IMPORTS & EXPORTS.

1895.

Memoranda referring to the following Returns of Imports and Exports.

1. IMPORTS.

These Returns include only articles subject to duty. There are no available sources from which to calculate, even roughly, the values and quantities of other Imports.

2. EXPORTS.

There is no Export duty in Malta. These Returns include only articles subject to Import duty, which are exported in same bottoms or from bond, or were transhipped.

3. The general average prices of the various Imports have been obtained from the most reliable sources, that is, from Firms of long standing, and from Public Brokers of experience.

4. *B.* denotes Barili—a Maltese Barile=9½ Imperial Gallons.

C. " Caffisi—a Maltese Caffiso=4½ do.

Ca. " Cantara—a Maltese Cantaro=175³/₈ English.

N. " Number.

S. " Salme—a Maltese Salma=1 Imperial Quarter.

5. There is no special "Entry for Home Consumption." The items under that column are the quantities released for consumption and include articles which were in bond previous to 1895 so that they will not tally with those in the column of Imports of that year.

6. The Imports and Exports (Tables 1A and 1B) show the value of the quantities—"*actually brought into the Island.*" distinct from those "*re-exported in the same bottoms, or transhipped,*" as required by Circular Despatch of the Secretary of State dated 29 June 1875.

7. Items with an asterisk (*) are quantities which proceeded in the same bottoms.
