No. of Inmates in 1908-1909	How supported	REMARKS
111	...	For Orphans of both sexes between the age of 6 and 16. With few exceptions, the children have lost both parents. This Institution is for the reception of Male and Female patients, and contains 200 beds.
3209	...	This Hospital, which was opened on the 20th March 1882, adjoins the Central Hospital, and contains 26 beds intended only for seamen, who contribute 2/6 per day each for their maintenance and treatment.

161	...	
429	... BY GOVERNMENT:	Enlarged in 1850. Capable of containing 72 patients—42 Males and 30 Females. This Hospital is partly used for convalescent patients from the Central Hospital.
839	...	Hospital for mental disorders. The building is situated at <i>Wied Incisa</i> , between Notabile and Attard. It was opened on the 4th of July 1861, on which day the patients were transferred thereto from the Asylum at Floriana.
1168	...	For the reception of the aged and disabled poor, above the age of 60, and of persons affected with incurable diseases, of both sexes; women who have led a dissolute life and are anxious to repent; and foundling and deserted infants until nurses can be found for them in the country, or they become of age to be admitted into the Orphan Asylum.
76	... BY GOVERNMENT:	For Male Lepers. The law is not yet applied to Female Lepers, for want of the necessary accommodation.
569	...	For both sexes, and capable of containing 60 patients.
195	...	Accommodates 160 aged and disabled poor (80 of each sex) above 60 years of age, with few exceptions, there being no Institutions for incurable cases in Gozo.
32	...	Hospital for contagious diseases.

The number of children farmed out in above period was 438 in Malta and 4 in Gozo. Monthly average 175 at the rate of about 4/1 each (Malta) and 1 at the rate of 5/4 (Gozo).

Gratuitous Assistance of a Midwife was given in 174 cases, monthly average 15 at the rate of about 4/7½ each (Malta); and in 17 cases in Gozo, monthly average 1 at the rate of 7/10 each including travelling expenses.
