2. Valletta	.. .. .	The War Department control extends over the whole of the Fortifications, ditches, and glacis, and over the military buildings, and over the spaces between the ramparts and the sea, though the latter have in some places been allowed to be used for civil purposes.
3. Floriana	.. .. .	The War Department control extends over the whole of the Fortifications with their outworks, ditches, covered way, and glacis, over the military buildings, and over the spaces between the sea and the foot of the ramparts, though the latter have been allowed to be used in some places for civil purposes.
4. Fort Ricasoli	.. .. .	} In the cases of all these Forts the control of the War Department extends over the whole of the Forts together with their ditches and glacis, and the spaces between the works and the sea. *
