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COMMENTARY

1. DEMOGRAPHIC DEVELOPMENT

1.1 POPULATION GROWTH

The estimate of the total population for the Maltese Islands for 2002 was 397,296 persons, made up of 196,836 males and 200,460 females. These included work and resident permit holders and foreigners residing in Malta. The number of foreign residents remained the same as in the previous year, representing 2.6 per cent of the total population.

The main demographic events registered during the year are shown in various tables in this issue. Population change is the net result of two demographic aspects: the difference between births and deaths and the migration balance. Again both were positive during the year. There was a natural increase of 810 persons and a net migration inflow of 462 persons in the total population. The end year Maltese population (excluding permanent foreign residents) stood at 386,938 consisting of 191,975 males and 194,963 females.

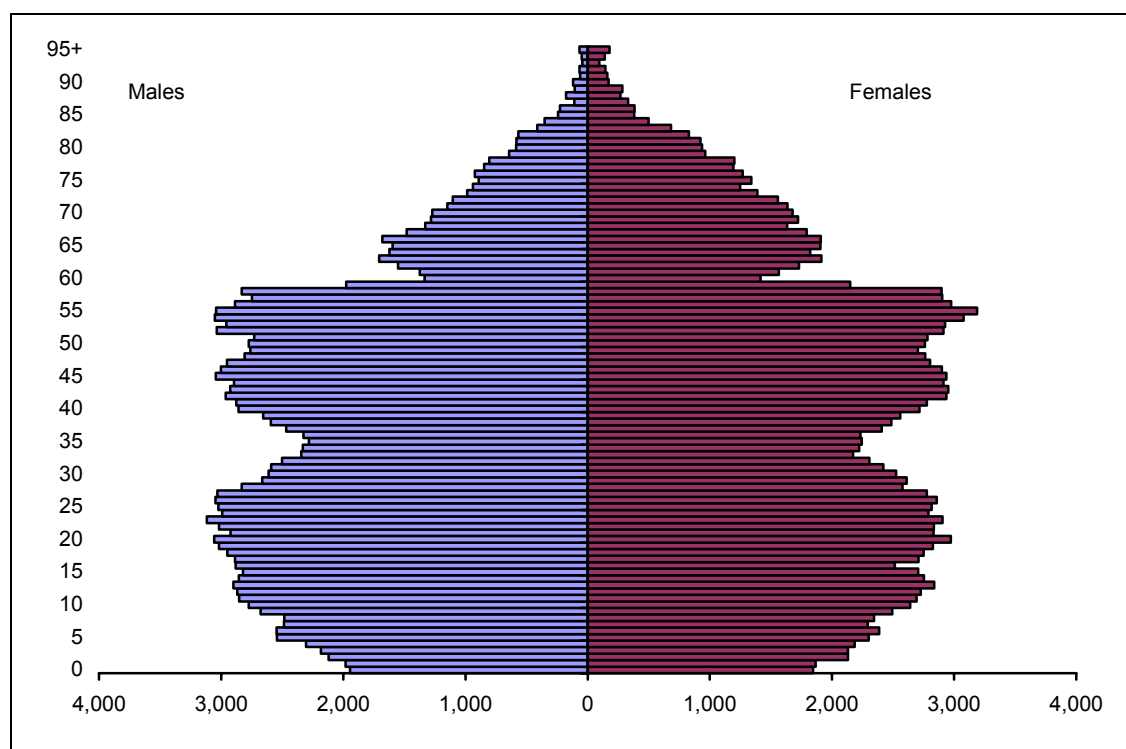
With an area of 315.590 square kilometers, Malta has a population density of 1,257 persons per square kilometer, which is the highest in Europe.

1.2 COMPOSITION

Since the middle of the 1960s and the end of the baby-boom, all the present and acceding countries of the European Union have been experiencing noticeable ageing of the structures of their population. This phenomenon, closely connected with the decline of fertility, is strengthened today by the progress obtained in life expectancy at high ages. This development jeopardizes the Social Security systems and constitutes one of the greatest challenges presented to human imagination and to our capacities of adaptation. The acceding countries including Malta, will experience an acceleration of the ageing in their population.

The aged-child ratio for the population in the Maltese Islands, in the year 2002, consisted of 68 old persons per 100 children, whereas the Total Dependency Ratio was 46.09.

2. VITAL STATISTICS

2.1 FERTILITY

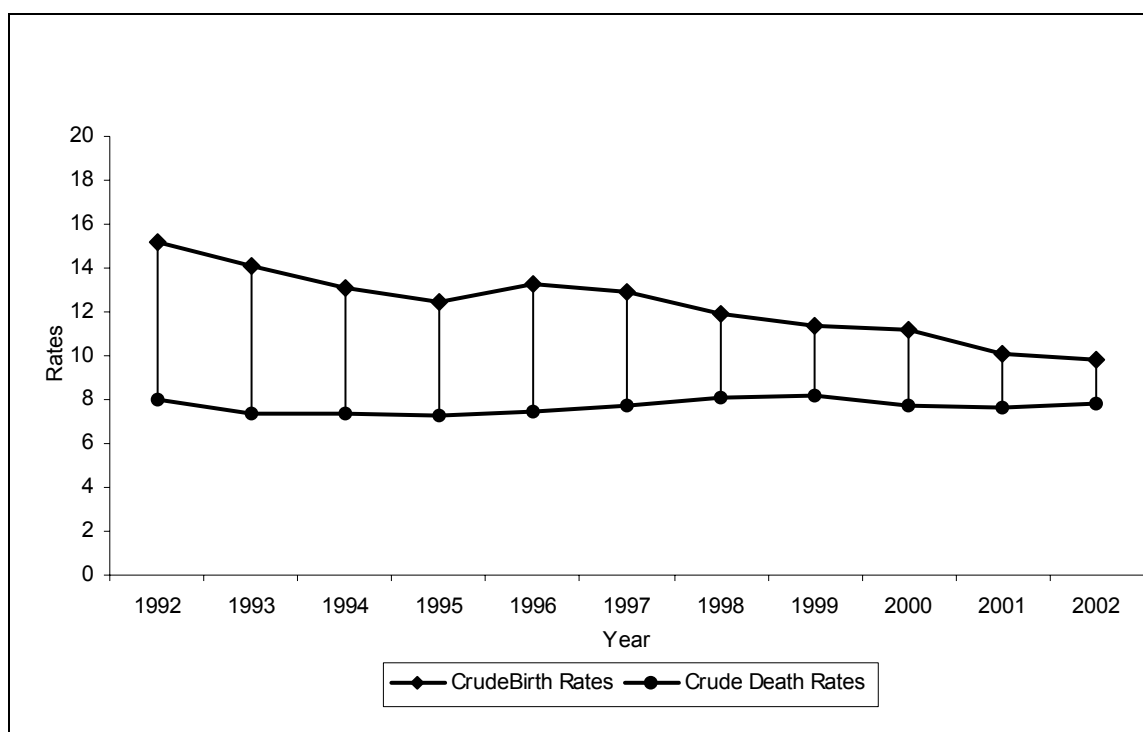
From the 1960s, the fertility of the Western European countries has continuously decreased. With the forthcoming enlargement, the European Union will incorporate countries which, although they long remained on appreciably higher fertility levels, all have a low fertility level; this can be said also for Malta with a Total Fertility Rate being 1.46 for 2002.

The number of newborns to Maltese parents was slightly lower than the previous year. At 3,805 the figure is now the lowest recorded over the past thirty years. This slight drop might be an indication that the TFR will find its level and remain constant for the coming years.

The Crude Birth Rate continued to drop to 9.86 in 2002. Babies born to parents of other nationalities residing in Malta, amounted to 101. Birkirkara again registered the largest number of births with 222, with a Crude Birth Rate of 10.31 on a Locality basis. However it was Mtarfa which scored the highest Crude Birth Rate of 31.58.

Births outside marriage continued to rise, which at 14.95 per cent of the total births, is the highest ever recorded.

2.2 MORTALITY AND HEALTH

The increase in the life expectancy in Europe is accompanied by incapacity illnesses leading to an increase in health expenditures. European countries carried out a transition towards the market economy bringing a change in the socio-economic system. In the field of health, the public sector and private sector have to find their respective places in a completely new care system.

As mortality improves people can look forward to longer life than that of previous generations. The Expectation of Life for the year 2002 was 75.78 for males and 80.48 for females.

The number of deaths for 2002 was 3,031 with a Crude Death Rate of 7.85, this has been the average CDR for the past decade. Infant deaths increased to 23 from 17 over last year, the difference being a constant fluctuation recorded over the past decade, keeping the infant mortality rate at an average of 7.2. The infant mortality has been traced way back to 1896. It fluctuated widely between 190 and 300 per 1000 live births from 1896 to 1942, and kept declining ever after.

The seasonal behaviour of mortality has been relatively the same over the past three decades, namely attaining a moderate peak in the first quarter of the year, then flattens out in the other quarters. Responsible for the 'peak' are the diseases of the circulatory and respiratory systems, which take a higher toll of human life during the initial three months of the year than in any other month.

Again Luqa, where the main Government Home for the Elderly (St. Vincent De Paule Residence) is situated, showed the highest Crude Death Rate at 23.81.

2.3 MARRIAGES

The Crude Marriage Rate for the Maltese Islands, at 5.80, kept its level as the previous year. Marriages in Malta amounted to 2,068, whilst those occurring in Gozo stood at 172.

Single brides amounted to 2,100 out of the 2,240 marriages celebrated during the year. Single Bridegrooms made 93.5 per cent of the total bridegrooms, whilst the widowed, annulled and divorced grooms made 0.9 per cent, 1.0 per cent and 4.2 per cent respectively. Widowed, annulled and divorced brides and grooms came from the 30-44 age group. Most male spouses came largely from the Technical and Professional sectors, whereas the female spouses were clerks and factory workers.

Again foreign spouses were mostly of British Nationality while most of the Maltese spouses come from the Northern Harbour District. The month of June kept its record for the past decade, as being the most popular month for weddings.

Civil marriages increased from the previous year by 101 to 575 marriages, this being the highest increase between two successive years, since the introduction of Civil Marriages Act in 1975.

3. MIGRATION

The progressive integration of the Central and Eastern European countries, and social realities in the countries of departure and of arrival, did not lead to large migratory moves envisaged by some. Tomorrow, with the accession to the European Union of ten new countries, mainly from Central Europe, how will the new migratory flows structure themselves in Europe?

What will be the demographic and socio-economic consequences of a broader opening of the borders of the European Union to the potential migrants from the acceding countries?

The number of Maltese leaving the Islands to settle in other countries has dwindled drastically. Up to 1995, records were held of all prospective emigrants to the main four receiving countries – these were Australia, Canada, United Kingdom and the United States of America. Since then these countries have made it quite difficult on such persons to settle there. The National Statistics Office has found difficulties to gather data on such emigrants to countries other than the United Kingdom, although it is believed that data to these other countries is quite negligible.

During 2002, there were 96 persons, 46 males, and 50 females who left to settle abroad. There were 382 returning migrants made up of 219 males, and 163 females plus 533 non-Maltese settlers and 801 naturalizations and registrations, which includes 18 adoptions. This figure is the lowest ever recorded, since adoptions from Romania have

stopped at the end of year 2000. New work permits during the year were given to 255 persons.

Between 1992 and 1996, the number of returned migrants was decreasing constantly. From 1997 onwards, the number of returning migrants took quite a linear pattern with very little fluctuations. A large proportion of the returning migrants over the past few years were people who had been living abroad for between 0 and 4 years. In 2002, 76 males, and 52 females returned to Malta after having spent less than 4 years abroad. On the other hand, people returning from abroad after over 50 years decreased; only 14 people, returned in 2002.

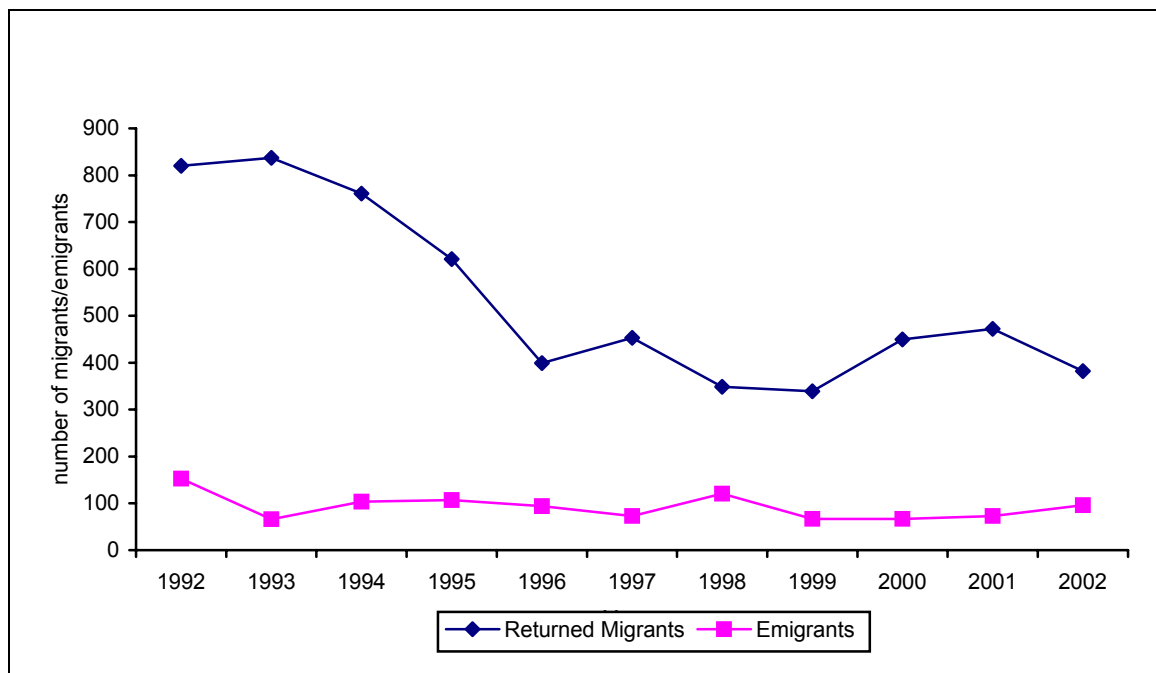
Another aspect on migration statistics is the phenomenon of irregular migration, which has increased dramatically over the past decade.

In the case of the Mediterranean Sea, boats and ferries are probably the main carriers. Countries North and South of the Mediterranean Sea are transit countries as well as destinations.

This applies to Malta as well. With a population density of 1,257 per square kilometer, Malta had to cope with about 1600 boat people during the year.

The absence of exact figures and a shortage of reliable studies concerning clandestine migration from the south of the Mediterranean into Europe applies also for Malta. This phenomenon was quite an impact on the Maltese Authorities.

4. FORECASTS

Future population trends are usually based on projections which in themselves are neither forecasts nor predictions. These are an extension of past trends, based on the judgement of the future as seen at the moment. Although they are in a sense ventures into prophecy, they should not be dignified by the terms 'estimates' or 'predictions'. There is no suggestion that they will be borne out. No matter how refined, the projections are necessarily little more than an educated guess.

Malta's population is still 'young' by European standards. The 0-14 age group represents 18.9 per cent of the Maltese population, whereas the 65+ age group stands at 12.8 per cent. The number of potential workers for each pensioner gives nearly the same results as shown in last year's projections, i.e. 5.3:1 in 2002 declining to 3.1:1 in the year 2025.

5. SOURCES OF DATA

Births statistics are derived from records held at the Public Registries of Malta and Gozo where registrations of such births are obligatory. Such births are matched with data provided from state hospitals, private hospitals and private clinics. These sources always match.

Deaths registered are forwarded to the Health Information where these are analyzed and data is sent regularly to the National Statistics Office.

6. DEFINITION OF TERMS USED

Crude Birth, Death and Marriage Rates are respectively the number of births, deaths and marriages per thousand in the mid-year population.

Sex Ratio at birth, which is used for projections of population figures, gives the number of male births per hundred female births.

Life Expectancy at Birth indicates the number of years of a newborn baby is expected to live if mortality in the various age-groups remains at the level of the period on which life expectancy is computed.

Infant Mortality Rate is the number of deaths of infants under 1 year per 1000 live births.

Natural Increase is the excess of births over deaths. When expressed as a rate per thousand population it is the difference between the Crude Birth Rate and the Crude Death Rate.

Annulled marriage refers to annulments given by the Superior Courts or the Church Tribunal.

Divorce refers to divorces which were accepted by the laws of Malta in terms of Section 33 of The Marriage Act, 1975.

Migration data has undergone quite some changes since the Labour Department dismantled its section of Emigration in January 1995. The data hence encountered deficiencies in record availability. The only sources for prospective emigrants were those from the Embassies and the High Commissions. Since 2000 only the High Commission of Britain was complying with our requests.

Data for returning migrants and foreign settlers is derived from monthly returns from the Comptroller of Customs. Prospective settlers, both foreign and returning Maltese, have to be recorded at the Customs since they have to declare their personal effects.

Marriages are compiled at NSO from data kept at the respective Public Registries of Malta and Gozo. The limitations in this aspect are data relating to separations and annulments. Divorce is not recognized in the Constitution of Malta.

Population Estimates are based on Census results updated annually to take account of the components of change: births, deaths and net migration, as well as registration of foreigners as Maltese nationals.
