No. of inmates in 1895	How supported	REMARKS
120	...	For Orphans of both sexes between the age of 6 and 16. With but few exceptions, the children are orphans of both parents. The building was formerly the Hospital for Men.
2,347	...	This Institution is for the reception of Male and Female patients, and contains 200 beds.
104	...	This Hospital, which was opened on the 20th March 1882, is adjoining the Central Hospital and contains 26 beds intended only for seamen who contribute 2/6 per day each for their maintenance and treatment therein.
503	...	Enlarged in 1856, capable of containing 72 patients 42 Males and 30 Females. This Hospital is partly used for convalescent patients from the Central Hospital.
653	...	Hospital for mental disorders. The building is situated at <i>Wied Incitta</i> , between Notabile and Attard. It was opened on the 16th of July 1864, on which day the Patients were transferred thereto from the Asylum at Floriana.
1,159	...	For the reception of the aged and disabled poor, above the age of 60, and of persons affected with incurable disease, both sexes; of women who led a dissolute life and are anxious to repent; and of foundlings and deserted infants until nurses can be found for them in the country or they become of age to be admitted into the Orphan Asylum.
428	...	For both sexes, and capable of containing 60 patients, 30 of each sex.
174	...	Can afford asylum to 160 aged and disabled poor, 80 of each sex, above 60 years of age, with few exceptions, there being no Institution for incurable cases in Gozo.
