Labour Market

Gainfully Occupied Population: August 2007

Labour market data for August 2007 indicate that the full-time gainfully occupied population increased by 2,227 persons while unemployment decreased by 582 persons when compared to August 2006.

This news release presents labour market data, provided by the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC), for the month of August 2007. In the month under review, the labour supply increased by 1,645 persons over the same month in 2006. The full-time gainfully occupied population increased by 2,227 persons, whereas the registered unemployed decreased by 582 persons.

In this way, the labour supply amounted to 148,963 persons. Of these, the full-time gainfully occupied population amounted to 142,373 persons, whilst the registered unemployed amounted to 6,590 persons.

Economic activities

In the twelve-months to August 2007, the economic activities which registered the main growth in full-time employment were real estate, renting and business activities (NACE 70-74) and other community, social and personal service activities (NACE 90-93). Accordingly, the sector of real estate, renting and business activities (NACE 70-74) increased 1,545 persons on its books. Among other activities, this sector includes accounting and auditing, security services and call centres. On its part, the sector of other community, social and personal service activities (NACE 90-93) reported an increase of 562 persons, as illustrated in Table 1. Besides other activities, this sector includes betting companies.

A comparison of the figures of August 2006 and August 2007, indicates an expansion in the activities of retail and wholesale trade (NACE 50-52), hotels and restaurants (NACE 55), and health and social work activities (NACE 85) as well. In fact, retail and wholesale trade registered an increase of 300 persons, hotels and restaurants registered an increase of 356 persons, and health and social work activities registered an increase of 327 persons.

On the downside, the number of the gainfully occupied persons fell in manufacturing (NACE 15-37), transport, storage and communication (NACE 60-64) and electricity, gas and water supply (NACE 40-41). In fact, manufacturing dropped 704 persons, transport, storage and communication dropped 287 persons, and electricity, gas and water supply dropped 134 persons.

Regional aspects

In August 2007, the full-time gainfully occupied persons increased by 2,128 persons in Malta as well as by 99 persons in Gozo.

A regional comparison indicates that the number of full-time gainfully persons in hotels and restaurants (NACE 55) increased both in Malta and Gozo. On the other hand, when it comes to manufacturing (NACE 15-37), the number of full-time gainfully persons increased Gozo, whereas in Malta it is on the decline.

Part-time employment

On a year-on-year basis, part-time employment rose by 3,561. Among part-timers who also hold a full-time job, there was an increase of 1,547 persons, whilst those having a part-time job as their primary occupation went up by 2,014 persons, as illustrated in Table 4 ■

Methodological Notes

1. In line with international methodology, annual data are being presented as an average for each respective year.
2. The statistics in this release are based on the administrative records of the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC).
3. The data in this release are to be considered as current and therefore subject to revision. Monthly data are revised in T+12.
4. Full/part-time status is defined by what the employer (employer or self-employed) declares in the Engagement Form which is required to be sent to the ETC upon the commencement of employment.

Definitions

Part 1 of the unemployment register: Those registering under Part 1 are either new job seekers who have left school, re-entrants into the labour market, and job losers who have been made redundant by their former employer.

Part 2 of the unemployment register: Those registering under Part 2 are either workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work out of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities or were struck off the register after an inspection by the Law Enforcement personnel.

Apprentices, trainees and students: Includes apprentices, trainees, Junior College and University students in the summer work-phase, undergraduate trainees, and trainees with fixed contracts.

Labour Supply: The sum of the full-time gainfully occupied population and the registered unemployed population.

Malta/Gozo employment: Data on regional employment differ on the basis of economic sector. Accordingly, the data of the private sector depend on employee residence, whereas the data of the public sector depend on employer information of location of its employees.
