MALTA.					<p>(1) The University of Malta is empowered to confer five degrees, viz: (1) B.A. Bachelor of Arts; (2) M.A. Master of Arts; (3) M.D. Doctor of Medicine; (4) LL.D. Doctor of Law; (5) D.D. Doctor in Divinity; and consists of four Faculties; viz: Arts and Sciences, Medicine, Law, and Theology.</p> <p>(2) The Lyceum is an Institution intended to impart intermediate instruction. It is divided into three departments: the Preparatory School, the Modern Department, and the Classical Department. It prepares young men to matriculate in the University, to compete for situations in the Army or the Civil Service, or to embrace the career of Commerce, and Architecture, and Land-Surveying.</p> <p>(3) English, Italian, French, and the other subjects of the curriculum of a Young Ladies' School are taught.</p> <p>(4) In the Secondary School for boys, instruction is imparted in Latin, English and Italian, Arithmetic, Algebra and Geometry, History and Geography, the Elements of Physical Sciences, Writing and Religious Doctrine.</p> <p>(5) The Primary Schools are intended to educate and instruct the children of the working classes, and to prepare those among them, who are willing to continue their studies for admission to the Lyceum and the other intermediate or Secondary Schools. Instruction is given in the Maltese, English, and Italian languages, Arithmetic, Writing, History, Geography, Needlework, (for girls) and the Catechism.</p> <p>(6) A School for artisans learning the art of modelling in clay, plaster-casting, stucco, cabinet-making and wood and stone carving.</p>
