| 276 | .. | For Men and Women effected with incurable disease. The building was formerly the Hospital for Women. |
| 139 | .. | For Orphans of both sexes between the age of 6 and 16. With but few exceptions, the children are orphans of both parents. The building was formerly the Hospital for Men. |
| 1,590 | .. | This Institution is for the reception of Male and Female patients, and contains 250 beds. |
| 796 | .. | For the reception of the aged and disabled poor of both sexes above the age of 60. |
| 28 | .. | Women who led a dissolute life, and can produce certificates from their spiritual advisers that they are anxious to repent, are allowed an asylum in this Institution. They work for their maintenance. |
| 23 | .. | This Institution receives Foundlings and Deserted Infants until nurses can be found for them in the country or become of age to be admitted into the Orphan Asylum. |
| 167 | .. | Enlarged in 1850, capable of containing 60 patients, 30 of each sex. |
| 438 | .. | Hospital for mental disorders. The building is situated at <i>Wied Incita</i> , between Notabile and Casal Attard. It was opened on the 16th of July 1861, on which day the Patients were transferred thereto from the Asylum at Floriana. |
| 276 | .. | For both sexes and capable of containing 60 patients, 30 of each sex. |
| 178 | .. | Can afford asylum to 172 aged and disabled poor, 86 of each sex, above 60 years of age. |
