1847 April 24 <sup>th</sup>	An Order of Her Majesty's in Council whereby, in pursuance of the powers vested in Her Majesty by the Act 6 and 7 Victoria Cap: 94 intitled "An Act to remove doubts" as to the exercise of power and jurisdiction by Her Majesty within divers countries and places out of Her Majesty's dominions, and to render the same more effectual" more extensive powers are conferred to Her Majesty's Consular Officers in the Dominions of the Sublime Ottoman Porte, for the repression and punishment of crimes committed by British Subjects within the said dominions, than were sanctioned by the Order in Council of the 19 <sup>th</sup> of June 1844.
