No. of inmates in 1879	How supported	REMARKS
280	..	For Men and Women affected with incurable disease. The building was formerly the Hospital for Women.
140	..	For Orphans of both sexes between the age of 6 and 16. With but few exceptions, the children are orphans of both parents. The building was formerly the Hospital for Men.
2,127	..	This Institution is for the reception of Male and Female patients, and contains 250 beds.
841	..	For the reception of the aged and disabled poor, of both sexes, above the age of 60.
22	..	Women who led a dissolute life, and can produce certificates from their spiritual adviser that they are anxious to repent, are allowed an asylum in this Institution. They work for their maintenance.
33	..	This Institution receives Foundlings and Deserted Infants until nurses can be found for them in the country, or become of age to be admitted into the Orphan Asylum.
498	..	Enlarged in 1850, capable of containing 60 patients, 30 of each sex.
513	..	Hospital for mental disorders. The building is situated at <i>Wied Incita</i> , between <i>Notabile</i> and <i>Casal Attard</i> . It was opened on the 16th of July 1861, on which day the Patients were transferred thereto from the Asylum at <i>Floriana</i> .
313	..	For both sexes, and capable of containing 60 patients, 30 of each sex.
195	..	Can afford asylum to 172 aged and disabled poor, of each sex, above 60 years of age.
