In July, registered full-time employment increased by 3.6 per cent when compared to the corresponding month last year, while registered part-time employment as a primary job rose by 6.3 per cent.

## Gainfully Occupied Population: July 2014

Administrative data provided by the ETC show that over a period of one year, the labour supply (excluding part-timers, see methodological notes) increased by 3.2 per cent, reaching 171,702. This was mainly attributed to an increase in the full-time gainfully occupied population (+5,803) and a drop in registered unemployment (-464) (Table 1).

### Registered Full-Time Employment

In the month under review, Administrative and Support Service Activities (NACE 77-82) and the Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities (NACE 69-75) contributed mostly to the increase in employment, compared to the corresponding month last year (refer also to methodological note 6). Registered full-time employment in the private sector went up by 3,756 persons, to 120,762. Public sector full-time employment increased by 2,047 persons to 44,106 (Table 2).

The number of persons registered as full-time self-employed rose by 429 when compared to July last year, while the number of persons registered as employees increased by 5,374. Full-time employment for males and females went up by 2.6 per cent and 5.5 per cent respectively over 2013 levels (Table 2).

### Registered Part-Time Employment

Registered part-time employment in July went up by 5.8 per cent when compared to last year. The sectors that contributed mostly to the overall increase in part-time employment were Education (NACE 85, +623) followed by Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles (NACE 45-47, +619 persons) (Table 3).

In July, the number of part-timers who also held a full-time job amounted to 25,014, up by 5.1 per cent when compared to the corresponding month last year. Employed persons whose part-time job was their primary occupation totalled 36,672, up by 6.3 per cent, or 2,175 persons, when compared to 2013 levels (Table 4) ■

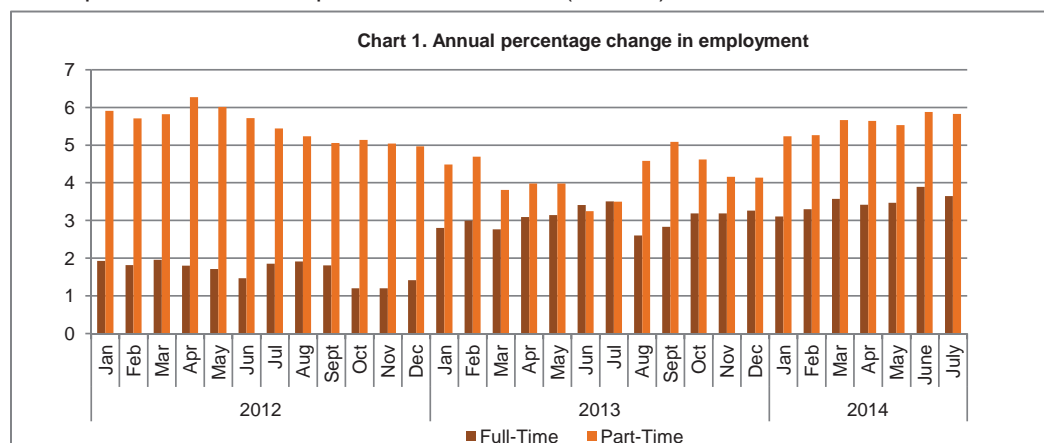

## Methodological Notes

1. In line with international methodology, annual data are being presented as an average for each respective year.
2. The statistics in this release are based on the administrative records of the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC).
3. The data in this release may be subject to revision. Monthly data are revised in the subsequent year.
4. Full/part-time status is defined by what the employer (employer or self-employed) declares in the Engagement Form which is required to be sent to the ETC upon the commencement of employment.
5. Apprentices, trainees and students are being included under their respective economic activity.
6. Year-on-year increases in full-time employment within Public Administration and Defence Compulsory Social Security (NACE 84) were primarily the result of a classification shift in public sector employment from Construction (NACE 41-43) due to a transfer of employees from the former Ministry for Resources and Rural Affairs, to either the Ministry of Sustainable Development, Environment and Climate Change or the Ministry for Transport and Infrastructure. Thus the drop in the number of employees in Construction (NACE 41-45) resulted in an increase in the number of employed in Public Administration and Defence, Compulsory Social Security (NACE 84). This change was first recorded in the Gainfully Occupied Population: August 2013 (News Release no: 007/2014 published on the 13 January 2014).
7. Gainfully occupied population data for January-July 2013 includes ex-MRRA workers under Construction (NACE 41-43). Following changes in ministerial responsibilities, these workers were shifted to a new ministry with a different economic activity, namely Public administration and defence; compulsory social security (NACE 84). As a result, there was a change in the way this group of employees was considered in the course of 2013, resulting in a break in comparability in the time series within these areas of economic activity. For this reason, the average number of employees for NACE 41-43 and NACE 84 is not being computed.

The NSO is currently working with its main data providers in order to eliminate these inconsistencies in the time series and plans to publish revised and statistically adjusted time series data on registered employment in the coming months.

## Definitions:

- **Part 1 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 1 are either new job seekers who have left school, re-entrants into the labour market, and job losers who have been made redundant by their former employer.
- **Part 2 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 2 are either workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work out of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities or were struck off the register after an inspection by the Law Enforcement
- **Apprentices, trainees and students:** Includes apprentices, trainees, Junior College and University students in the summer work-phase, undergraduate trainees, and trainees with fixed contracts.
- **Labour Supply:** The sum of the full-time gainfully occupied population and the registered unemployed population.
- **Malta/Gozo employment:** Data on regional employment differ on the basis of economic sector. Accordingly, the data of the private sector depend on employee residence, whereas the data of the public sector depend on employer information of location of its employees.
