

In August 2014, registered full-time employment increased by 3.7 per cent when compared to the corresponding month in 2013, while registered part-time employment as a primary job rose by 8.6 per cent.

## Gainfully Occupied Population: August 2014

Administrative data provided by the ETC show that over a period of one year, the labour supply (excluding part-timers, see methodological notes) increased by 3.1 per cent, reaching 171,432. This was mainly attributed to an increase in the full-time gainfully occupied population (+5,871) and a drop in registered unemployment (-759) (Table 1).

### Registered Full-Time Employment

In the month under review, Administrative and Support Service Activities (NACE 77-82) and Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities (NACE 69-75) contributed mostly to the increase in employment, compared to the corresponding month in 2013. Registered full-time employment in the private sector went up by 3,793 persons, to 120,668. Public sector full-time employment increased by 2,078 persons to 44,066 (Table 2).

The number of persons registered as full-time self-employed rose by 411 when compared to August 2013, while the number of persons registered as employees increased by 5,460. Full-time employment for males and females went up by 2.6 per cent and 5.6 per cent respectively over 2013 levels (Table 2).

### Registered Part-Time Employment

Registered part-time employment in August 2014 went up by 7.7 per cent when compared to August 2013. The sectors that contributed most to the overall increase in part-time employment were Public Administration and Defence; Compulsory Social Security (NACE 84, +1,429) followed by Education (NACE 85, +596) (Table 3).

The number of part-timers who also held a full-time job amounted to 24,841, up by 6.4 per cent when compared to the corresponding month in 2013. Employed persons whose part-time job was their primary occupation totalled 36,899, up by 8.6 per cent or 2,915 persons, when compared to 2013 levels (Table 4) ■

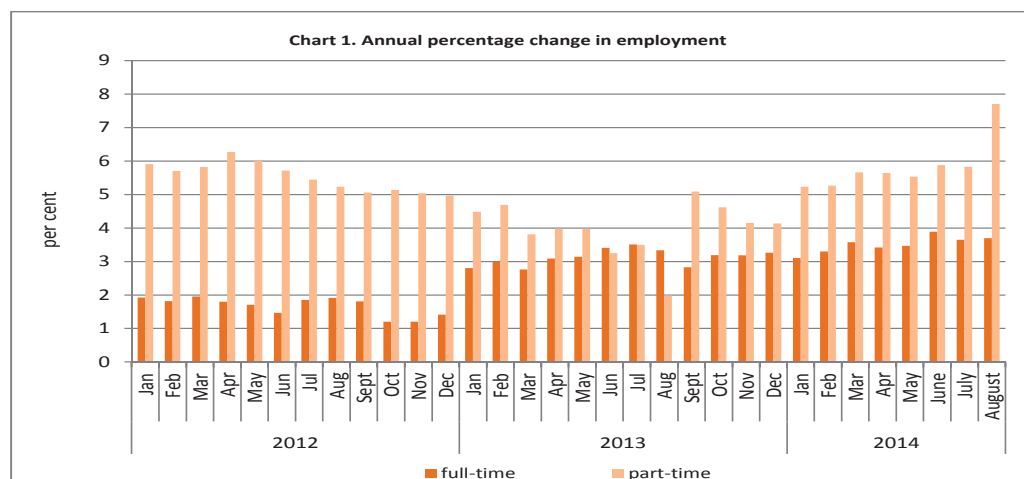

## Methodological Notes

1. Data in this release are based on administrative records of the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC).
2. The information contained in this release may be subject to revision. Monthly data are revised in the subsequent year.
3. Full-time and part-time status is defined by what the employer (employer or self-employed) declares in the Engagement Form which is required to be sent to the ETC upon the commencement of employment.
4. Apprentices, trainees and students are also included under their respective economic activity.
5. **Definitions:**
  - **Part 1 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 1 are either new job seekers who have left school, re-entrants into the labour market, or job losers who have been made redundant by their former employer.
  - **Part 2 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 2 are either workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work out of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities or were struck off the register following an inspection by the Law Enforcement personnel.
  - **Apprentices, trainees and students:** Includes apprentices, trainees, Junior College and University students in the summer work-phase, undergraduate trainees, and trainees with fixed contracts.
  - **Labour Supply:** Full-time gainfully occupied population and the registered unemployed population.
  - **Malta/Gozo employment:** Data on regional employment differ on the basis of economic sector. Accordingly, private sector data depend on employee residence whereas public sector data depend on employees' location information supplied by the employer.
