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LABOUR STATISTICS

Gainfully Occupied Population: January 2004

Full-time Employment

In January 2004, the administrative records of the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC) indicated a drop of 175 persons in the full-time gainfully occupied over the previous month. Over a period of twelve months, that is to say from January 2003 to January 2004, the full-time gainfully occupied decreased by 1,716 persons.

In the month under review, employment in the private direct production sector decreased by 224 persons in comparisons to December 2003. In relation to the same month in the previous year, the number of the full-time gainfully occupied in the production sector decreased by 1,621 persons. Most of this decline in employment occurred in manufacturing.

The private market services sector decreased in its employment levels by 72 persons in January 2004 with comparison to December 2003. On the other hand, there was an increase of 471 persons employed in the private market services sector on a year-to-year basis. In January 2004, hotels and catering establishments dropped 131 full-time employed persons. Activities in wholesale and retail trade increased 267 persons in full-time employment over a twelve-month period.

In January 2004, the public sector increased 127 employees on its books. On a year-to-year basis, however, the public sector dropped 472 employees. Much of the decline in public sector employment in the twelve months up to January 2004 occurred in companies where the state holds majority shareholding.

Part-time Employment

In January 2004, the administrative records of the ETC indicated that there were 18,638 persons holding a part-time employment as their primary occupation. On the other hand, there were 15,171 persons who hold a part-time job in addition to their full-time employment in January 2004.

Most of the part-timers who have a part-time employment as their primary occupation are employed in services and especially the private sector. Accordingly, 14,033 persons (75.3 per cent) were employed in the market services sector in the January 2004. In the month under review, there were 7,103 men (38.1 per cent) and 11,535 women (61.9 per cent) holding a part-time job as their primary occupation.

Those holding a part-time job in conjunction to their full-time employment are equally likely to be employed in the services and especially the private sector. Actually, 11,494 of these type of part-timers (75.8 per cent) were employed in the market services sector in the January 2004. In the month under review, there were 11,508 men (75.9 per cent) and 3,663 women (24.1 per cent) holding a part-time job in addition to their full-time employment.

Registered Unemployed

In January 2004, there were 8,794 registered unemployed with the ETC. Of these 6,942 were men, while 1,852 were women. The registered unemployment rate stood at 6.1 per cent of the labour supply
