(Bachelor of Science); (3) B. Eng. &amp; Arch. (Bachelor of Engineering and Architecture); (4) B. L. Com. (Bachelor of Canon Law); (5) D.Lit. (Doctor of Literature); (6) D.Sc. (Doctor of Science); (7) D. Eng. &amp; Arch. (Doctor of Engineering &amp; Architecture); (8) M.D. (Doctor of Medicine); (9) Ch.M. (Master of Surgery); (10) LL.D. (Doctor of Laws); (11) D.D. (Doctor of Theology); and Diplomas of (1) Pharmacist; (2) Landsurveyor &amp; Architect; (3) Legal Procurator; (4) Notary Public; (5) Dental Surgeon; (6) Practical Midwife.</p> <p>The University comprises six Faculties, viz:—Literature, Science, Engineering &amp; Architecture, Medicine &amp; Surgery, Laws, and Theology.</p> <p>[2] The Lyceum is an Institution intended to impart intermediate instruction. It is divided into two Courses of Study, the Classical and the Modern, each consisting of two grades of instruction, a Higher and a Lower. It prepares young men to matriculate for admission into the University, or to embrace the career of Commerce, Electrical Engineering and of Marine Engineering.</p> <p>[3] English, Italian, French, Arithmetic, Needle work and the other subjects included in the curriculum of a Secondary School for Girls are taught.</p> <p>[4] In the Secondary School for Boys instruction is imparted in Latin, English, Italian, Arithmetic, Algebra and Geometry, History and Geography, Writing, Sacred History, and Religious Doctrine. It prepares young men to matriculate for admission into the University.</p>
