The drains concentrate into one main sewer, which discharges itself into a cess-pit at a distance from the Asylum. The drain openings are properly trapped. The sewage is not yet utilized.

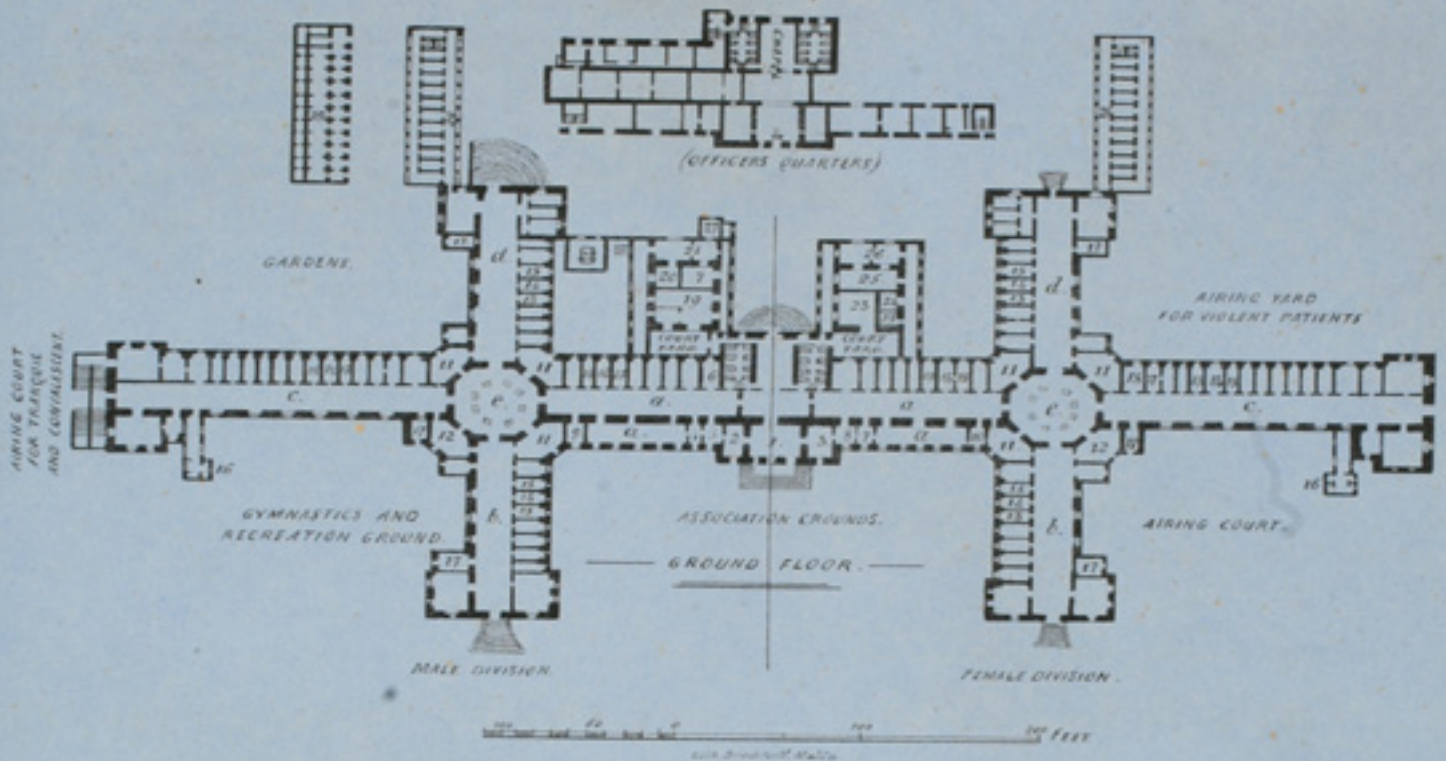
