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In August 2013, full-time employment increased by 2.6 per cent when compared to the corresponding month in 2012.

Gainfully Occupied Population: August 2013

Administrative data provided by the Employment and Training Corporation indicate that over a period of one year, the labour supply increased by 2.9 per cent, reaching 165,187. This was mainly attributed to increases in the gainfully occupied population of 3,995, and in registered unemployment of 636.

Full-Time Employment

Full-time employment in the private sector went up by 2.6 per cent with increases being recorded in the Administrative and Support Services Activities (NACE 77-82; +12.1 per cent) and in the Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities (NACE 69-75; +7.8 per cent). On the other hand, private sector employment within Construction (NACE 41-43) dropped by 3.1 per cent when compared to August 2012.

Within the public sector, year-on-year increases in full-time employment were mostly recorded within Public Administration and Defence, Compulsory Social Security (NACE 84; +3,001 persons). As shown in Table 2, these increases were mainly the result of a shift of employees from the former Ministry for Resources and Rural Affairs (NACE 41-43; -3,050 persons) to the Ministry for Sustainable Development, Environment and Climate Change (NACE 84; +1,028 persons) and the Ministry for Transport and Infrastructure (NACE 84; +1,813).

Female full-time employment increased by 2,987 persons, reaching 56,106. During the same period, males registering as working on full-time basis rose by 1,008, totalling 101,624. When compared to August 2012, the total number of employees increased by 2.8 per cent, whereas the number of self-employed went up by 1.1 per cent.

Part-Time Employment

Registered part-time employment went up by 4.6 per cent when compared to the previous year's levels. The economic activities where increases in part-time employment were registered included mainly Wholesale and Retail; Repair of Motor Vehicles (NACE 45-47; +520 persons) and the Public Administration and Defence, Compulsory Social Security (NACE 84, +497 persons). On the other hand part-time employment in Information and Communication (NACE 58-63) went down by 128 persons. This decrease was mainly attributed to a drop in employment in activities associated with Programming and Broadcasting (NACE 60; -116 persons).

In August 2013, the number of part-timers who also held a full-time job amounted to 24,427 persons, increasing by 4.0 per cent or 944 persons when compared to the corresponding month in 2012. Compared to August 2012, the number of employed whose part-time job was their primary occupation totalled 34,355, also rising by 5.0 per cent or 1,630 persons when compared to 2012 levels ■

Methodological Notes

1. In line with international methodology, annual data are being presented as an average for each respective year.
2. The statistics in this release are based on the administrative records of the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC).
3. The data in this release may be subject to revision. Monthly data are revised in the subsequent year.
4. Full/part-time status is defined by what the employer (employer or self-employed) declares in the Engagement Form which is required to be sent to the ETC upon the commencement of employment.
5. Apprentices, trainees and students are being included under their respective economic activity.

Definitions:

Part I of the unemployment register: Persons registering under Part I are either new job seekers who have left school, re-entrants into the labour market, and those who lost their job and who have been made redundant by their former employer.

Part II of the unemployment register: Persons registering under Part II are either workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities, or were struck off the register after an inspection by the Law Enforcement personnel.

Apprentices, trainees and students: Includes apprentices, trainees, Junior College and University students in the summer work-phase, undergraduate trainees, and trainees with fixed contracts.

Labour supply: The sum of the full-time jobs and the registered unemployed population. The number of part-time jobs is being excluded from the computation of this figure.

Malta/Gozo employment: Data on regional employment differ on the basis of economic sector. Accordingly, the data of the private sector depend on employee residence, whereas the data of the public sector depend on information provided by the employer regarding the location of its employees.

NACE: The statistical classification of economic activities in the European Community, abbreviated as NACE, is the nomenclature of economic activities in the European Union (EU).
