population. The number of residents having a Maltese citizenship amounted to 394,830 persons, equivalent to nearly 96.2 per cent of the total population.

Population increase results mainly from natural increase, which is the difference between births and deaths, and net migration. Net migration, constituted by the net difference between immigration and emigration, accounted for 82.9 per cent of the increase in total population. Almost 64 per cent of the total population increase was attributed to an increase in foreign residents in Malta.

The resulting population density in Malta went up to 1,298 persons per square kilometer – an increase of 7 persons per square kilometer when compared to that estimated during the previous year.

### Population projections

Revised population projections based on the 2007 population figures demonstrate an increasing trend in the total population of up to a maximum of just over 424,000 persons in 2025 (an increase of 3.3 per cent when compared to the total in 2007). The total population is projected to drop to 400,763 in 2050; 2.4 per cent decrease over the next 43 years.

Chart 1. Population pyramid: 2007

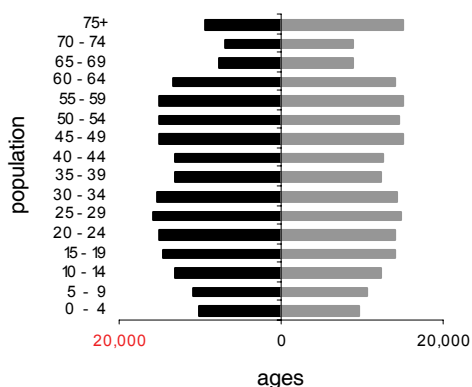


Chart 2. Population Pyramid: 2015

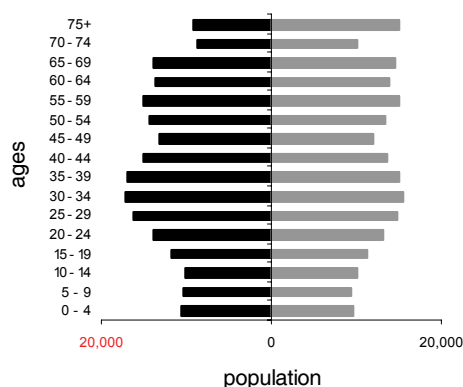


Chart 3. Population pyramid: 2050

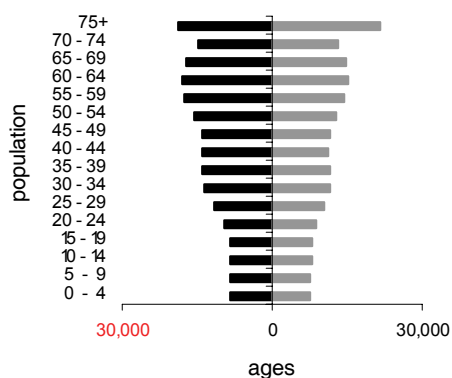
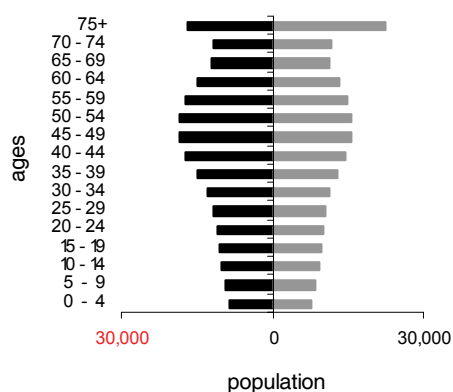


Chart 4. Population Pyramid: 2035

Projections also indicate a continuous decreasing proportion of females with respect to males in the total population. In fact, the percentage of women in the total population is expected to drop by 3.2 per cent by 2050. This trend may be explained as being due to an increase in the life expectancy of males and a higher proportion of male immigrants with respect to female immigrants.

These projections also show a continuously ageing population during the next years. In fact, the percentage of persons aged 65 years and over is expected to increase from 13.8 per cent, as estimated during 2007, to 25.0 per cent in 2050. This may be attributed to an increasing life expectancy which is noticeable in both males and females. The percentage of persons aged between 20 and 59 is expected to decrease from 56.2 per cent in 2007 to 50.6 per cent in 2050.

## **Fertility**

The total number of live births that were registered during 2007 amounted to 3,871. This figure includes all births to Maltese and foreign parents excluding tourists. In fact, 91.0 per cent of these babies were registered by Maltese parents (refer to annex for more exact definitions). 52.6 per cent of the total number of babies born were boys.

Comparisons with 2006 reveal a slight drop of 14 births. This slight decrease has reflected in a marginal drop in the total fertility rate; from the 1.41 during 2006, to 1.37 for the year under review.

The crude birth rate also fell to 1.46 during 2007 – a drop of 0.10 from 2006. It is also interesting to note that during the last decade, the total number of births in Malta fell by 19.2 per cent, whilst those in Gozo dropped by 33.6 per cent. The highest crude birth rate registered in Malta during 2007 was within the South Eastern district at 10.62, whilst the lowest was that of Gozo at 8.31.

During 2007, there were 40 mothers who gave birth to twins. There was also one case of triplets and another of quadruplets. All these 87 babies were born alive.

Out of all maternities, 51.2 per cent of the mothers were expecting a child for the first time in their lives, whilst 33.6 per cent were going through their second maternity. Mothers expecting to give birth for the sixth time amounted to 27 during the year under review. The majority of these maternities (37 per cent) were in the 30-34 year old bracket.

From all the registered live births, 33.6 per cent of the mothers were aged between 25 to 29 years, whilst 30.7 per cent were between 30 and 34 years old. 32.2 per cent of the fathers were between 30 to 34 years old, whilst 24.5 per cent were aged between 25 to 29 years.

The total number of registered live births outside marriage has increased from 866 during 2006 to 964 during 2007 – an increase of more than 10 per cent when compared to last year. From all the births outside wedlock, 352 (36.5 per cent) were registered with unknown paternity. Moreover, 871 (90.0 per cent) of births outside marriage were of Maltese parents.

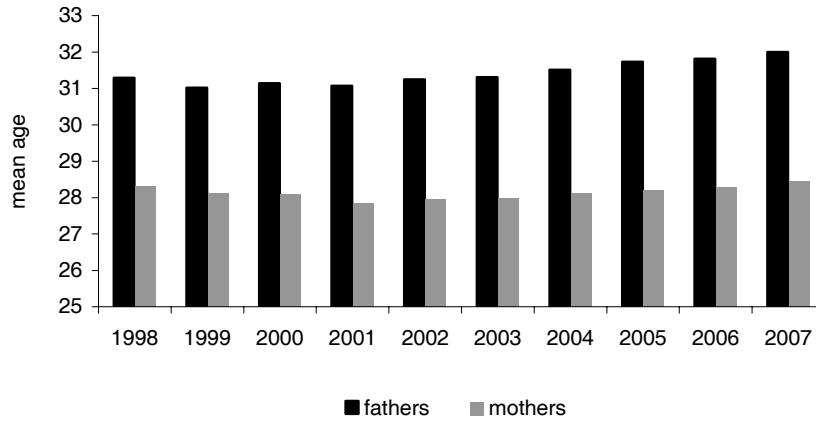
Births from mothers under the age of 20 numbered 239 during the year under review. From these 239 births, 213 (89 per cent) were births outside wedlock.

The majority of the mothers were either within the 25 to 29 year old or within the 30 to 34 year old categories. In fact, the number of births that fell under these age groups amounted to 33.6 per cent and 30.7 per cent respectively. 2.1 per cent of the mothers were 40 years or older.

Birth statistics also reveal that in general, the age of the fathers was higher than that of the mothers. As an example, the average age of mothers for the year under review was 28.5 years whilst that of fathers was 32.0 years.

From all the registered live births, 319 babies were born to foreign mothers. From these, 83 were EU citizens. 62 mothers were nationals of another European country, 105 were African citizens, whilst 50 mothers were Asian. The number of foreign fathers amounted to 424. From these, 101 had an EU citizenship whilst 135 were Africans.

**Deaths**

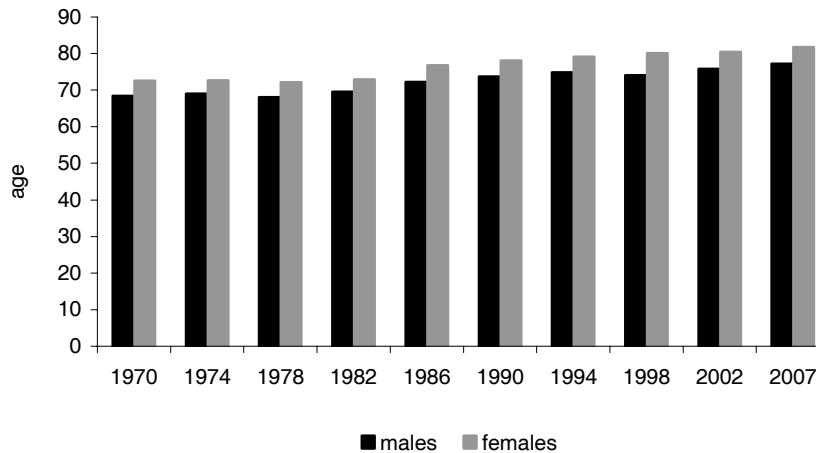
The total number of deaths that were registered during 2007 amounted to 3,111 – a decrease of 3.3 per cent with respect to last year. 51.8 per cent of the total number of deaths involved men.

The crude death rate has been constantly dropping since 2004, down to 7.6 for the year under review. The highest crude death rate was registered within the Southern Harbour region at 9.3, whilst the lowest rate reported in 2007 was 5.61 for the Northern District.

Diseases related to the circulatory system featured as the most common cause of death accounting for 40.7 per cent of the total. However this percentage decreased by 1.91 per cent from last year. Deaths caused by cancer have remained high, and amounted to nearly 27 per cent of the total number of deaths – an increase of nearly 2 per cent with respect to the past year. Deaths due to external causes have also increased marginally with respect to last year and amounted to 141 cases.

The life expectancy for both sexes has increased slightly with respect to the last year. In fact, the life expectancy at birth for males has increased from 76.8 years in 2006 to 77.2 years for the year under review, whilst that for females has increased from 81.2 years to 81.8 years.

**Chart 6. Life expectancy by sex: 1970-2007**

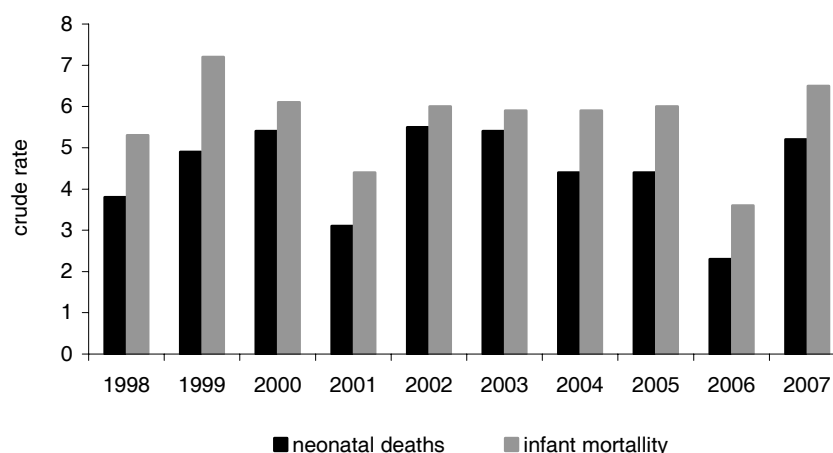




The number of infant deaths recorded during 2007 amounted to 25 – an increase of 11 deaths with respect to last year. The infant mortality rate for this year was estimated at 6.5. The number of infant deaths in the year under review has been the highest one recorded since 2000, when the number of infant deaths amounted to 26.

The number of neonatal deaths has also been one of the highest figures that were registered during the past decade. In fact, the year under review included 20 neonatal deaths – an increase of 11 deaths with respect to that registered during 2006.

**Chart 7. Crude rate of neonatal and infant deaths: 1998-2007**

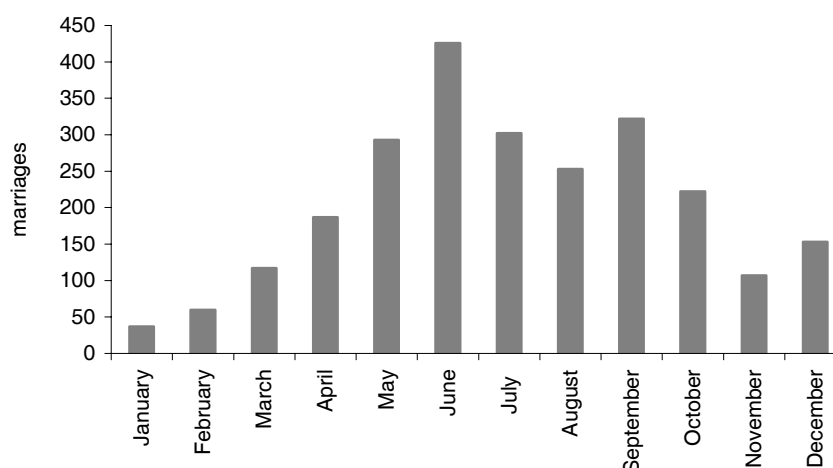


## Marriages

The total number of marriages that were registered in Malta, including those occurring between foreigners, amounted to 2,479. The crude marriage rate for 2007 was estimated at 6.10.

Total marriages have decreased by 2.3 per cent with respect to last year. The highest drop in marriages was recorded in Gozo, a decrease of 153 which implies a drop of nearly 17 per cent with respect to last year.

**Chart 8. Marriages by month: 2007**



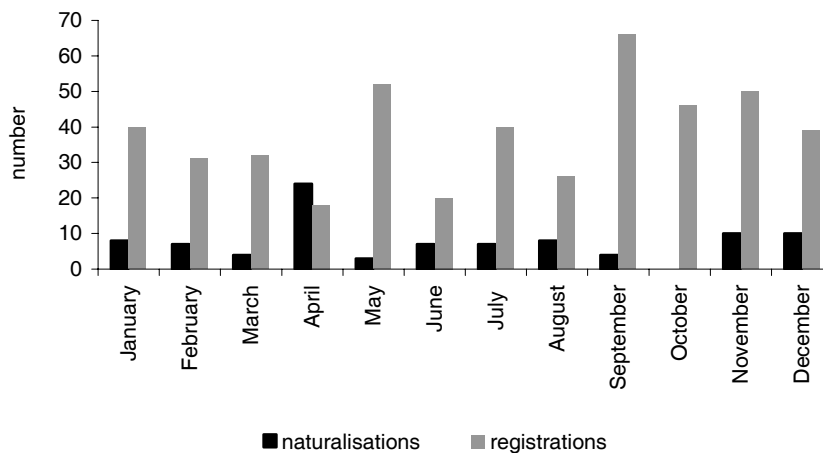
Nearly 35 per cent of all the marriages were civil marriages. The majority of these 867 marriages involved foreigners. In fact, only 14.1 per cent were marriages in which both the bride and groom were Maltese. 26.2 per cent had only one spouse with a Maltese citizenship. A noticeable fact was that out of all civil marriages, 42.6 per cent were between British spouses.

The selection of the months in which couples decide to celebrate their marriage in Malta has remained more or less the same as during the previous year. As an example, the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of the year remained the most popular time in the year for marriage celebrations. In fact, nearly 37 per cent of all marriages were celebrated between April and June. The third quarter of the year also had a significant share of the total number of marriages that occurred during 2007. In fact, the share of total marriages that occurred during the third quarter amounted to 35.3 per cent.

### Naturalisations & Registrations

During 2007, a total number of 460 foreigners obtained Maltese citizenship by registration. Nearly 65 per cent of these persons were aged between 24 and 49 years. Most of these registrations were given following a previous marriage to a Maltese citizen. During this year, another 92 foreigners obtained Maltese citizenship by naturalisation. 52.2 per cent of these individuals were less than 16 years old.

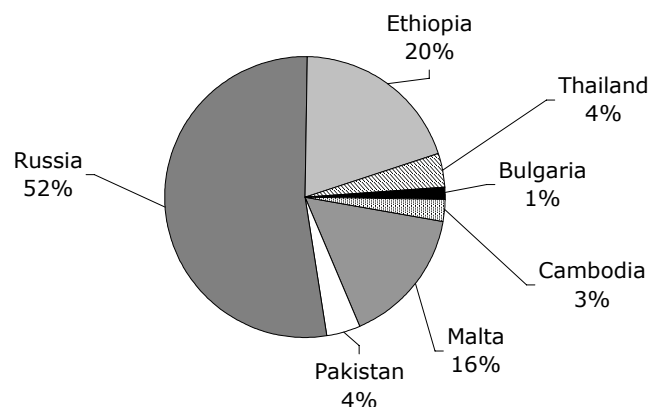
**Chart 9. Naturalisations & Registrations by month: 2007**



### Adoptions

During the year under review, 76 children have been adopted. 46.1 per cent of these children were boys, whilst 69.7 per cent had less than 10 years of age. 52.6 per cent of the children that were adopted were from Russia, with another 19.7 per cent coming from Ethiopia. Another 12 adoptions involved children who were born in Malta. In total, 461 children were adopted since 2000.

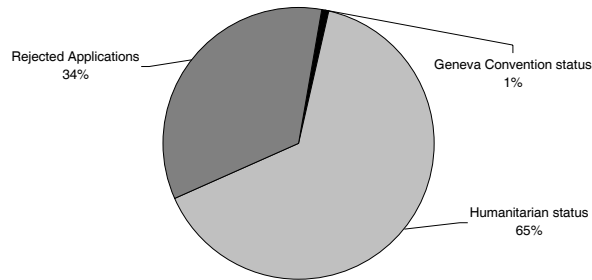
**Chart 10. Adoptions by country of origin of children: 2007**



## International Protection

During 2007, the Office of the Refugee Commission filed 1,379 applications for asylum. Nearly 25 per cent of these applications involved applicants who declared themselves as unaccompanied minors.

Out of these applications, 7 were granted the Geneva Convention status, whilst 620 were granted a Humanitarian status. Nearly 24 per cent of these applications were rejected.

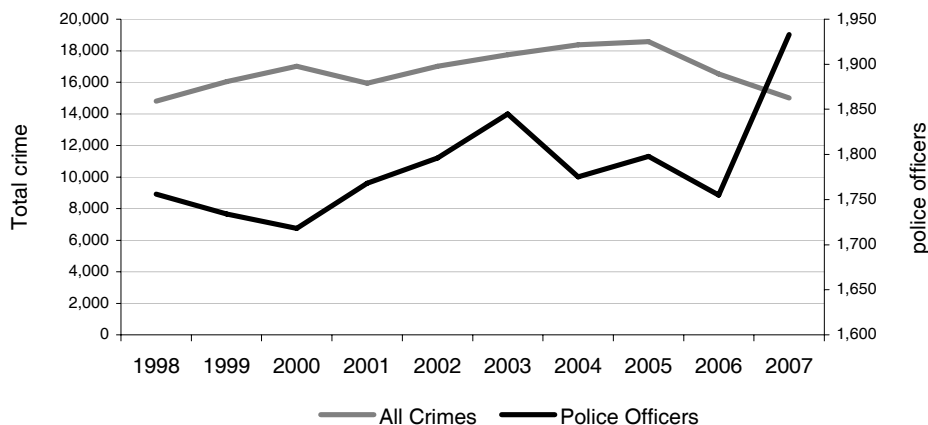
## Crime

Total reported crime has decreased from 16,527 during 2006 to 15,005 for the year under review – a decrease of 9.2 per cent.

Despite the decrease in the total number of crimes during the past three years, 2 particular categories of crimes have increased with respect 2006; namely violent crimes and drug trafficking. In fact, the number cases related to violent crimes amounted to 422 – an increase of 8.2 per cent with respect to the previous year, whilst those related to drug trafficking totalled 149 – an increase of 21.1 per cent with respect to the previous year.

Crimes that have decreased during the past year include robberies which have gone down to 200 from 222, domestic robberies went down to 735 from 856 and crimes involving motor vehicles which have gone down to 388 from 584.

The total number of police officers has increased by 178 to 1,933 during the year under review. The average prison population during 2007 amounted to 382 – an increase of 1.6 per cent with respect to 2006. The average prison population as calculated over the past decade amounts to 288.3 residents.

### **Seperations**

During 2007, the Public Registry filed 637 separation cases, of which 89.3 per cent were between Maltese spouses. There were 35 divorces obtained abroad and recognized by Maltese Authorities. 37.1 per cent of these divorces were granted in the United Kingdom. During this year, there were also 167 marriage annulments, out of which 79.6 per cent were civil annulments. 35.3 per cent of these annulments involved marriages that had lasted for a period of 5 to 9 years.

## Definitions & Methodological Notes

- **Total Population** figures include both Maltese and foreign residents. The total population at the end of year  $t$ , is computed using the following equation,

$$P_t = P_{t-1} + B_t - D_t + I_t - E_t, \text{ where}$$

- $P_t$  is the total population at the end of year  $t$ ,
  - $P_{t-1}$  is the total population at the end of year  $t-1$ ,
  - $B_t$  is the total number of births registered during year  $t$ ,
  - $D_t$  is the total number of deaths registered during year  $t$ ,
  - $I_t$  is the total immigration of both Maltese and foreign nationals registered during year  $t$ . This figure is measured by summing up the count of all new work permit and residence permit holders, together with their dependents, returned migrants and new adoptions of children from foreign countries.
  - $E_t$  is the total emigration of both Maltese and foreign nationals registered during year  $t$ . This figure is measured by summing up the counts of all work permit and residence permit holders who fail to extend their permits during the year under review, together with their dependents, and other Maltese emigrants (i.e. persons who leave the country for a period of at least 12 months).
- **Maltese population** figures include Maltese residents only. The Maltese population at the end of year  $t$ , is computed using the following equation,

$$P'_t = P'_{t-1} + B'_t - D'_t + I'_t - E'_t, \text{ where}$$

- $P'_t$  is the Maltese population at the end of year  $t$ ,
- $P'_{t-1}$  is the Maltese population at the end of year  $t-1$ ,
- $B'_t$  is the number of Maltese births registered during year  $t$ ,
- $D'_t$  is the number of deaths occurring to Maltese citizens during year  $t$ ,
- $I'_t$  is the total immigration of Maltese nationals registered during year  $t$ . This figure is measured by summing up the count of returned migrants, all registrations and new adoptions of children from foreign countries.
- $E'_t$  is the count of all Maltese residents who that leave Malta to settle in another country for a period of at least 12 months.

Some of the **migration** components mentioned above have been estimated using auxiliary data like data obtained from the 2005 Population and Housing Census and other register data.

- Maltese and total **mid-year populations** are calculated by averaging beginning and end-year population estimates.
- **Total live births** include all births registered in Malta from both Maltese and foreign parents. All still births are excluded. The **crude birth rate** is the number of total live births per thousand mid-year population.
- **Maltese live births** include all births registered on Malta having a Maltese father or a Maltese mother (in case the father has not been registered with the Public Authorities). The **Maltese crude birth rate** is the number of Maltese live births per thousand mid-year Maltese population.
- **Total fertility rate** is the estimated total number of life births occurring to an average woman during her fertility age (14 - 49).
- **Maternities** include both still and life births. Multiple births are counted as one maternity.
- **Maternity order** is the ranking of a newborn baby in relation to all the previous births (both still and life) of the mother; that is, the number of previous births (both still and life) plus the birth that has just occurred.
- **Still births** are deaths occurring to babies prior to the complete expulsion or extraction from its mother of a product of conception, after 22 weeks of gestation or weighing 500 grams and over.
- **Neonatal deaths** are deaths occurring within the first 28 days after birth.

- **Infant deaths** are deaths occurring during the first year of life. Infant mortality rate is the number of infant deaths per 1,000 life births.
- **Total deaths** include all registered Maltese and foreign deaths in Malta and Gozo. This count excludes tourists but includes Maltese who die abroad and who are then buried in Malta. Total deaths exclude still births. The **crude death rate** is the total number of deaths per thousand mid-year total population.
- **Maltese deaths** include all registered deaths of Maltese nationals in Malta and Gozo. This count includes also Maltese who die abroad and who are then buried in Malta. Still births are also excluded. The **Maltese crude death rate** is the number of Maltese deaths per thousand mid-year Maltese population.
- **Life expectancy at birth** is the number of years a newborn is expected to live if mortality in the various age-groups remains at the level of the period in which the expectation of life is computed.
- **Total marriages** include all marriages registered in Malta and Gozo. This count includes marriages between non-resident foreign spouses as well. The **crude marriage rate** relates the number of marriages per 1,000 total mid year population.
- **Civil marriages** include all non-religious marriages that are recognized by law in Malta
- Data on **separations** has been extracted from records held at the Public Registry of separations involving both Maltese and/or foreign spouses that have been concluded by a legal contract.
- Information on registered **annulments** of Religious and Civil Marriages between Maltese and/or foreign spouses is as according to records held at the Public Registry.
- **Divorces** obtained abroad of marriages involve both Maltese and foreign spouses. Information in this publication includes only those divorces that were accepted by the laws of Malta in terms of section 33 of the Marriage act, 1975 and are registered at the Public Registry.
- **Emigration** is the action by which a natural person leaves his or her usual residence in the territory of the Member State for a period that is or is expected to last a minimum of 12 months.
- **Immigration** is the action by which a natural person establishes his or her usual residence in a territory of a State for a period that is or is expected to last a minimum of 12 months.
- **Registration** is the action by which foreign residents register themselves as Maltese citizens at the Expatriates and Citizenship Division. Registered persons are included in the Maltese population count.
- **Naturalisation** is the action by which a foreigner may be granted a Maltese citizenship according to the Maltese Citizenship Act.
- **Asylum Statistics:**
  - A third country national or stateless person is granted the **Geneva Convention status** (also referred to as Refugee status) if, owing to a well founded fear of being prosecuted for reasons of race, religion, nationality, political opinion or membership of a particular social group, is outside the country of nationality and is unable or, owing to such fear, is unwilling to avail himself of the protection of that country.
  - Person eligible for **subsidiary protection** is a third country national or stateless person who does not qualify as a refugee but in respect of whom substantial grounds have been shown for believing that the person concerned, if returned to the country of former habitual residence, would face a real risk of suffering serious harm, or owing to such risk is unable to avail himself or herself of the protection of that country.
- **Crime:** Data on crime is classified according to the Classifications used by the Department of police, which are our data providers for crime.

## Classifications:

- Occupations are coded according to the International Standard Classification of Occupations (ISCO).
- Deaths by causes are classified according to the International Classification of Diseases (ICD).
- Localities are classified into districts according to the Malta Geographical Codes (MGC) as follows:
  - **Southern Harbour** - Żabbar, Xgħajra, Valletta, Tarxien, Santa Lucija, Paola, Marsa, Luqa, Kalkara, Senglea, Floriana, Fgura, Cospicua, Vittoriosa.
  - **Northern Harbour** - Ta' Xbiex, Swieqi, Sliema, Santa Venera, San Gwann, St. Julians, Qormi, Pietà', Pembroke, Msida, Ħamrun, Gżira, Birkirkara.
  - **South Eastern** - Żurrieq, Żejtun, Safi, Qrendi, Mqabba, Marsaxlokk, Marsaskala, Kirkop, Gudja, Ghaxaq, Birżebbuġia.
  - **Western** - Żebbuġ (Malta), Siġġiewi, Rabat (Malta), Mtarfa, Mdina, Lija, Iklin, Dingli, Balzan, Attard.
  - **Northern** - St. Paul's Bay, Naxxar, Mosta, Mgarr, Mellieħa, Gharghur.
  - **Gozo and Comino** - Rabat (Gozo), Fontana, Ghajnsielem and Comino, Għarb, Għasri, Kerċem, Munxar, Nadur, Qala, San Lawrenz, Sannat, Xagħra, Xewkija, Żebbuġ (Gozo).

## Other notes:

- As from 2003, there has been a change in the method in which birth and death statistics are compiled. Prior to 2003, figures on births and deaths referred to Maltese persons only. In 2003 definitions were changed to include total births and deaths. Past data has been revised to reflect the new definitions and to ensure that the time series are consistent. In the case of annual deaths data classified by ICD Chapters of causes, revisions were not necessary since these figures have always referred to the total number of deaths.
- The total maternities by age of mother in tables 16 and 17 are not comparable because the data has been extracted from different registers which might have some minor inconsistencies.
- During this year, the methodology by which the population projections are computed has been revised. This mainly justifies the inconsistencies of these projections when comparing with others published during previous years.
