

In February, registered full-time employment increased by 3.3 per cent compared with the corresponding month in 2013, while registered part-timers as their primary job rose by 5.8 per cent.

## Gainfully Occupied Population: January-February 2014

Administrative data provided by the ETC show that over a period of one year, the labour supply (excluding part-timers, see methodological notes) increased by 3.4 per cent, reaching 168,288. This was mainly attributed to increases in the full-time gainfully occupied population (+5,123) and in registered unemployment (+474) (Table 1).

### Registered Full-Time Employment

In the month under review, the Public Administration and Defence, Compulsory Social Security (NACE 84) and the Administrative and Support Service Activities (NACE 77-82) sectors contributed mostly to the increase in employment. These increases were partly counteracted by drops in employment, which were registered mostly within the Construction (NACE 41-43) and the Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management and Remediation Activities (NACE 36-39) sectors. Full-time employment within the private sector increased by 2.9 per cent, while that within the public sector increased by 4.3 per cent (Table 2).

The number of persons registered as full-time self-employed rose by 353 when compared with February last year, while the number of persons registered as employees increased by 4,770. Male and female full-time employment went up by 2.1 per cent and 5.4 per cent respectively over 2013 levels (Table 2).

### Registered Part-Time Employment

Registered part-time employment for February went up by 5.3 per cent compared to last year. The sector that contributed mostly to this increase was the Wholesale and Retail Trade; Repair of Motor Vehicles and Motor Cycles (NACE 45-47, +540 persons). Drops in part-time employment were registered in Information and Communication (NACE 58-63, -163 persons) (Table 3). In February, the number of part-timers who also held a full-time job amounted to 24,337, up by 4.6 per cent compared to the corresponding month in 2013. Employed persons whose part-time job was their primary occupation totalled 33,443; up by 5.8 per cent or 1,820 persons ■

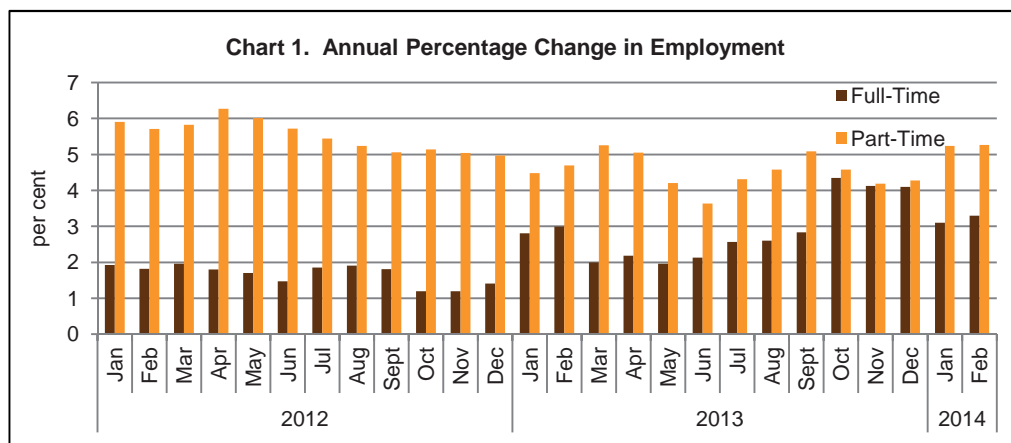

## Methodological Notes

1. In line with international methodology, annual data are being presented as an average for each respective year.
2. The statistics in this release are based on the administrative records of the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC).
3. The data in this release may be subject to revision. Monthly data are revised in the subsequent year.
4. Full/part-time status is defined by what the employer (employer or self-employed) declares in the Engagement Form which is required to be sent to the ETC upon the commencement of employment.
5. As from January 2013, the number of apprentices, trainees and students are no longer being included under their respective economic activity.
6. GOP statistics pertaining to the last quarter of 2013 have been updated by ETC, and are therefore being revised in this release.

## Definitions:

- **Part 1 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 1 are either new job seekers who have left school, re-entrants into the labour market, and job losers who have been made redundant by their former employer.
- **Part 2 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 2 are either workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work out of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities or were struck off the register after an inspection by the Law Enforcement
- **Apprentices, trainees and students:** Includes apprentices, trainees, Junior College and University students in the summer work-phase, undergraduate trainees, and trainees with fixed contracts.
- **Labour Supply:** The sum of the full-time gainfully occupied population and the registered unemployed population.
- **Malta/Gozo employment:** Data on regional employment differ on the basis of economic sector. Accordingly, the data of the private sector depend on employee residence, whereas the data of the public sector depend on employer information of location of its employees.
