

In November 2014, registered full-time employment increased by 3.8 per cent when compared to the corresponding month of the previous year.

Gainfully Occupied Population: November 2014

Administrative data provided by the ETC show that over a period of one year, the labour supply (excluding part-timers, see methodological notes) increased by 2.9 per cent, reaching 171,956. This was mainly attributed to an increase in the full-time gainfully occupied population (6,022) and a drop in registered unemployment (1,138) (Table 1).

Registered full-time employment

In November 2014, administrative and support service activities (NACE 77-82) and professional, scientific and technical activities (NACE 69-75) contributed mostly to the increase in employment, compared to November 2013 (Table 1). Registered full-time employment in the private sector went up by 3,876 persons to 120,964. Public sector full-time employment increased by 2,146 persons to 44,491 (Table 2).

The number of persons registered as full-time self-employed rose by 382 when compared to November 2013, while the number of persons registered as employees increased by 5,640. Full-time employment for males and females went up by 2.8 per cent and 5.5 per cent respectively over 2013 levels (Table 2) ■

Note on registered part-time employment

The Employment and Training Corporation is undertaking checks and updates on its employment databases. This exercise is affecting registered part-time employment. In view of this, figures on part-time employment in this release are being published only for November 2014. No comparative figures for past months are being provided. Users are therefore advised that all part-time employment data in this release are not comparable to counterpart data included in previous releases. This situation will prevail for the duration of the updating exercise. Annual averages are still provided, but users should note that there is a break in series and these figures should not be compared with the monthly data provided.

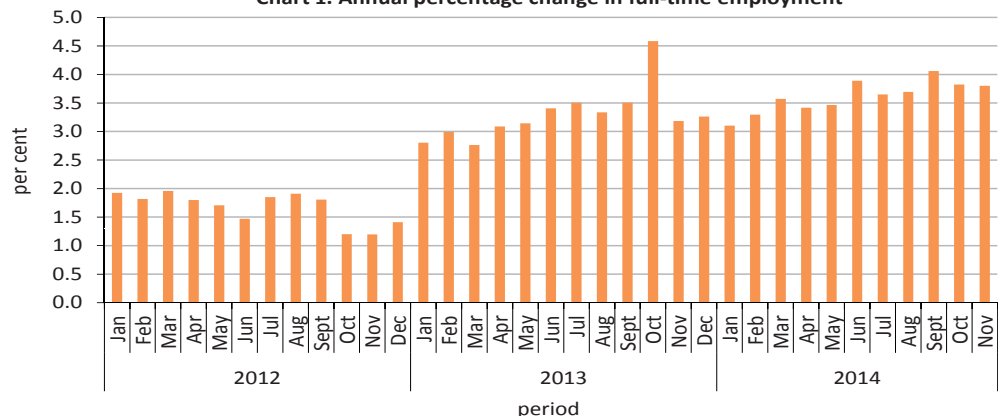
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Chart 1. Annual percentage change in full-time employment

Methodological Notes

1. Data in this release are based on administrative records of the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC). The data are classified according to the NACE Rev. 2 classification of economic activity.
2. The information contained in this release may be subject to revision. Monthly data are revised in the subsequent year.
3. Full-time and part-time status is defined by what the employer (or self-employed person) declares in the Engagement Form which is required to be sent to the ETC upon the commencement of employment.
4. Registered part-time data are currently being revised, and the monthly figures presented here are not comparable with those in previous releases and with the annual average figures presented in this release.
5. Apprentices are also included under their respective economic activity.
6. **Definitions:**
 - **Part 1 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 1 are either new job seekers, re-entrants into the labour market, or job losers who have been made redundant by their former employer.
 - **Part 2 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 2 are either workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work out of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities or were struck off the register following an inspection by the Law Enforcement personnel.
 - **Apprentices:** Includes apprentices, trainees, Junior College and University of Malta students in the summer work-phase, undergraduate trainees, and trainees with fixed contracts.
 - **Labour Supply:** Full-time gainfully occupied population and the registered unemployed population.
 - **Malta/Gozo employment:** Data on regional employment differ on the basis of economic sector. Accordingly, private sector data depend on employee residence whereas public sector data depend on employees' location information supplied by the employer.
7. Gainfully occupied population data for January-July 2013 includes ex-MRRA workers under Construction (NACE 41-43). Following changes in ministerial responsibilities, these workers were shifted to a new ministry with a different economic activity, namely Public administration and defence; compulsory social security (NACE 84). As a result, there was a change in the way this group of employees was considered for statistical purposes in the course of 2013, resulting in a break in comparability in the time series within these areas of economic activity. For this reason, the average number of employees for NACE 41-43 and NACE 84 is not being computed.

The NSO is currently working with its main data providers in order to eliminate these inconsistencies in the time series and plans to publish revised and statistically adjusted time series data on registered employment in the coming months.
