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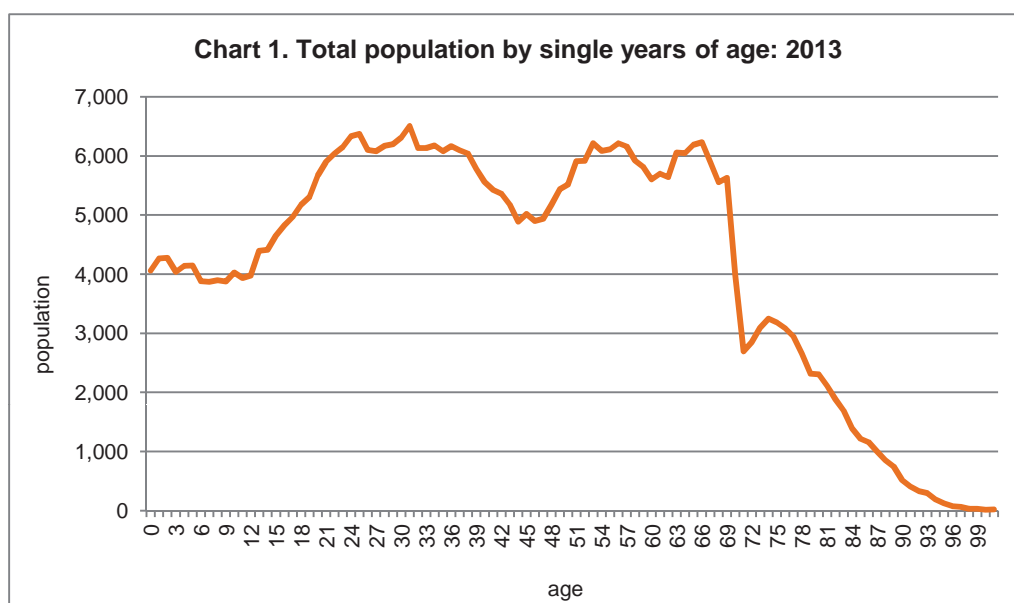
The total population of Malta at the end of 2013 stood at 425,384, up by 1.0 per cent when compared to 2012.

World Population Day 2014

The Maltese population accounted for 94.1 per cent of the total population. Persons under 18 made up 17.8 per cent of the total, while a further 17.9 per cent were aged 65 and over. Of these, 2,114 persons - 1,500 females and 614 males - were over 89 (Tables 1-2). The population increase was mainly due to net migration (immigration less emigration).

Live births registered during 2013 decreased by 2.5 per cent over the previous year (Table 4). During 2013, 129 babies, or 3.1 per cent, were born to teenage mothers. On the other hand, almost two-thirds of babies were born to mothers aged between 25 and 34. There were 1,039 births outside marriage, of which 10.8 per cent were born to teenage mothers, while 30.6 per cent were born to mothers between 20 and 24 (Table 5). Of the 3,236 deaths registered during 2013, 66.5 per cent were persons over 74 years old (Table 6).

A decrease of 245 registered marriages was observed last year: 207 in Malta and 38 in Gozo. Civil marriages accounted for 46.5 per cent of the total in 2013, an increase of 2.5 per cent over the previous year (Table 7). From the total marriages registered, 21.0 per cent were between spouses aged 25-29. More than a third (33.9 per cent) of grooms were between 25 and 29 years old while a further 28.2 per cent were aged between 30 and 34. Almost 40 per cent of brides were between 25 and 29 years old, 23.2 per cent were between 30 and 34, and a further 14.0 per cent were between 20 and 24 years of age (Table 8) ■

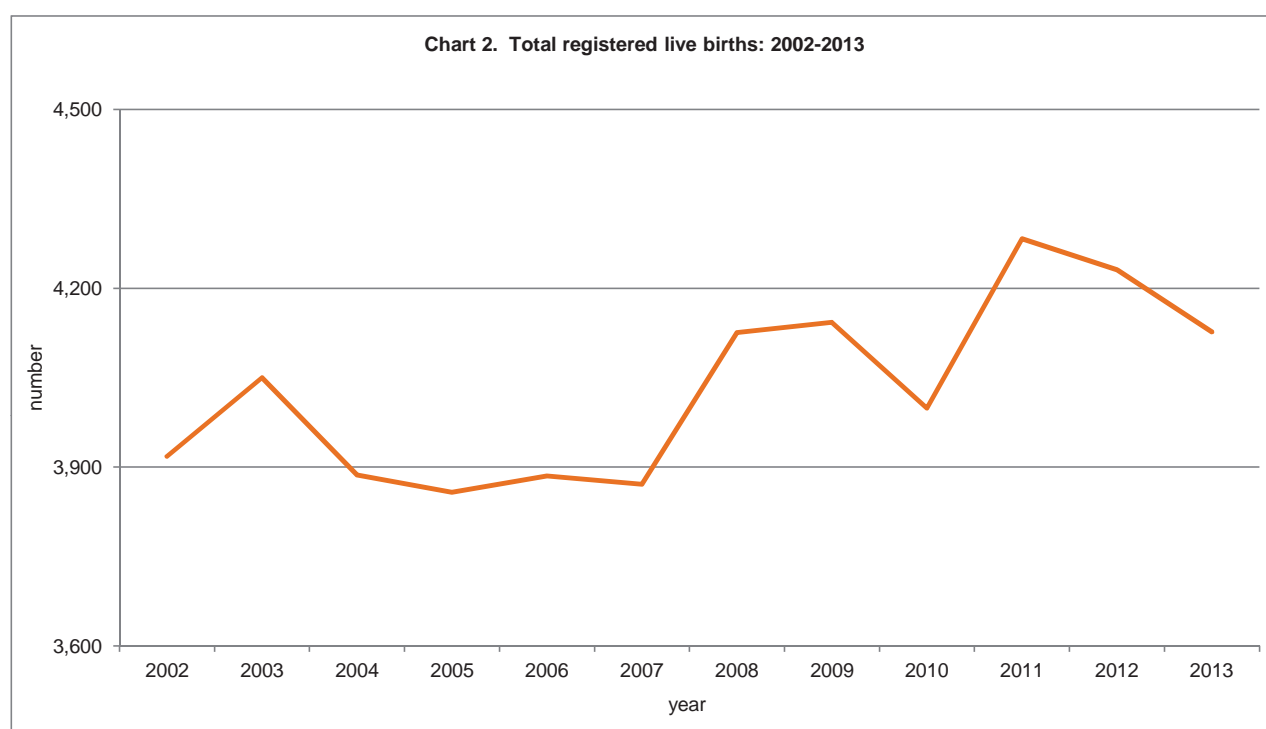

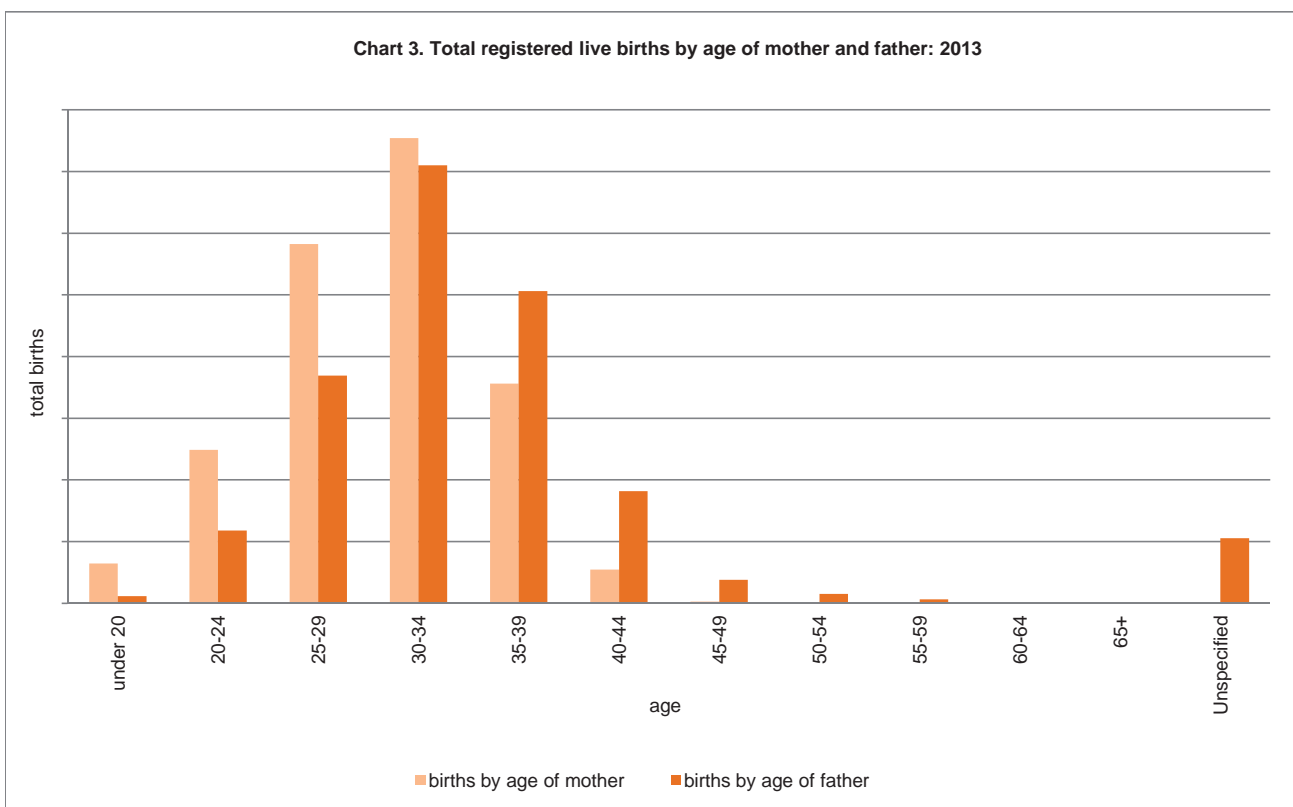

Methodological notes

1. **Total population:** all Maltese and foreign persons residing in Malta
2. Total and Maltese **mid-year populations** are calculated by averaging beginning and end-year population estimates.
3. The usual residence concept is being used for the compilation of total population figure (Tables 1, 2 and 3). The methodology used is in line with European Regulation (EU) No. 1260/2013.

'Usual residence' means the place where a person normally spends the daily period of rest, regardless of temporary absences for purposes of recreation, holidays, visits to friends and relatives, business, medical treatment or religious pilgrimage. The following persons alone shall be considered to be usual residents of a specific geographical area:

(i) those who have lived in their place of usual residence for a continuous period of at least 12 months before the reference time; or

(ii) those who arrived in their place of usual residence during the 12 months before the reference time with the intention of staying there for at least one year.
4. **Total registered live births:** include all births registered in Malta from both Maltese and foreign parents. All still births are excluded. This definition is being used in Tables 4 and 5.
5. **Total deaths:** include all registered Maltese and foreign deaths in Malta and Gozo. This count excludes tourists but includes Maltese who die abroad and who are then buried in Malta. Total deaths exclude still births (Table 6).
6. **Total registered marriages:** include all marriages registered in Malta and Gozo. This count includes marriages between non-resident foreign spouses as well. The crude marriage rate is the total number of marriages per thousand mid-year population (Tables 7 and 8).
7. **Civil marriages** include all non-religious marriages that are recognised by Maltese law.
8. The term **Third Country Nationals** refers to Non-EU Citizens.
9. Figures on **migration** have been based on register data and estimates basing on auxiliary information.
10. **Emigration** is the action by which a natural person leaves his or her usual residence in the territory of the Member State for a period that is or is expected to last a minimum of 12 months.
11. **Immigration** is the action by which a natural person establishes his or her usual residence in the territory of the Member State for a period that is or is expected to last a minimum of 12 months.
