The Government supports the University having appropriated to itself the whole of the said property.	—	The pay of the Rector Professors Masters &c. and incidental Expenses amounted in 1835 to £100.2.	—	The University was instituted by the Grand Master Pinto in 1771 under Statutes which have been modified from time to time. A new arrangement of the University and Lyceum was carried into effect from the 1 <sup>st</sup> January 1834. having been submitted to and approved of by His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for the affairs of the Colonies.
