107	BY GOVERNMENT. Hospital does not exist in certain cases—vide A Page 7.	For Orphans of both sexes between the age of 6 and 16. With but few exceptions, the children are orphans of both parents. The building was formerly the Hospital for Men.
2582		This Institution is for the reception of Male and Female patients, and contains 200 beds.
61		This Hospital, which was opened on the 20th March 1882, is adjoining the Central Hospital and contains 20 beds reserved only for women who contribute 2/6 per day each for their maintenance and treatment therein.
118		Hospital for infectious diseases.
456		Enlarged in 1890, capable of containing 72 patients 42 Males and 30 Female. This Hospital is partly used for convalescent patients from the Central Hospital.
799		Hospital for mental disorder. The building is situated at <i>Wlet Incita</i> , between Notabile and Attard. It was opened on the 26th of July 1861, on which day the patients were transferred thereto from the Asylum at Floriana.
1216		For the reception of the aged and disabled poor, above the age of 60, and of persons affected with incurable disease, both sexes; of women who led a dissolute life and are anxious to repent; of foundlings and deserted infants until nurses can be found for them in the country or they become of age to be admitted into the Orphan Asylum and also of Male Lepers who are kept in a separate building in force of Ordinance No. VII of 1833. The law is not yet applied to Female Lepers, for want of the necessary accommodation.
411		For both sexes, and capable of containing 60 patients.
189		Can afford asylum to 160 aged and disabled poor, 80 of each sex, above 60 years of age, with few exceptions, there being no Institutions for incurable cases in Gozo.
