(Bachelor of Science), (3) B.Eng. & Arch. (Bachelor of Engineering and Architecture); (4) B.L.Can. (Bachelor of Canon Law); (5) M.D. (Doctor of Medicine); (6) L.L.D. (Doctor of Laws); (7) D.D. (Doctor of Theology); and Diplomas of (1) Pharmacist, (2) Legal Procurator, (3) Notary Public, (4) Dental Surgeon, (5) Practical Midwife. It is divided into two courses of studies, the Classical and the Modern, each consisting of two grades of instruction, a Higher and a Lower. It prepares young men to matriculate for admission into the University, to enter the Civil Service or to embrace the career of Commerce, Electrical Engineering and of Marine Engineering. The average annual cost for each student was £15. 14. 0.</p> <p>(3) In the Secondary School for Girls, Valletta, instruction is imparted in English, Italian, French, Arithmetic and Mathematics, Needlework and the other subjects usually included in the curriculum of a Secondary School for young ladies. The average annual cost for each student was £5. 7. 0.</p> <p>(4) In the Secondary School for Boys at Gozo, Latin, English, Italian, Arithmetic, Algebra and Geometry, History and Geography, Physics, Sacred History and Religious Doctrine are taught. It prepares young men to matriculate for admission into the University. TECHNICAL EDUCATION.

Drawing forms part of the syllabus of the Elementary Schools, and is taught in all boys' classes from Standard IV upwards. Marine and Electrical Engineering Classes are held in the Lyceum with a workshop for practical training. The attendance in 1930-31 was 42 students. The cost was £343. 12. 0. Students attend H.M. Dockyard for practical instruction. Carpentry, shoemaking, stone-cutting and trimming, motor mechanics and driving, and cooking are taught at the Salvatore Reformatory. Technical Education cost the Government £1,166 in 1930-31. There are other private technical institutes, viz: the Salesian Industrial School, the Istituto Vincenzo Bugeja, the Casa di S. Giuseppe or Istituto Bonnici and the Oratorio San Luigi, the first three of which are subsidized by the Government.

There is also a School of Art which comprises free courses in higher art education. It embraces painting, drawing, modelling, smithery and filigree, history of art and general art knowledge.

There is a Migrants Training Centre at "tal Hammieri" where prospective emigrants are given colloquial instruction in English or French and are trained in rough carpentry, elementary bricklaying and concrete construction, erection of shelters and fences, land clearing, and other matters as a preparation for life in the country to which the emigrants intend to proceed. The cost of running the Migrants' Training Centre amounted to £1393. 10. 7.
