No. of Inmates in 1885	How supported	REMARKS
286	...	For Men and Women affected with incurable disease. The building was formerly the Hospital for Women.
127	...	For Orphans of both sexes between the age of 6 and 16. With but few exceptions, the children are orphans of both parents. The building was formerly the Hospital for Men.
1,998	... A page 7.	This Institution is for the reception of Male and Female patients, and contains 201 beds.
276	...	This Hospital, which was opened on the 20th March 1882, is adjoining the Central Hospital and contains 20 beds intended only for seamen who contribute 2s. per day each for their treatment therein. This small Institution is considered to be a self-supporting one.
803	...	For the reception of the aged and disabled poor, of both sexes, above the age of 60, with few exceptions.
13	...	Women who led a dissolute life and are anxious to repent are allowed an asylum in this Institution.
10	...	This Institution receives Foundling and Deserted Infants until nurses can be found for them in the country, or become of age to be admitted into the Orphan Asylum.
347	...	Enlarged in 1850, capable of containing 60 patients, 30 of each sex. This Hospital is partly used for convalescent patients from the Central Hospital.
572	...	Hospital for mental disorders. The building is situated at <i>Wied Incita</i> , between <i>Mdina</i> and <i>Attard</i> . It was opened on the 16th of July 1861, on which day the Patients were transferred thereto from the Asylum at <i>Floriana</i> .
473	...	For both sexes, and capable of containing 60 patients, 30 of each sex.
193	...	Can afford asylum to 172 aged and disabled poor, of each sex, above 60 years of age, with few exceptions, there being no Institution for Incurable cases in <i>Gozo</i> .
