To this fund the Students of Medicine Surgery and Anatomy do not contribute but pay 4/2 each Monthly to the respective Professors.</p> <p>These Schools were established 13 years ago, during which period there have been admitted 1405 males & 1077 females. The children generally are taught reading, writing & Arithmetic, the English and Italian Languages. The Females all sorts of needle works.</p> <p>In the Seminary the Pupils are divided into two Classes, the 1st called <i>Alumni</i>, pay £ 5 per Annum, & the 2^d called <i>Convictori</i>, pay £ 12. 10 per Annum. They as well as the Professors &c. live in and are fed by the Establishment. The Seminary, independent of the contributions by the Pupils has an Annual Revenue derived from Landed Property of about £ 310. —</p>
