Revenue, General Causes of Increases or Decreases, above £ 100.

A The difference is chiefly in Import duties on Wheat, Barley, Spirits, and Beer, and is attributable, as regards Wheat to the reduction in the Duty-paid stock, on account of high prices in the market, and as regards Barley to high prices, the market offering substitutes at cheaper rates. Spirits and Beer, having been relieved of last year's extraordinary consumption, have resumed their usual proportion.

B Increase attributable to the establishment of quarantine during the year.

C These receipts always vary according to circumstances.

Expenditure, General Causes of Increases or Decreases, above £ 100.

- A This difference is chiefly on savings of certain salaries.
- B This difference is chiefly attributable to the hire of Extra Health Guards.
- C The annual rate of pensions granted in 1879 amounted to £ 403 2 11; that of pensions lapsed in 1879 amounted to £ 1,111 15 10.  
From 1st April 1875 all military pensions ceased to be payable by the local Government.
- D This difference is chiefly on items for maintenance of distressed Maltese abroad.
- E This difference is spread over several items.
- F This difference is chiefly on items of general consumption.
- G These differences depend simply on the services undertaken and their cost. The sums revoted for 1880 are, Works and Buildings £ 3,786 5 11; Roads &c. £ 532 2 11.
- H This difference is chiefly attributable to expenses in connection with the proposed Maltese Emigration to Cyprus.
- I This difference is chiefly attributable to the payment of arrears of interest on ancient loans.
- K These services depend upon the special requirements of each year, and fluctuate accordingly.
- L The total Increase was £ 10,493 3 7.
