The quantity of water is practically unlimited.

A natural source from the town aqueduct.

Quality is good in every respect.

Porcelain and cement Baths with hot and cold laid on; the Lavatories are earthenware basins fixed in marble slabs. They are all regularly trapped.

Water System. The Privies are separated from the wards by means of passages thoroughly ventilated.
