Retail Prices Index - December 2004

In December 2004, the Retail Prices Index went up by 0.30 per cent to 105.27 from 104.96 in the previous month.

The Food Items Index increased by 0.30 per cent to 103.47 from 103.16 in November as a result of average price increases in respect of fresh bread and fresh pastry, cheese, fresh fruits and vegetables. Average price drops were recorded in biscuits and rusks and fresh fish.

At 111.94 the Beverages and Tobacco Index increased by 0.01 per cent

The Clothing and Footwear Index went up by 2.66 per cent to 98.81 from 96.25 in November. Average price increases were recorded for men's, boy's, women's and girl's outerwear and men's and women's footwear. A decrease was recorded in babies' garments.

The Housing Index rose by 0.19 per cent over the previous month. Higher average prices for dwelling maintenance and repair services were registered.

The Household Equipment and House Maintenance Cost Index increased by 0.28 per cent to 102.49 from 102.20 in November. Average price increases were recorded for decoration articles and carpets.

The Transport and Communications Index decreased by 0.08 per cent to 106.59 from 106.68. Lower prices were registered in air transport services while higher average prices were recorded for motor cars and telephone and telephone services.

The Personal Care and Health Index went up by 0.15 per cent to 108.75. Price increases were recorded for medicines.

The Recreation and Culture Index went down by 0.03 per cent to 100.73 from 100.76 in the previous month. Lower prices in respect of plants and flowers were recorded. However, higher average prices were also registered for books and newspapers .

The Other Goods and Services index declined by 0.01 per cent to 112.76 from 112.77 in November.

Inflation Rate

In December the inflation rate stood at 2.79 per cent ■

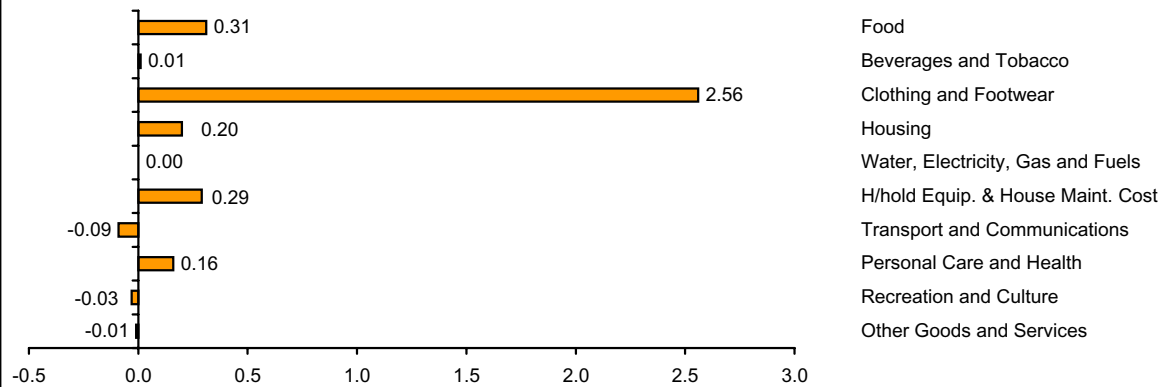

Methodological Notes

1. A new Retail Prices Index series, with base December 2002, was officially introduced as from January 2003. Price quotations in respect of the goods and services in this new index series started being collected in January 2002. As a result the NSO was in a position to compile the new index series as from January 2002. This new index series may be linked to the old index series by using a linking coefficient of 1.1914.
2. The index is compiled using a large and representative selection of more than 355 separate goods and services for which price movements are regularly measured in 30 localities throughout the country. Around 9,000 separate price quotations are used each month in compiling the index.
3. The Retail Prices Index is the main measure of inflation in Malta. It measures the average change from month to month in the prices of goods and services purchased by most households in Malta. The spending pattern on which the index is based was derived from the Household Budgetary Survey 2000/1.
4. Each monthly News Release on the Retail Prices Index shall include three different measures of inflation as follows:
 - (a) The **monthly rate** compares price levels between the two latest months. Although up-to-date, this can be affected by seasonal and other effects.
 - (b) The **annual rate** measures price changes between the current month and the same month of the previous year. This measure is responsive to recent changes in price levels but can be influenced by one-off effects in either month.
 - (c) The **12-month average rate**, used officially in Malta, overcomes the volatility of the previous two rates by comparing average Retail Prices Indices in the latest 12 months to the average of the previous 12 months. This measure is less sensitive to transient changes in prices.
5. The data in this release are not normally subject to revision.
