

Errata Corrige: Full-time equivalent (FTE) figures in the footnote to Table 2 were revised to 41,547 for January 2015 (from 40,795) and to 41,212 for February 2015 (from 40,536). Online documents were amended on 17 July 2015 at 14:00 hrs.

In February 2015, registered full-time employment increased by 4.1 per cent when compared to the corresponding month of the previous year.

Gainfully Occupied Population: January-February 2015

Administrative data provided by the ETC show that over a period of one year, the labour supply (excluding part-timers) increased by 3.0 per cent, reaching 173,549. This was mainly due to an increase of 6,622 persons in the full-time gainfully occupied population and a drop of 1,563 persons in registered unemployment (Table 1).

Registered full-time employment

In February 2015, administrative and support service activities (NACE 77-82) and professional, scientific and technical activities (NACE 69-75) contributed mostly to the increase in employment, compared to February 2014 (Table 1). Registered full-time employment in the private sector went up by 6,180 persons to 123,467. Public sector full-time employment increased by 442 persons to 43,892 (Table 2).

The number of persons registered as full-time self-employed rose by 555 when compared to February 2014, while the number of persons registered as employees increased by 6,067. Full-time employment for males and females went up by 3.2 per cent and 5.8 per cent respectively over 2014 levels (Table 2) ■

Note on registered part-time employment

The Employment and Training Corporation is undertaking checks and updates on its employment databases. This exercise is affecting registered part-time employment. In view of this, figures on part-time employment in this release are being published only for January and February 2015. No comparative figures for past months are being provided. Users are therefore advised that all part-time employment data in this release are not comparable to counterpart data included in previous releases. This situation will prevail for the duration of the updating exercise. Annual averages are still provided, but users should note that there is a break in series and these figures should not be compared with the monthly data provided.

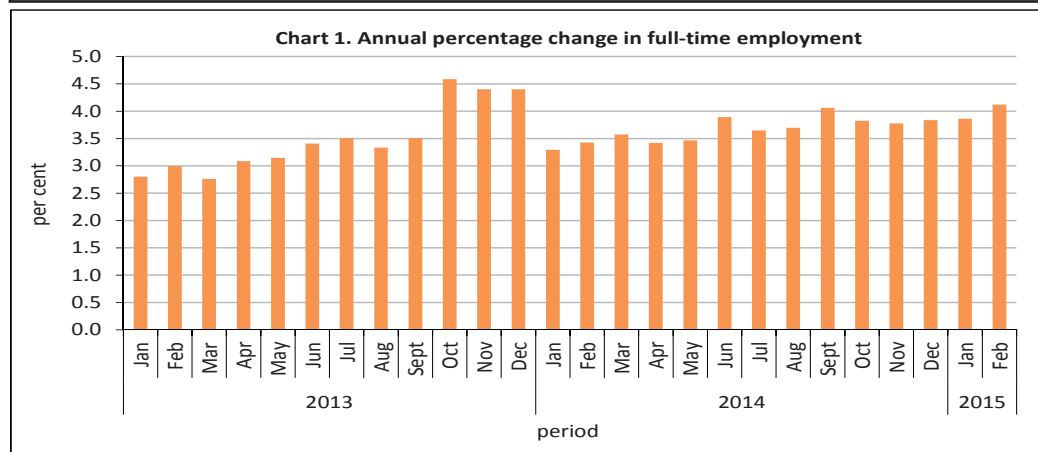

Methodological Notes

1. The source for the data provided in this release, including the relevant classifications, is based on administrative records of the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC).
2. The information contained in this release may be subject to revision. Monthly data are revised in the subsequent year.
3. Full-time and part-time status is defined by what the employer (or self-employed person) declares in the Engagement Form which is required to be sent to the ETC upon the commencement of employment.
4. Registered employment data is currently being revised by ETC. The updated series pertaining to the period 2010-2014 will be issued in the last quarter of 2015.
5. Apprentices are also included under their respective economic activity.
6. **Definitions:**
 - **Labour Supply:** Full-time gainfully occupied population and the registered unemployed population.
 - **Full-time equivalent (FTE):** employment in full time equivalent is a conversion method used to measure the number of employees according to the number of hours worked. When using FTE a full time employee working a 40 hour week is equivalent to 1.0, whereas a person who works 20 hours per week is equivalent to 0.5. Table 2 of this release includes persons who work full time, persons on a full time with reduced hours basis and full time employees who are on unpaid leave. When converting these figures into FTE, full time employees are considered as 1 whereas persons working full time with reduced hours or who are on unpaid leave are considered according to the hours worked. The use of full-time equivalent is being restricted to public sector employment so as not to burden private sector employers to inform the competent national authorities of the working hours of each of their employees and of any changes in such working hours. In addition, FTE data is being compiled from January 2015 onwards. FTE data in the public sector as shown in this release are based on the administrative records of the Public Administration and Human Resources Office of the Office of the Prime Minister.
 - **Apprentices:** Includes apprentices, trainees, Junior College and University of Malta students in the summer work-phase, undergraduate trainees, and trainees with fixed contracts.
 - **Malta/Gozo employment:** Data on regional employment differ on the basis of economic sector. Accordingly, private sector data depend on employee residence whereas public sector data depend on employees' location information supplied by the employer.
 - **Part 1 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 1 are either new job seekers, re-entrants into the labour market, or job losers who have been made redundant by their former employer.
 - **Part 2 of the unemployment register:** Persons registering under Part 2 are either workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work out of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities or were struck off the register following an inspection by the Law Enforcement personnel.
7. Gainfully occupied population data for January-July 2013 includes ex-MRRA workers under Construction (NACE 41-43). Following changes in ministerial responsibilities, these workers were shifted to a new ministry with a different economic activity, namely Public administration and defence; compulsory social security (NACE 84). As a result, there was a change in the way this group of employees was considered for statistical purposes in the course of 2013, resulting in a break in comparability in the time series within these areas of economic activity. For this reason, the average number of employees for NACE 41-43 and NACE 84 is not being computed.

The correct classification of all government entities, departments and ministries was taken on board by the administrative sources used for this release and, as a consequence, data in respect of 2015 reference period is correctly classified.
8. As at January 2015 persons working with the public transport operator are being classified with the private sector. Throughout 2014, such persons were classified with the public sector.
