
MILITARY EXPENDITURE.

Insert an Account of the Military Posts and Works ; specifying whether the same are under the controul of the Ordnance Department, and details of the Expense incurred on account thereof by the Colony.

A General Return of the Militia, and of any other Local Corps, with the charge attending the same.

The pecuniary Allowances (if any) granted to the King's Troops; and the value of Rations, Quarters, or other advantages received by them, and forming a Charge on the Colony.

It is desired that this may include a Statement of the particulars of Colonial Pay and Allowances actually received by Officers of the Staff and Army, together with the Names of such Officers, to which is to be added a Statement of the particulars of British Pay and Allowances received by them.

In those Colonies where Officers of the Staff and Army do not receive Colonial Pay or Allowances, it is desirable that a Statement should be furnished of the British Pay and Allowances attached to the several Military Ranks.
