Total arrivals and nights spent in collective accommodation establishments during November advanced by 14.3 and 12.3 per cent respectively when compared to the corresponding month in 2012.

Collective Accommodation Establishments: November 2013

Cut-off date: 23 January 2014 Total arrivals in collective accommodation establishments during the month under review amounted to 102,016, while total nights spent numbered 539,606. Almost all establishments recorded increases in total nights spent, with the exception of a 0.5 per cent decline in 4-star hotels (Table 2). The largest share of guest nights was reported in 4-star hotels, accounting for 254,727 nights, or 47.2 per cent of the total.

The average length of stay in collective accommodation establishments stood at 5.3 nights, practically unchanged when compared to November 2012. The net use of bedplaces amounted to 48.2 per cent, an increase of 5.5 percentage points when compared to the corresponding month of the previous year. Moreover, all collective accommodation categories registered increases in occupancy levels.

Regional breakdown

Total arrivals in Malta numbered 96,238, an increase of 12.7 per cent over November 2012. Additionally, a rise of 11.8 per cent was recorded in the number of nights spent. The average length of stay on the mainland stood at 5.5 nights, at par with previous year's levels. The net occupancy rate went up from 43.2 per cent to 48.7 per cent.

Total arrivals and nights spent in Gozo and Comino advanced by 49.4 and 32.6 per cent when compared to the comparative month in 2012, to 5,779 and 15,512 respectively.

Capacity

On a national level, there were 142 active collective accommodation establishments during November, with a net capacity of 17,621 bedrooms and 38,607 bed-places (Table 4). On average, each establishment had 2.2 beds per room

Methodological Notes

Survey on collective accommodation establishments

- 1. The objective of the survey is to estimate the utilisation rate of bed-places of all collective accommodation establishments in Malta and Gozo. The variables collected from the survey are the following:
 - Number of residents
 - Number of non-residents
 - Nights spent by residents
 - Nights spent by non-residents
 - Number of room nights sold to foreign residents
 - Number of room nights sold to Maltese residents
 - Number of bedrooms
 - Number of bed-places
 - Number of days the establishment was closed during the month

The collection of the above variables and the calculation of occupancy levels satisfy Regulation (EU) No 692/2011.

- 2. The survey is distributed monthly to all collective accommodation establishments namely hotels, apart-hotels, questhouses and hostels.
- 3. In this release the figures for October 2013 should be considered as a second estimate while those relating to November 2013 are a first estimate thus subject to revisions in the following release.
- 4. The NSO is currently carrying out quarterly improvements on past data in view of new Regulation Requirements. As a result, past data may be subject to minor modifications.
- 5. Definitions:
 - A *bedroom* is the unit formed by one room or groups of rooms constituting an indivisible rental whole in an accommodation establishment or dwelling.
 - A bed-place in an establishment is determined by the number of persons who can stay overnight in the bed set-up in the establishment, not taking into account any extra beds that may be provided to clients on request.
 - Residents are Maltese/Gozitan residents who check in (out) of a collective accommodation establishment. A person is considered to be a Maltese/Gozitan resident if:
 - (a) S/he has lived for most of the past 12 months in Malta/Gozo;
 - (b) S/he has lived in Malta/Gozo for less than 12 months but intends to return within the year to settle into a life here.
 - Non-residents are foreigners who do not necessarily follow the definition of a tourist and check in (out) of a
 collective accommodation establishment.
 - Total arrivals are the number of residents and non-residents altogether.
 - Total nights spent refers to each night a guest actually spends or is registered to spend in a collective
 accommodation establishment.
 - Net use of bed-places is the net occupancy rate calculated for all active accommodation establishments
 net of seasonal closures and other temporary closures for renovation, police order, etc. The net use of bed
 places is the percentage of the total nights
