Doctor of Divinity; and consists of four Faculties, viz: Literature and Science, Medicine, Law, and Theology.

Valletta District	* Elementary Schools. (6) Valletta, Strada Mercanti	580	437	1,017	(2) The Lyceum is an Institution intended to impart intermediate instruction. It is divided into two Courses of Study, the Classical and the Modern; each consisting of two grades of instruction, a Higher and a Lower. It prepares young men to matriculate for admission into the University, to compete for situations in the Army or the Civil Service, or to embrace the career of Commerce, of Engineering and Architecture, Electrical Engineering and of Marine Engineering. (3) English, Italian, French, Arithmetic, Needlework and the other subjects included in the curriculum of a Secondary School for Girls are taught. (4) In the Secondary School for boys instruction is imparted in Latin, English, Italian, Arithmetic, Algebra and Geometry, History and Geography, the Elements of Physical Sciences, Writing, and Religious Doctrine. (5) In the Technical and Manual School, Modelling in Clay, Plaster-casting, Stucco-work, Wood and Stone carving are taught. (6) The Elementary Schools are intended to educate and instruct the children of the working classes, and to prepare those among them who are willing to continue their studies for admission to the Lyceum and the other intermediate or secondary Schools. Instruction is given in the Maltese, English and Italian languages, Arithmetic, Writing, History, Geography, Needlework (for girls) and the Catechism. — Drawing, wood carving and modelling are also taught in the town Schools, and Physical Drill in all the Schools.
