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In September 2013, full-time employment increased by 2.8 per cent when compared to the corresponding month in 2012.

Gainfully Occupied Population: September 2013

Administrative data provided by the Employment and Training Corporation show that over a period of one year, the labour supply increased by 3.2 per cent, reaching 165,303. This was mainly attributed to increases in the full-time gainfully occupied population of 4,342 persons and in registered unemployment of 750.

Registered Full-Time Employment

In the month under review, the Administrative and Support Services Activities (NACE 77-82) and the Education sector (NACE 85) increased by 12.4 per cent and 6.0 per cent respectively when compared to the corresponding month in 2012. Increases in full-time employment within the private sector were recorded in Administrative and Support Services Activities (NACE 77-82; +13.1 per cent) and in Human Health and Social Work Activities (NACE 86-88; +10.3 per cent). This sector also registered drops in employment in Construction activities (NACE 41-43, -2.2 per cent) when compared to 2012 levels. Within the public sector, a shift in employment was registered from Construction (NACE 41-43) to Public Administration and Defence; Compulsory Social Security (NACE 84).

The number of full-time self-employed rose by 215 when compared to September 2012. During the same period, the number of employees increased by 4,127. Male and female full-time employment went up by 1.4 per cent and 5.6 per cent respectively over 2012.

Registered Part-Time Employment

Registered part-time employment for the month under review went up by 5.1 per cent when compared to 2012 levels. The economic activities which experienced major increases were Wholesale and Retail; Repair of Motor Vehicles (NACE 45-47; +503 persons) and Public Administration and Defence; Compulsory Social Security (NACE 84; +473 persons). On the other hand, part-time employment in Information and Communication (NACE 58-63) went down by 145 persons.

In September 2013, the number of part-timers who also held a full-time job amounted to 24,311 persons; an increase of 4.2 per cent when compared to the corresponding month in 2012. Compared to September 2012, the number of employed persons whose part-time job was their primary occupation totalled 33,774 persons; an increase of 5.8 per cent or 1,840 persons when compared to 2012 levels ■

Methodological Notes

1. In line with international methodology, annual data are being presented as an average for each respective year.
2. The statistics in this release are based on the administrative records of the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC).
3. The data in this release may be subject to revision. Monthly data are revised in the subsequent year.
4. Full/part-time status is defined by what the employer (employer or self-employed) declares in the Engagement Form which is required to be sent to the ETC upon the commencement of employment.
5. Apprentices, trainees and students are being included under their respective economic activity.

Definitions:

Part I of the unemployment register: Persons registering under Part I are either new job seekers who have left school, re-entrants into the labour market, and those who lost their job and who have been made redundant by their former employer.

Part II of the unemployment register: Persons registering under Part II are either workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities, or were struck off the register after an inspection by the Law Enforcement personnel.

Apprentices, trainees and students: Includes apprentices, trainees, Junior College and University students in the summer work-phase, undergraduate trainees, and trainees with fixed contracts.

Labour supply: The sum of the full-time jobs and the registered unemployed population. The number of part-time jobs is being excluded from the computation of this figure.

Malta/Gozo employment: Data on regional employment differ on the basis of economic sector. Accordingly, the data of the private sector depend on employee residence, whereas the data of the public sector depend on information provided by the employer regarding the location of its employees.

NACE: The statistical classification of economic activities in the European Community, abbreviated as NACE, is the nomenclature of economic activities in the European Union (EU).
