

# **LIFESTYLE SURVEY 2007**

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## Foreword

When the Austrian psychologist, Alfred Adler, coined the word 'lifestyle' eighty years ago, little did he know that this term would eventually be used by statistical offices around the world to capture, for example, a country's level of happiness compared to another's. The National Statistics Office is no exception. Results of a second adult lifestyle survey carried out in winter 2007 show that over 80 per cent of Maltese adults are satisfied with their lives.

However lifestyle is not just about the way a person lives, but concerns individuals' social relations, consumption, entertainment and dress. In fact respondents were asked to provide information on their likes and dislikes, habits and intentions, as well as information related to their daily life. NSO's survey revealed that restaurants are the most frequented places, while casinos are the least frequented. In addition, almost 75 per cent of the youngest age group covered in the survey (18-24) consume at least one unit of alcohol per week. On average, individuals in all age groups drink 4.2 glasses of wine, 5.4 bottles of beer and 5 tots of spirits. Although the wine and beer intake of persons aged 18-24 is lower than the average (2.9 glasses of the former and 4.4 bottles of the latter), they drink 5.4 tots of spirits.

With regard to eating habits, over 95 per cent of males aged between 18 and 24 eat fried food at least once a week, compared to 77.8 per cent of females in the same age group. Just over 25 per cent of the youngest age group eat fried food at least 3 days a week, while almost 62 per cent opt for this food type once or twice a week.

Lifestyles also reflect individual attitudes, constrained by choices resulting from surrounding social systems. They also reflect the progress, or otherwise, of a nation. This publication includes data on leisure activities, exercise patterns, smoking, alcohol consumption, and the perceived quality of life of individuals. Reading, for example, emerges as one of the most popular hobbies among Maltese adults.

Lifestyle surveys are today being extended over an even wider range, covering evolving trends in the lives of men and women, their health and even the average weight and height of the population. NSO's results show that 26.4 per cent smoke cigarettes. On a gender level, 33.5 per cent of males and 19.4 per cent of females are smokers. Furthermore, the average weight of the Maltese population is 72.5 kg, with the average height being estimated at 165.3 cm.

That is just a taster. This publication has the right ingredients to offer more food for thought and analysis.

## Methodology

### Target Population

The target population consisted of Maltese residents aged 18 and over and living in private households as found in the preliminary Census population adjusted for 2006.

### Sample Design

A gross sample of 2,000 individuals was selected using systematic random sampling amongst the whole list of individuals. Each individual had the same chance of being selected.

### Data Collection

Data was collected between November 2006 and January 2007, through self-completion questionnaires, which were sent to the individuals by postal mail. Due to the nature of some of the questions, e.g. sexual health, drug consumption and religion, and to make it easier for the selected persons to provide the true answers, it was decided that this survey should be anonymous. In fact, the individual answering the questionnaire could not be identified since no reference number, name, or address was printed on the questionnaire.

The target population was estimated at 312,079 persons. The population distribution and the key demographic characteristics of respondents are shown in the tables below:

## Response

The response rate for this survey stood at 68.5 per cent or 1,369 persons. The following two tables present the sample distribution by gender, age-group and district of all the participants in this survey.

## Grossing Up

The use of weights in survey analysis compensates for the bias which is created within the sample due to the sample size, non-response and coverage rates. A *posteriori* stratification was performed by gender, age-group, and marital status. By means of this process a weight was assigned to each respondent, such that upon grossing up the projected sample estimates reflected the real characteristics of the target population.

It is important to stress that although the results produced from sampling surveys are only estimates of the real population parameters, however the estimators produced from this research are clear indicators of what the actual values are. However in some tables totals may not tally due to rounding errors.

## Quality Control Measures

Suitable measures were taken to ensure that the survey results were of high quality. These included a series of quality checks by vetters, and in-built validation rules in the data entry program in order to limit the errors of data inputting. Missing data and non-response was imputed using the hot-deck technique, which involves analysing the dataset and checking whether there is another respondent



population. The mean is of particular interest because it is usually regarded as the true value, and divergences from it as errors of estimation due to sampling effects.

Given that the sample under study was drawn by means of Simple Random Sampling, the standard error of the proportion  $\sigma_p$  may be calculated by:

$$\sigma_p = \sqrt{\frac{p(1-p)}{n}}$$

where  $p$  is the proportion in the sample and  $n$  denotes the total number of respondents under observation.

Thereafter, in order to specify how accurate a particular point estimate is, we derive what is known as a confidence interval (C.I.), where we adjust the point estimate for error and provide a range of values within which we are confident the true value of the unknown parameter lies. These are upper and lower limits to the values of any uncertain estimate. All the results presented in this publication are worked out at a 95 per cent confidence interval. This means that if we were to take 100 different samples for the study from the same population, 95 of these samples would constitute the same results.

If a normally distributed population is assumed (as it is habitually considered) and the standard error of the proportion is known, then a confidence interval for that proportion can be computed as:

$$p \pm (z)(\sigma_p)$$

where  $\sigma_p$  is the standard error of the proportion and  $z$  is a constant which depends on the level of confidence desired. In this particular case,  $z$  will take a value equal to 1.96 since we have established a 95 per cent confidence interval, and a value of 1.96 coincides with the 0.975 quintile of the normal distribution.

Therefore, the 'true' population proportion must fall within the interval bounded below by  $[p - (z)(\sigma_p)]$  and above by  $[p + (z)(\sigma_p)]$ .

For example, the confidence interval for the proportion of individuals who visited a restaurant at least once a year was estimated at 2 per cent. This means that the reader may expect the actual proportion value of this estimate to lie within the interval  $0.80 \pm 0.02$ , i.e. 78 per cent and 82 per cent.

with similar variable characteristics, and then replacing the missing indicator with the indicator of that similar respondent. Technically it involves stratifying and sorting the data by key covariates, and then replacing missing data from another record in the same strata.

## **Errors**

The survey was subject to two main sources of errors, which are technically referred to as *sampling errors* and *non-sampling errors*.

The sample used for this particular survey was only one of an infinitely number of other possible samples of the same size and design that could have been selected. Moreover, whenever a sample is drawn, only that part of the population that is included in the sample is measured, and is used to represent the entire population. Hence, there must always be some error in the data, resulting from those members of the population who were not measured.

This difference is termed **sampling error**, and it arises from estimating a population characteristic by looking at only one particular portion of the population. It refers to the difference between the estimate derived from the sample survey and the 'true' value that would result if a census of the whole population were carried out under the same conditions. Error will, therefore, be reduced as the sample size is increased, so that if a census is performed, there would be no sampling error.

**Non-sampling error** is a catch-all term for the deviations from the true value that are not a function of the sample chosen, including various systematic and any random errors that are not due to sampling.

In particular, a non-sampling error is one that results solely from the manner in which the observations are made and includes a statistical error caused by human error. Very often these arise due to data entry errors, the interviewers effect and the respondent effect. These can include, but are not limited to, data entry errors, biased questions in a questionnaire, biased processing/decision making, inappropriate analysis conclusions and false information provided by respondents. Non-sampling errors are much harder to quantify than sampling errors and are in fact impossible to quantify. Moreover, tables may not be additive due to rounding errors. Therefore, the presence of this error should be borne in mind by all users of these data.

## **Quality control**

One way of assessing and controlling non-sampling errors in the survey was to independently duplicate the work at the different stages of operation with a view to facilitating the detection and rectification of errors.

In particular, the data collection process was subject to a series of quality checks by a group of well-trained and experienced NSO staff. Particular attention was made throughout the study in order to monitor and limit the occurrence of non-sampling errors arising in the data processing, editing and coding phases of the study. This involved detecting erroneous or questionable survey data with the goal of correcting these as much as possible.

In many cases, the information found in the survey questionnaire was pre-coded to limit coding errors. Other information contained in open-ended responses were grouped into specific categories.

In addition, the data-entry program used in the process of transferring collected data to the computer for analysis had a number of built-in validation rules to ensure the quality of captured data, and that data entry errors are kept to an absolute minimum.

## **Estimates of Precision**

The accuracy of a sample is a measure of the difference between the population and the drawn sample. This is measured in terms of specific parameters.

Sampling errors are partly measured by the standard error, which is a statistical measure of the dispersion of a set of values. The standard error provides an estimation of the extent to which the mean of a given set of scores drawn from a sample differs from the true mean score of the whole

- **Southern Harbour** - Żabbar, Xgħajra, Valletta, Tarxien, Santa Luċija, Paola, Marsa, Luqa, Kalkara, Senglea, Floriana, Fgura, Cospicua, Vittoriosa.
- **Northern Harbour** - Ta' Xbiex, Swieqi, Sliema, Santa Venera, San Ġwann, St. Julians, Qormi, Pietà', Pembroke, Msida, Ħamrun, Gżira, Birkirkara.
- **South Eastern** - Żurrieq, Żejtun, Safi, Qrendi, Mqabba, Marsaxlokk, Marsaskala, Kirkop, Gudja, Għaxaq, Birżebbuġia.
- **Western** - Żebbuġ, Siġġiewi, Rabat, Mtarfa, Mdina, Lija, Iklin, Dingli, Balzan, Attard.

**Body Mass Index (BMI):** This is an objective scientific measure of body fat based on height and weight that applies to both adult men and women. The BMI is calculated by dividing a person's weight in kilograms by the square of his/her height in metres. The algebraic expression for BMI is given by:  $BMI = Kg (m)^2$ .

The classification of underweight, overweight and obesity by BMI are as follows:

**Alcohol Units:** These are alcoholic measures related to the alcoholic content of different drinks. A unit of alcohol is the equivalent of 10g of alcohol. One glass of wine, one small bottle of beer and one tot of spirits constitute one unit of alcohol.



## **Commentary**

### **Leisure**

The analysis showed that restaurants are the most frequented places by the adult population, while casinos are the least. Moreover, attendance to cinemas, cultural sites and restaurants was found to be very similar for males and females. However, quite a discrepancy emerged between sexes for other frequented places, the most being bars and wine bars. There is also a relationship between age and some frequented places. In fact, all places except casinos are more likely to be frequented by the younger generation. Furthermore, 95.3 per cent of individuals aged 18 to 24 frequent restaurants at least once a year, compared to 49.8 per cent of those aged over 65.

The majority of Maltese residents listen to more than one type of music. However among those who listen to just one type, country music is the genre mostly listened to, followed by classical and pop music. In fact, while 38.9 per cent stated that they listen to more than one type of music, 19.2 per cent prefer country music, 10.9 per cent prefer classical music and 10.8 per cent listen to pop music. On the other hand, 7.1 per cent do not like listening to music.

There is a major difference between age groups as to what genre of music they listen to mostly. For example, techno, trance and house music are the most popular types of music among those aged 18 to 24, while rock music is most popular among persons aged between 25 and 34 and between 55 and 64.

It was found that reading is the most popular hobby among the adult population, with 48.1 per cent of females and 27.3 per cent of males. Twenty-six per cent highlighted travelling as one of their hobbies while home decoration was pointed out by over one-fifth of the population, predominantly women. In addition, around twenty-one per cent mentioned internet-browsing as their preferred activity.

Popularity of bingo, lotteries and gambling is highly related to the age of the persons. In fact, popularity in such hobbies varied from 3.0 per cent among those aged 18 to 24, 8.4 per cent of those aged 45 to 54 and 15.0 per cent among those having 65 years or more.

### **Exercise**

On a gender level, females are more likely to walk for at least 30 minutes per week than their counterparts. In fact, this was found to be true for 56.5 per cent of females compared to 48.3 per cent of males. This particular activity was also found to be common among 56.9 per cent of married and 49.4 per cent of single persons. A smaller proportion of 39.0 per cent of Gozitans claimed to walk for at least 30 minutes per week.

Similarly, females are more likely to undertake some intensive exercise than males. There is also a relationship between age and intensive exercise, where the young are more likely to perform this activity, with 48.4 per cent of those aged 18 to 24.

On average, 9.1 per cent of the total population attends a gym or fitness club at least once a week. In this case, the difference between males and females is narrower, with 7.5 per cent of males compared to 10.7 per cent of females. Furthermore, 12.7 per cent of the adult population living in the Northern district attends a gym or fitness club at least once a week, compared to 3.4 per cent of people living in the South Eastern district.

### **Transport**

73 per cent of the population own or make use of a car. There is a difference between males and females, with 84.2 per cent of males compared to 61.5 per cent of females.

In addition, the car or motorcycle is the mode of transport mostly used both for going out and to go to work or school. However, people from the Northern Harbour are the least likely to use a car or motorcycle to go to work or school. In fact, persons residing within this district are most likely to go to work or school on foot.

### **Holiday**

On average, 35.2 per cent of the population spends at least one night on a local holiday, while 29.6 per cent spend at least one night on a holiday abroad. The former was found to be most common among individuals aged 18 to 24 while the latter was found to be most common among persons between 25 and 34 years of age. Also, holidays are more popular among those from the Northern district, while Gozitans are the least likely to go on a holiday, both locally and abroad

The average duration of a local holiday is normally 7 nights while persons going for a holiday abroad usually spend about 13 nights.

### **Health**

The survey revealed that 84.0 per cent of the adult population visited a GP in the year prior to the survey, while half of them visited a dentist. Moreover, nearly 10 per cent reported that they visited neither a GP nor a dentist. In general, more women than men visited a GP or a dentist in the 12 months prior to the survey, with 80.1 per cent of males and 87.5 per cent of females. These proportions go down to 47.7 and 51.2 per cent respectively for visits to a dentist.

Sixty one per cent of respondents were sexually active in the 12 months prior to the survey. Of these, 67.5 per cent had not used some type of contraception.

### **Weight and Height**

On average a Maltese adult weighs 72.5kg. This varies from 65.9kg for women to 79.4kg for men. The results show that individuals between 35 and 44 years of age weigh most, with an average of 75.7kg. On the other hand, individuals aged between 18 and 24 weigh least, with an average of 66.7kg.

The average height of the Maltese population is 165.3cm. On a gender level, women are 159.7cm tall, compared to 171.2cm for men.

Overall, 2.6 per cent of the population are underweight, 35.1 per cent have normal weight, and the remaining 62.4 per cent are either overweight or obese. In addition, a minority of 7.5 per cent of overweight individuals and 6.5 per cent of obese individuals attend a gym or fitness club at least once a week.

### **Smoking**

More than one out of every 4 Maltese residents smokes cigarettes, with 26.4 per cent of the adult population. On a gender level, this is true for 33.5 per cent of males and 19.4 per cent of females. It was also found that 61.5 per cent of divorced, annulled and separated individuals are smokers while this proportion goes down to 8.9 per cent for the widowed.

Smokers smoke an average of 15 cigarettes daily. An analysis at gender level revealed that males smoke an average of 17 cigarettes each day, while females smoke 5 cigarettes less each day. Furthermore, divorced, annulled and separated individuals smoke 20.3 cigarettes per day.

## **Alcohol Consumption**

More than half (56.1 per cent) of the adult population consumes at least one unit of alcohol per week. This proportion decreases with age, with 74.4 per cent of those aged between 18 and 24 compared to 43.8 per cent of those aged 65 and over. There is also a significant difference at gender level. In fact, 70.3 per cent of males and 41.9 per cent of females drink at least one unit of alcohol per week.

Wine is the most widely consumed form of alcohol with 42.7 per cent of the population consuming at least one glass of wine per week. Some 24.0 per cent and 20.3 per cent of the population consume at least one bottle of beer and one unit of spirits per week, respectively. The youngest age group comprises the largest proportion of spirit consumers, with 50.3 per cent of individuals aged 18 to 24 compared to 20.3 per cent of the rest of the population.

On average, alcohol consumers drink 4.2 glasses of wine, 5.4 bottles of beer and 5 tots of spirits each week. Persons aged between 18 to 24 drink fewer units than the average with respect to wine and beer. However the opposite is true for drinking spirits.

Those in the younger age groups are most likely to drive a car after consuming three or more alcoholic drinks. In fact, 20.1 per cent of those between the age of 18 to 24 and 25.8 per cent of those between 25 and 34 have driven a car after having consumed three drinks or more.

## **Drugs**

It was found that some 16.5 per cent of females made use of prescribed tranquilisers, antidepressants or sedatives in the 12 months predating the survey, compared to 11.9 per cent of males. On the other hand, 4.1 per cent and 2.2 per cent of males and females respectively made use of these pharmaceuticals in the 12 months prior to the survey without any medical prescription.

Furthermore, 3.2 per cent claimed that they have made use of illicit drugs in the 12 months prior to the survey.

## **Eating Habits**

Ninety five per cent of the Maltese residents consume fruit at least once in a week, while 96.7 per cent consume vegetables at least once a week. In addition, 48.4 per cent of the population eat fruit almost everyday, while another 28.1 per cent do so 3 to 5 days a week. Another 39.2 per cent eat vegetables almost everyday, while 34.5 per cent eat vegetables 3 to 5 days a week.

Over half the Maltese population were on a diet at the time of the survey. Particularly, females are more likely to follow a diet than males. Furthermore, 66.3 per cent of males and 49.7 per cent of females ate fried food at least once in a week during the week preceding the survey. An analysis by age revealed that 95.1 per cent of males in the 18-24 age bracket eat fried food at least once a week, compared to 77.8 per cent of females having the same age. It also emerged that some 9.2 per cent of the adult population eat fried food from 3 to 7 days a week, while this proportion goes up to 25.3 per cent for individuals aged 18 to 24.

## **Life Satisfaction**

In general, persons rate their standard of living as good, with persons aged 18 to 24 and having a tertiary level of education giving the best rating.

With reference to job satisfaction, a proportion of 29.7 per cent of the population are satisfied, with females overruling males.

When asked about the satisfaction in their current relationship, 70.4 per cent claimed to be satisfied, while 20.6 per cent stated the opposite. More males than females are satisfied with their current relationship. In addition, married and single persons are also the most satisfied.

In general, the majority of Maltese adults are quite satisfied with their lives, with 80.3 per cent of individuals. It emerged that married persons are the most while cohabiting individuals are the least. It was also observed that persons claiming to have a very good or good standard of living were also those being the most satisfied with their lives. The same applied to those being very satisfied or satisfied in their current job.

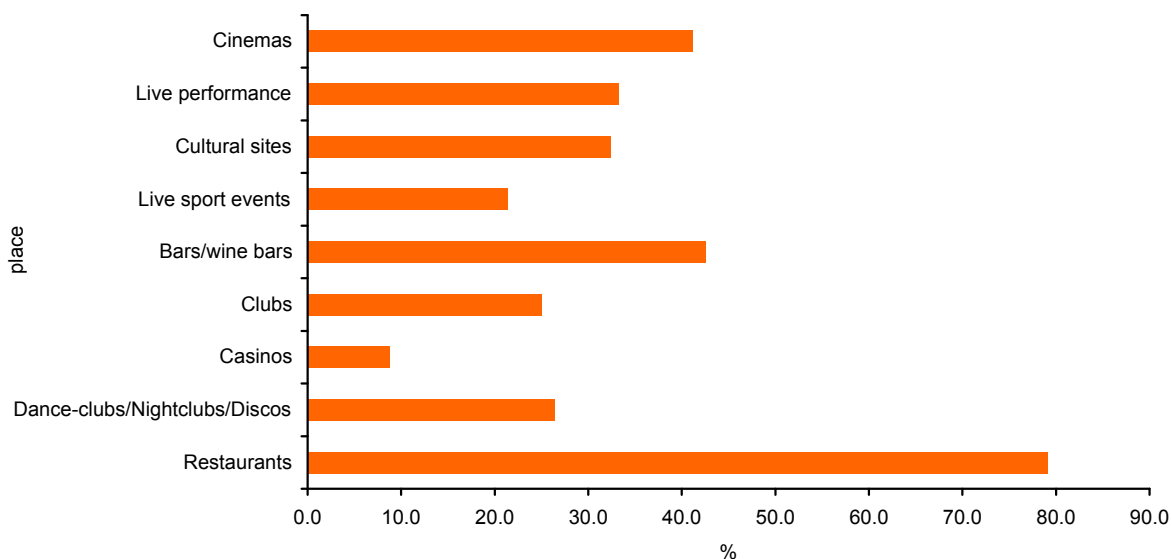

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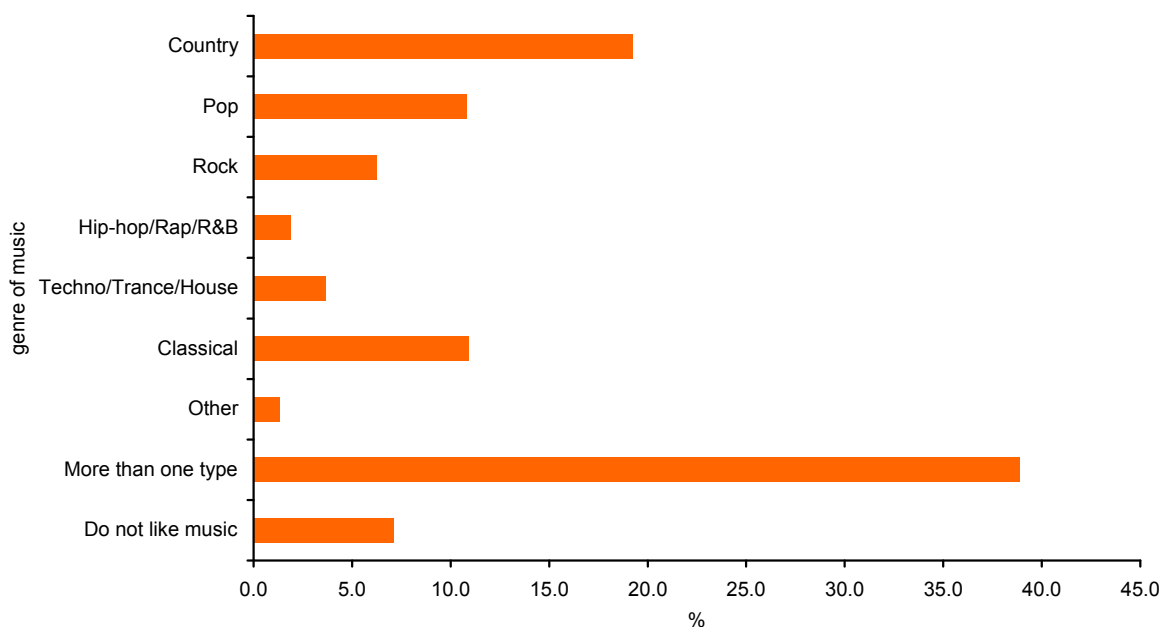

**Chart 2. Genres of music mostly listened to**



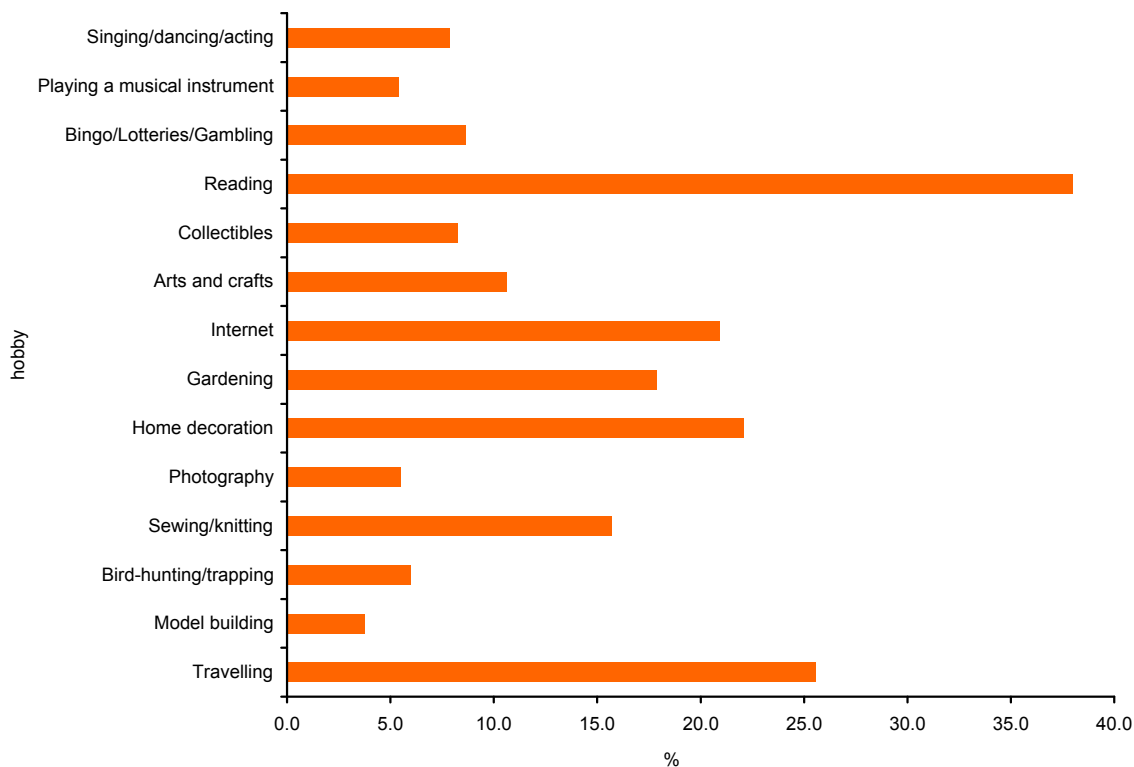

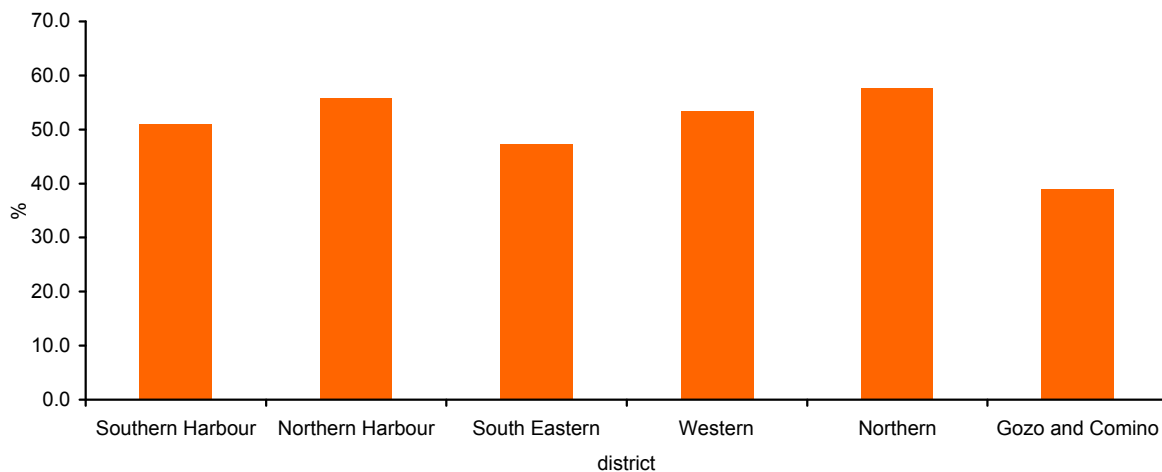

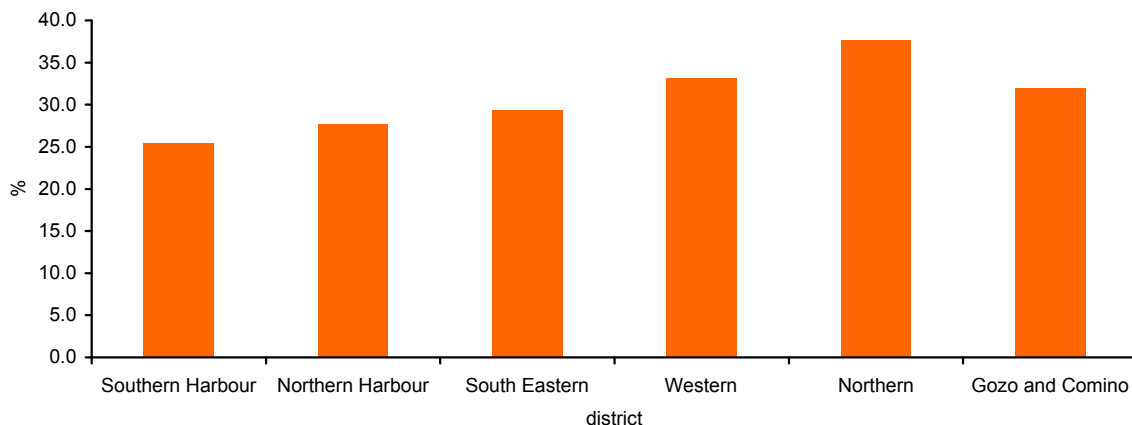

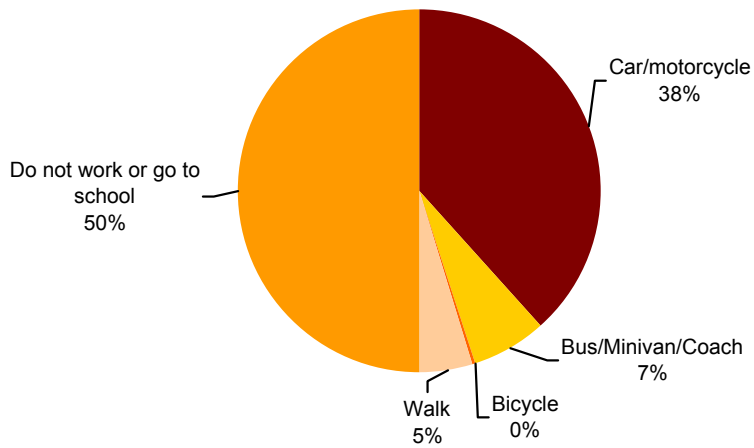

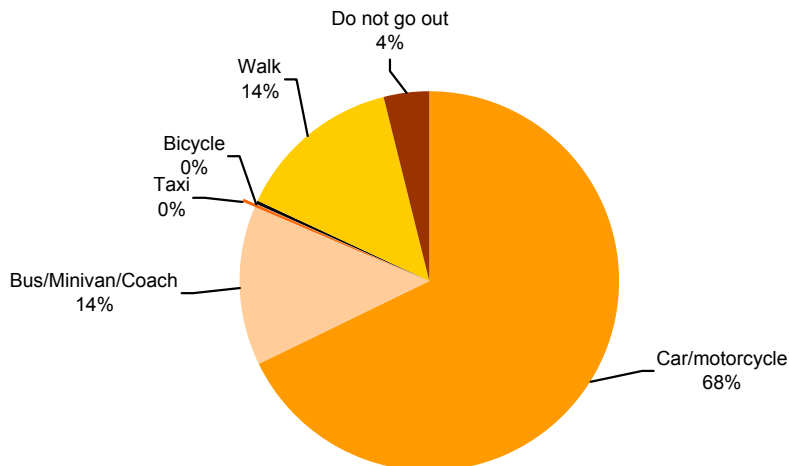

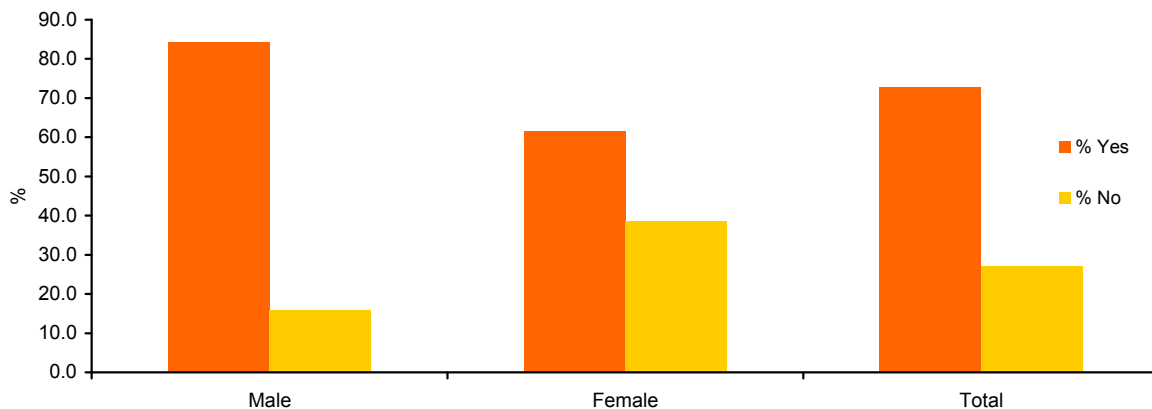

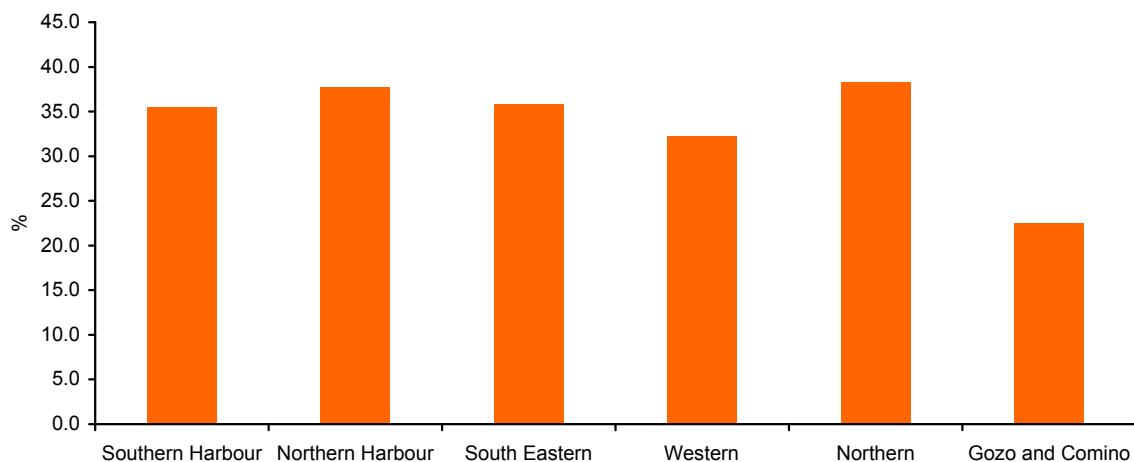

**Chart 9. Holidays locally by district**



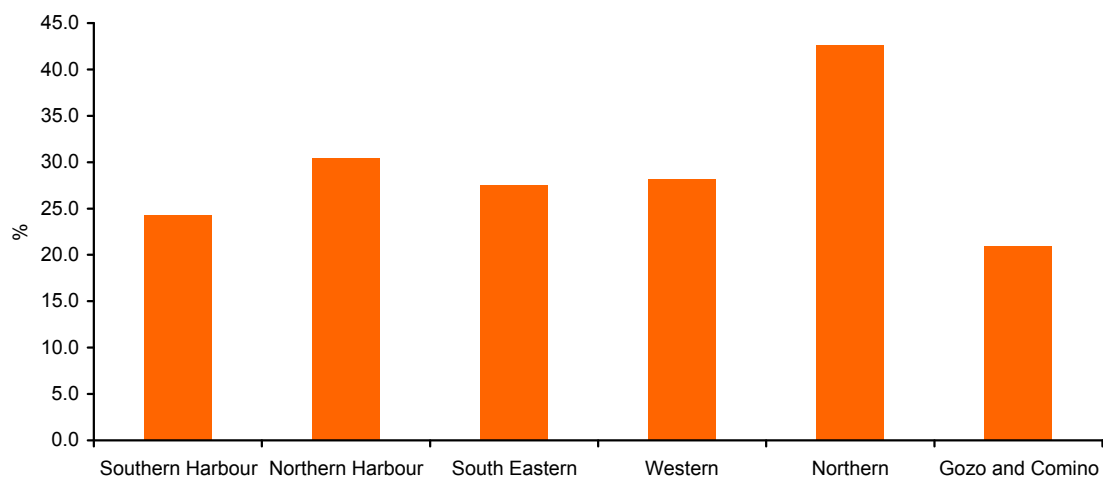

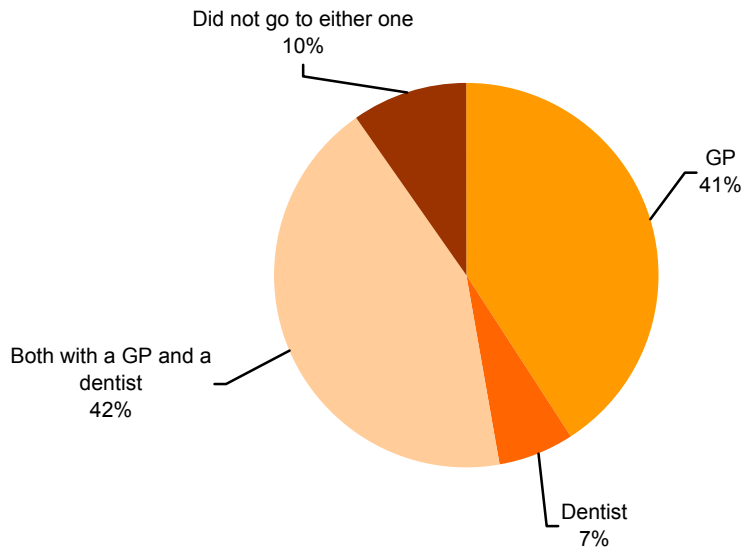

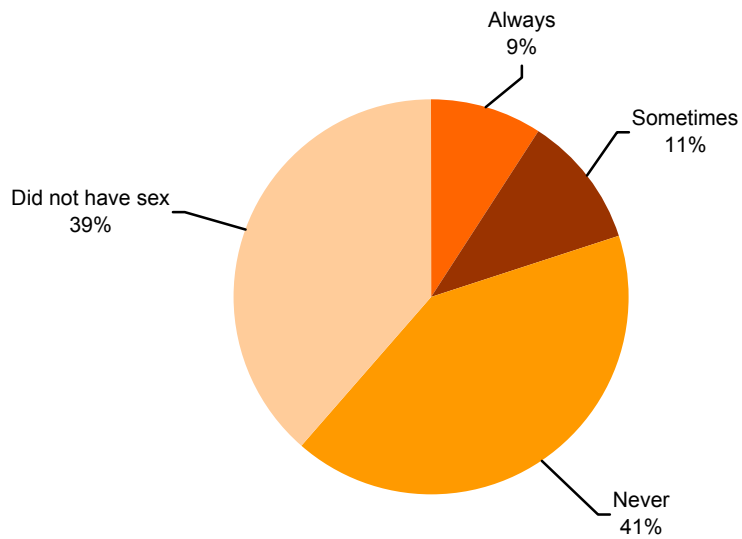

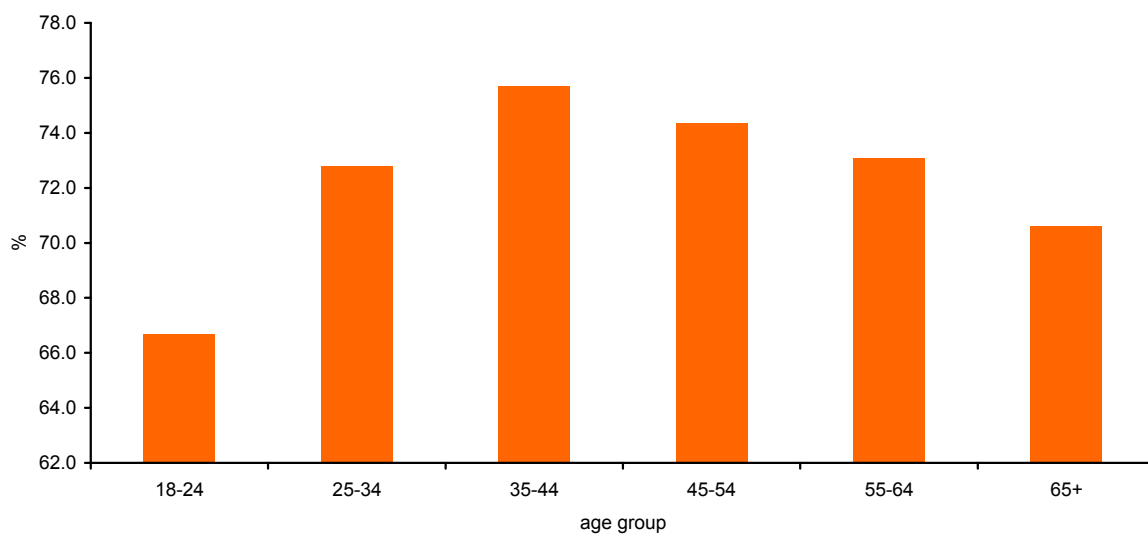

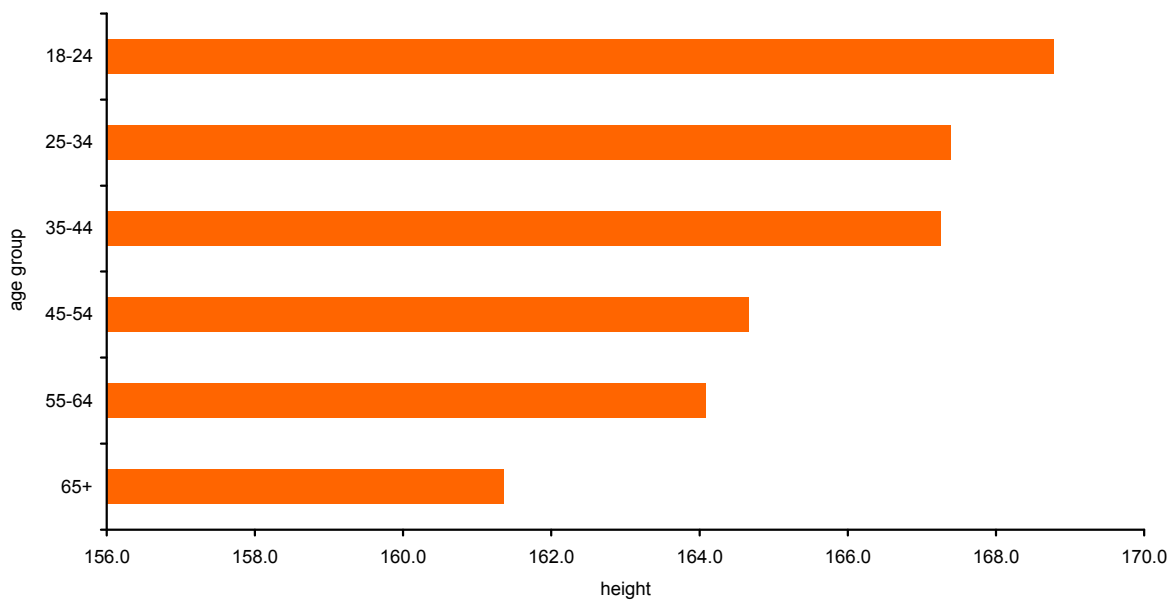

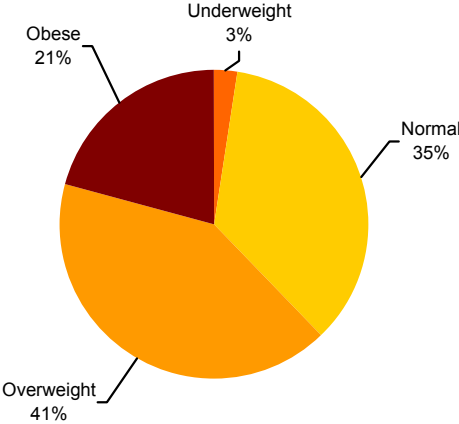

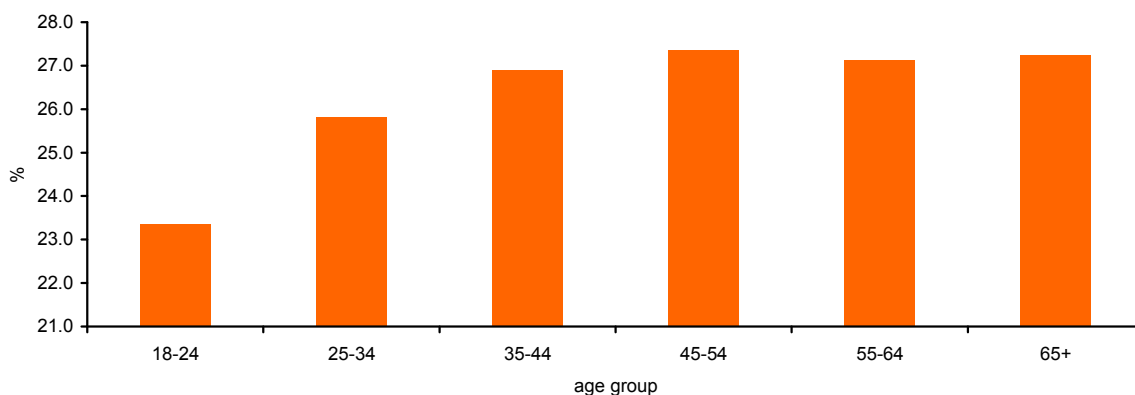

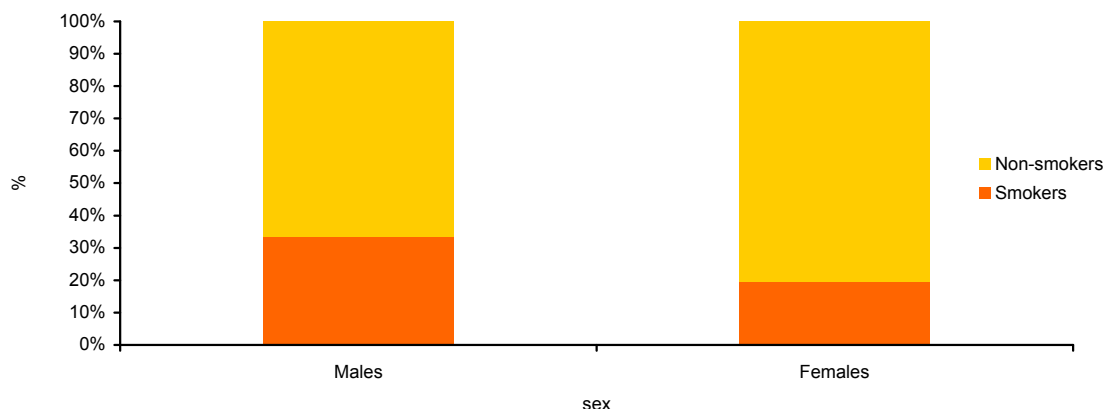

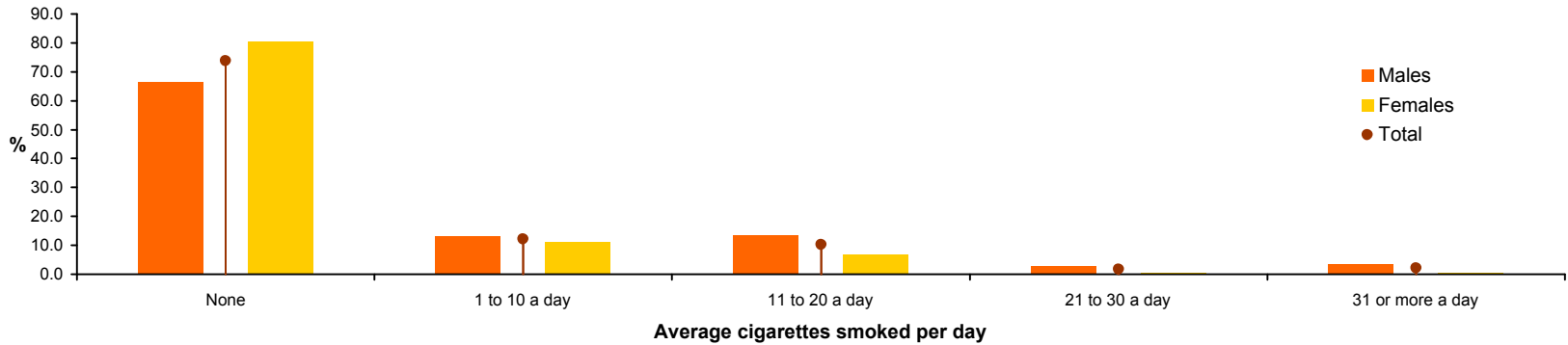

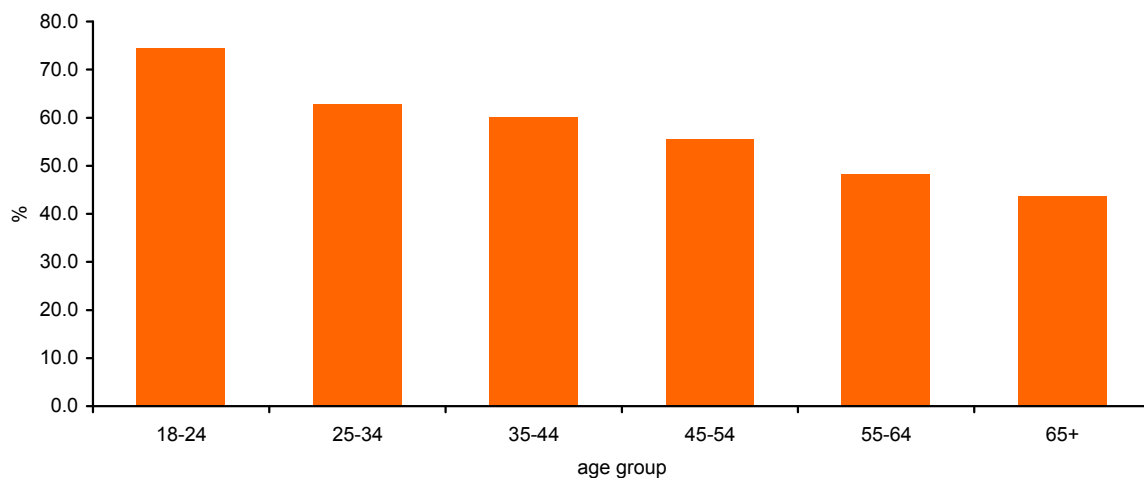

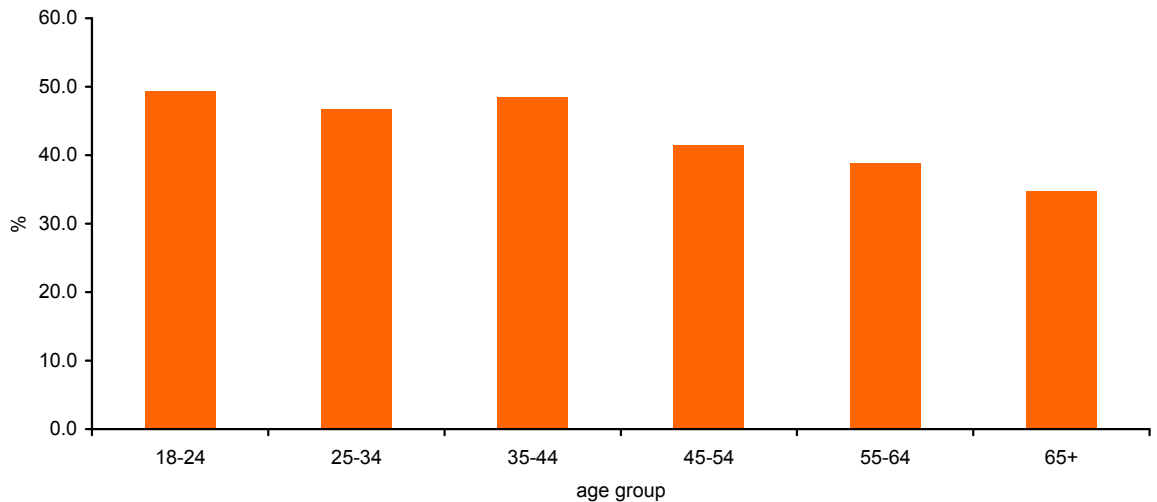

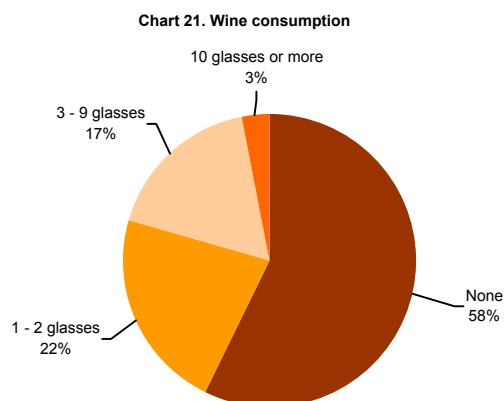

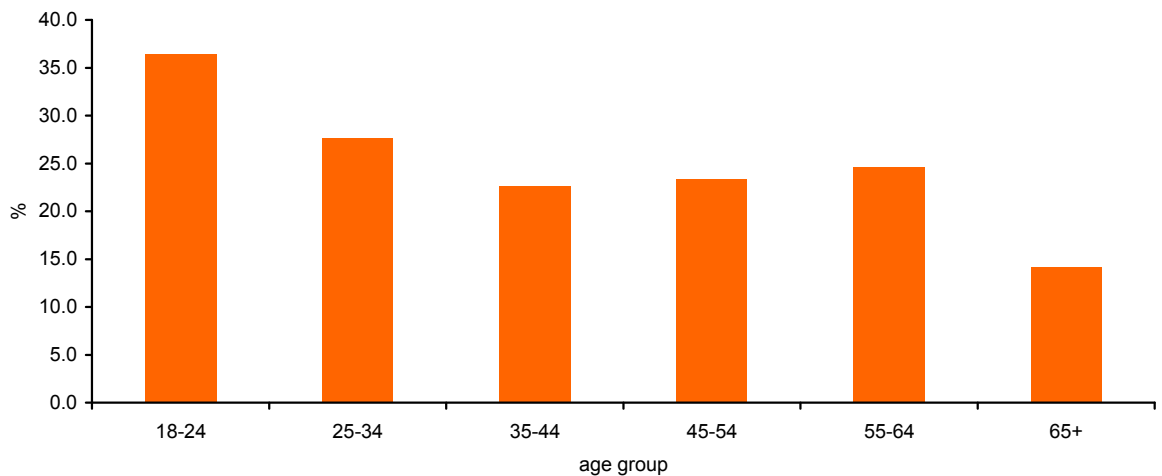

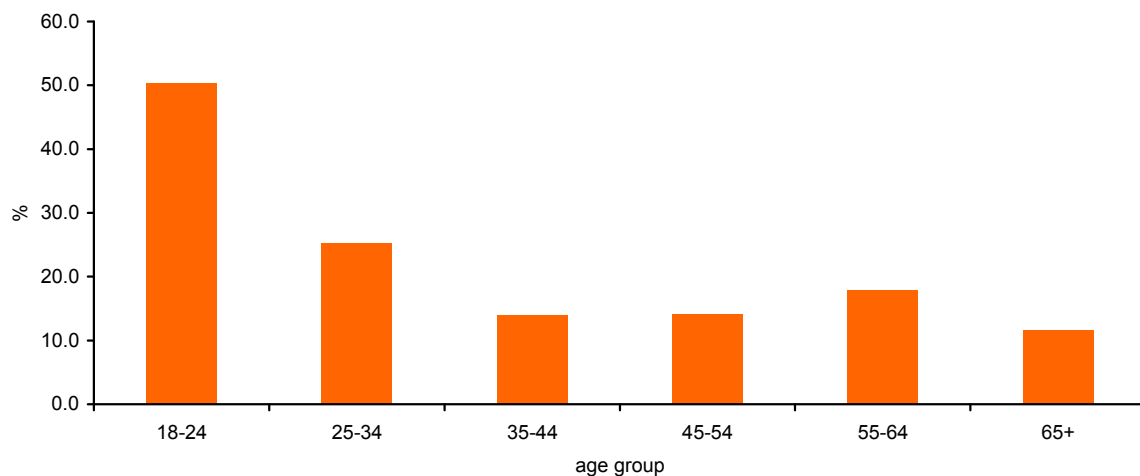

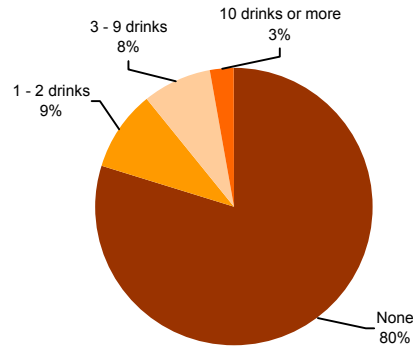

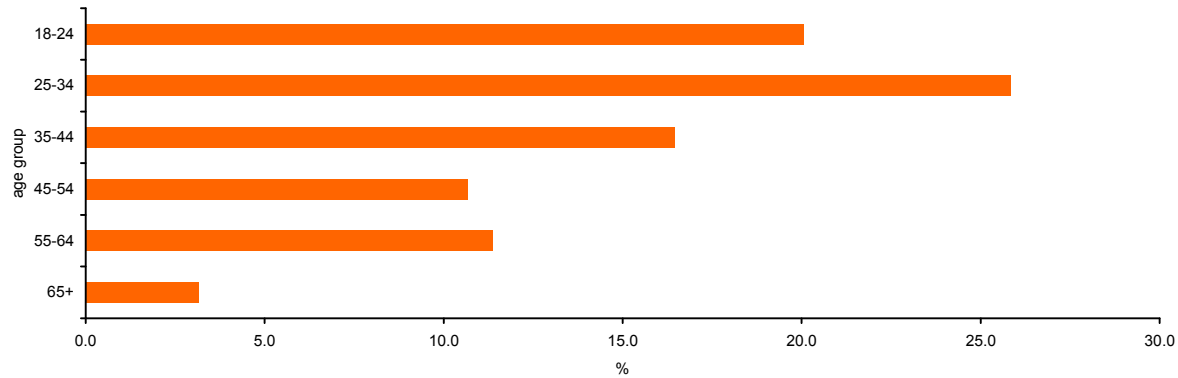

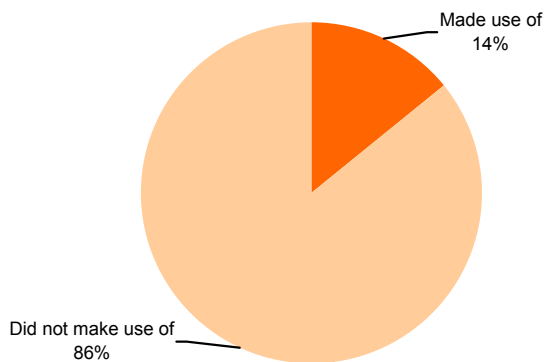

**Chart 26. Use of any prescribed tranquillizers, antidepressants or sedatives**



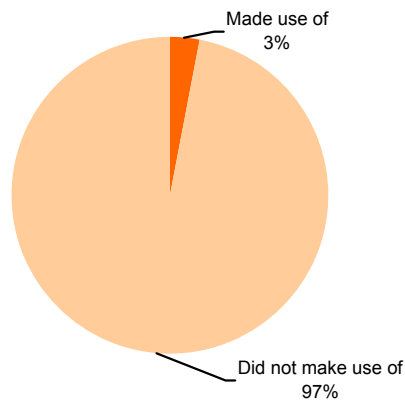

**Chart 27. Use of any unprescribed tranquillizers, antidepressants or sedatives**



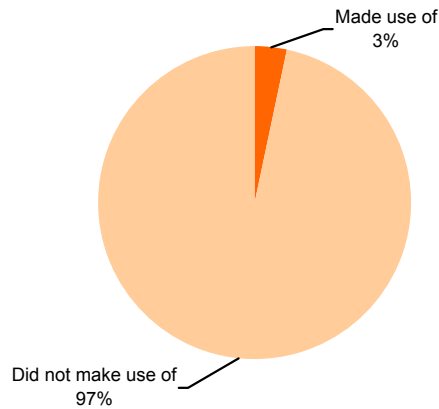

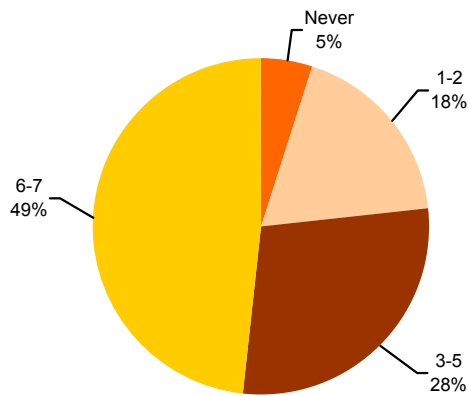

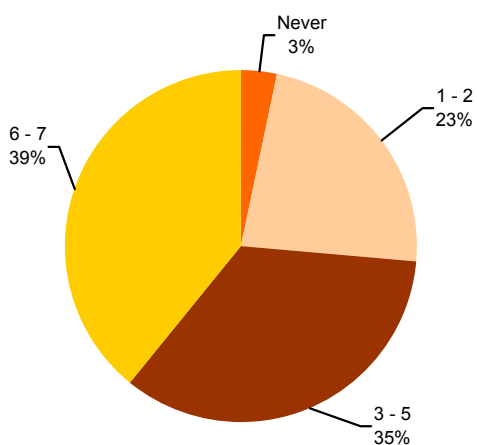

**Chart 30. Vegetable consumption**



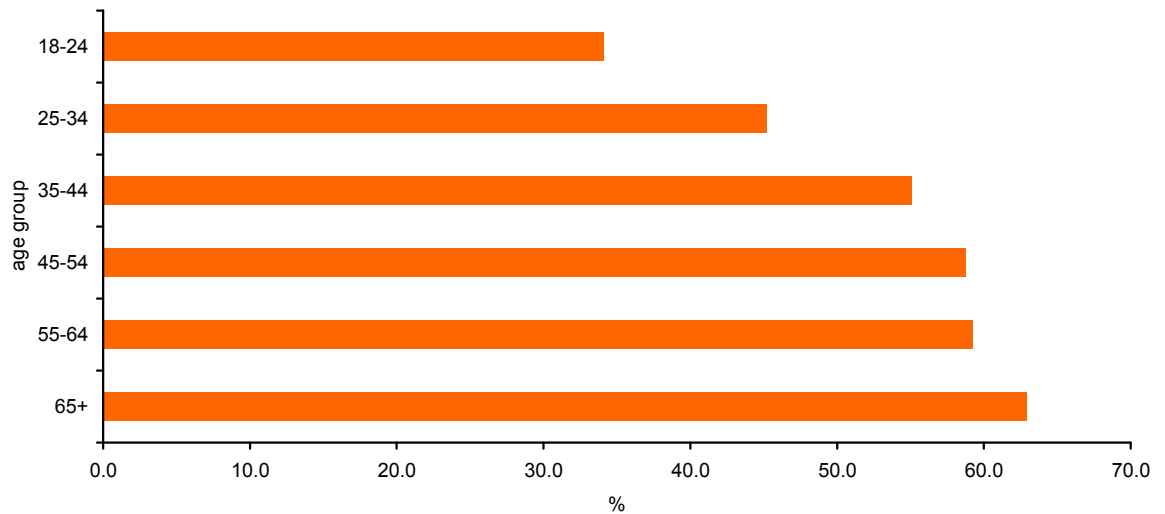

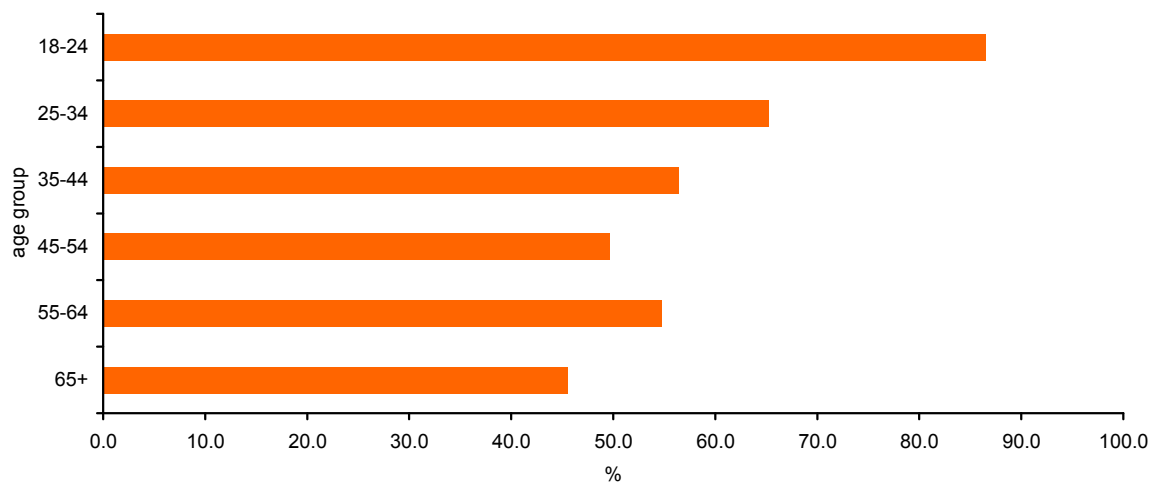
**Chart 31. Percentage of people following a diet by age group**

**Chart 32. Fried food eating by age**

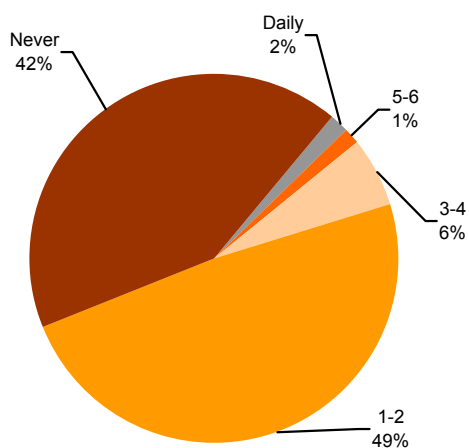

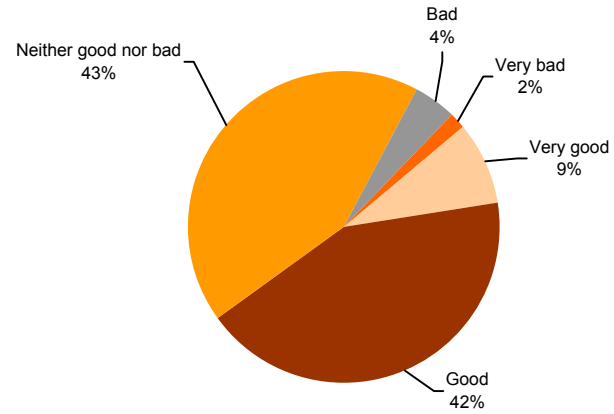

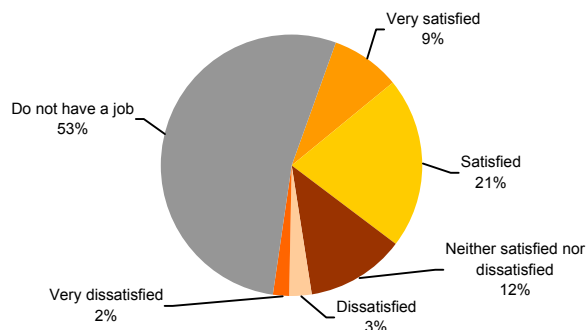

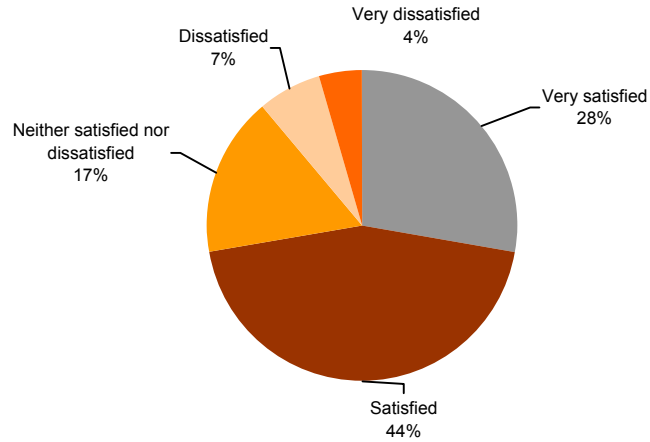

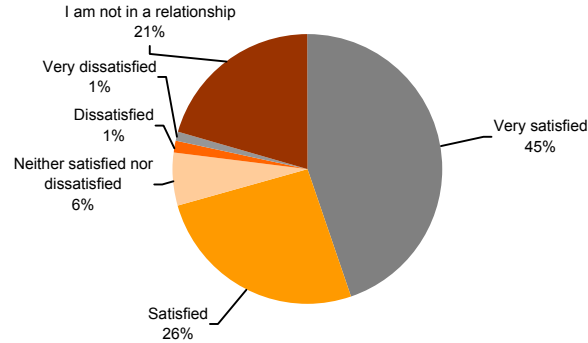

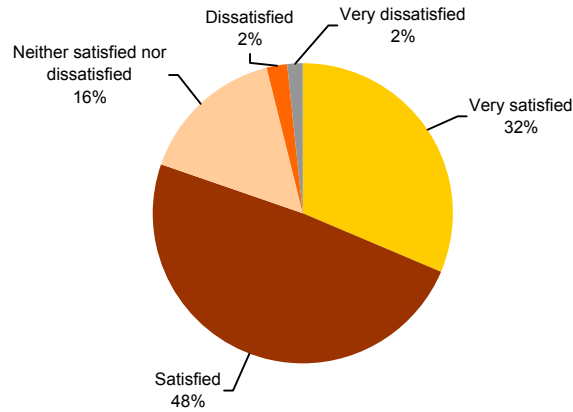
