TECHNICAL EDUCATION.

There are 25 technical evening classes in the Elementary Schools' Department with an average attendance of 677 pupils. Marine and Electrical Engineering Classes are held in the Lyceum with a workshop for practical training attached to the Malta Railway. The attendance in 1924-25 was 57 students. Students attend H.M. Dockyard for practical instruction. Carpentry, shoemaking, stone-cutting and trimming are taught at the Salvatore Reformatory. There are other private technical institutes, viz: the Salesian Industrial School, the Istituto Vincenzo Bugeja, the Casa di S. Giuseppe or Istituto Bonnici and the Oratorio San Luigi, the first three of which are subsidized by the Government.
