- a. Caused by expenses consequent on the prevalence of Cholera.
- b. Demises of Pensioners
- c. Difference between the sums paid to His Government as instalments for Harbour works.
- d. Partly expenses of Cholera, and partly expenses of Provisions, Medicines, Bedding & Clothing.
- e. Clothing & accoutrements for the Police, Provisions in barracks.
- f. The £ 100 to the omnibus company not being paid but revoted in 1866.
- g. Chiefly for the building of the new Opera House
- i. The hauling up slip in the new Harbour
- k. Chiefly refunds of Import Duty on articles of consumption by the Naval and Military Departments.
- l. The elections of members to serve in Council.
