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Labour market

Gainfully Occupied Population: October 2004

Full-time Employment

The number of full-time gainfully occupied persons in October 2004 was 137,267. This means a decrease of 441 persons from the previous month and a decrease of 225 persons from October 2003.

In the month under review, employment in the private direct production sector decreased by 240 persons in comparison to September 2004. In relation to the same month in the previous year, the number of the full-time gainfully occupied persons in the private direct production sector decreased by 232 persons.

The private market services sector recorded an increase of 292 persons, in its employment levels in October 2004 when compared to September 2004. Over a period of twelve months, the number of the full-time gainfully occupied persons in the private market services sector increased by 1485.

In October 2004, a drop of 562 employees in the public sector was recorded when comparing to employment in the same sector in September 2004. On a year-to-year basis, the public sector decreased by 1485 employees.

Part-time Employment

In October 2004, there were 20,683 persons holding a part-time employment as their primary occupation. On the other hand, there were 16,267 persons who held a part-time job in addition to their full-time employment in September 2004. This results in a total of 36,950 part-time jobs in the labour market.

Registered Unemployed

In October 2004, there were 8,172 registered unemployed with the ETC. Of these 6,518 were registering under Part 1, while 1,654 were registering under Part 2 of the unemployment register.

The registered unemployment rate stood at 5.6 per cent of the labour supply. The registered unemployment rate for men stood at 6.3 per cent, whereas that for women stood at 3.9 per cent ■

2. The data in this release are to be considered as current and therefore subject to revision. Monthly data are revised in T+12.
- 3 Full / part-time status is defined by what the employer (employer or self-employed) declares in the Engagement Form which is required to be sent to the ETC upon the commencement of employment.

Definitions

Part 1 of the unemployment register: Those registering under Part 1 are either new job seekers who have left school, re-entrants into the labour market, and job losers who have been made redundant by their former employer.

Part 2 of the unemployment register: Those registering under Part 2 are either workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work out of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities or were struck off the register after an inspection by the Law Enforcement personnel.
