FOR ALL HOSPITALS:

(I) What quantity of Water is available for each Patient every day?

The quantity of water is practically unlimited.

What is the source of the water supply?

A natural source from the town-aqueduct.

What is the quality of the Water?

Quality is good in every respect.

(II) Detail the arrangements as to Baths and Lavatories?

Porcelain and cement Baths with hot and cold laid on: the Lavatories are earthenware basins fixed in marble slabs. They are all regularly trapped.

(III) What is the system of sewage; and what the condition of the Privies?

Water System. The Privies are separated from the wards by means of passages thoroughly ventilated.
