Labour Market

Gainfully Occupied Population: November 2005

Labour market data for November 2005, provided by the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC), indicate a drop of 368 persons in the labour supply over the same month in the preceding year. This drop was the result of an increase of 564 persons in the gainfully occupied population and a decrease of 932 persons on the unemployment register.

In this way, the labour supply stood at 145,605 in November 2005. This was distributed as follows: the gainfully occupied population amounted to 138,412, whereas the registered unemployed amounted to 7,193.

Full-time Employment within the Private Sector

The data on hand indicate that, as from November 2004 to November 2005, jobs within the private sector went up by 1,467 persons or 1.6 per cent. Accordingly, the private sector was found to be employing 93,219 persons on a full-time basis in November 2005.

The following economic activities within the production sector reported the main growth as for full-time employment: manufacturing of chemicals and chemical products (NACE 24) 91 persons and fabrication of metal products (NACE 28) 48 persons. On the other hand, the main drop in terms of full-time employment within the productive sector occurred in the following economic activities: clothing manufacturing (NACE 18) -380 persons; manufacturing of textiles (NACE 17) -165 persons; manufacturing of footwear (NACE 19) -111; manufacturing of rubber and plastic products (NACE 25) -120. On its part, the construction sector reported an increase of 447 persons in employment when compared to the same month in the preceding year.

When it comes to services activities within the private sector, as from November 2004 to November 2005, the following economic activities reported an increase in terms of full-time employment: hotels and restaurants (NACE 55) 197 persons; wholesale trade (NACE 51) 189 persons; recreational, cultural, and sporting activities (NACE 92) 149 persons. On the other hand, a decline in employment occurred in retail trade (NACE 52) 113 persons.

For November 2005, the data on hand indicates that a drop of 212 apprentices / trainees occurred within the private sector over the preceding year.

Full-time Employment within the Public Sector

In November 2005, the public sector had 903 persons less than what it had on its books in the preceding year (-2.0 per cent) . The main decline was registered in health (NACE 85) - 276; construction / public works (NACE 45) -166; and, collection, purification and distribution of water (NACE 41) -128. In contrast, employment in the education sector (NACE 80) grew by 176.

All in all, the public sector was providing full-time employment for 45,193 persons in November 2005.

Regional Distribution of Full-time Employment

A comparison of the data on Malta and Gozo for November 2005, reveals that the share of construction, health, education, public administration, hotels and restaurants, and agriculture in the creation of work in Gozo is more accentuated than it is in Malta.

Part-time Employment

In regard to part-time employment, the ETC figures for November 2005 indicate that the total amount of people with a part-time job went up by 3,826 over the same month in the preceding year. This global figure translates into 2,265 persons whose part-time job is the primary occupation and 1,561 persons whose part-time job is their secondary occupation. All in all, there were 41,150 persons who had a job in the peripheral labour market in November 2005.

In November 2005, people holding a part-time job in addition to their full-time employment mainly increased in hotels and restaurants (NACE 55) 408 persons; education (NACE 80) 161 persons; and, wholesale trade (NACE 51) 116 persons.

When it comes to those people whose part-time job is their primary occupation, the main increase happened in hotels and restaurants (NACE 55) 572 persons; education (NACE 80) 174 persons; health (NACE 85) 144 persons; and, manufacturing of food products and beverages (NACE 15) 75 persons ■

Methodological Notes

1. In line with international methodology, annual data are being presented as an average for each respective year.
2. The statistics in this release are based on the administrative records of the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC).
3. The data in this release are to be considered as current and therefore subject to revision. Monthly data are revised in T+12.
4. Full / part-time status is defined by what the employer (employer or self-employed) declares in the Engagement Form which is required to be sent to the ETC upon the commencement of employment.

Definitions

Part 1 of the unemployment register: Those registering under Part 1 are either new job seekers who have left school, re-entrants into the labour market, and job losers who have been made redundant by their former employer.

Part 2 of the unemployment register: Those registering under Part 2 are either workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work out of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities or were struck off the register after an inspection by the Law Enforcement personnel.
