The quantity of water is practically unlimited.

A natural source from the town aqueduct.

What is the quality of the Water?

Quality is good in every respect.

(II) Detail the arrangements as to Baths and Lavatories?

Porcelain, enamel and cement Baths with hot and cold water laid on; the Lavatories are earthenware basins fixed in marble slabs. They are all regularly trapped.

(III) What is the system of sewage; and what the condition of the Privies?

Water System. The Privies are separated from the wards by means of passages thoroughly ventilated.
