<p><i>N.B.</i></p> <p><i>Ordinances are laid in draft before the Council of Government, and if passed, they are submitted to the Governor who assents or dissents to them or reserves them for the signification of Her Majesty's pleasure.</i></p> <p><i>Ordinances are sent to the Secretary of State for confirmation by Her Majesty and when their confirmation is notified to the Governor they are promulgated and become law from the date of promulgation, but the Governor has power, when necessary, to promulgate Ordinances provisionally without reference to the Secretary of State.</i></p> <p><i>In the absence of the signification of Her Majesty's pleasure Ordinances cease to have effect after a lapse of two years from the date on which they are passed by the Council.</i></p>
