

Provisional estimates for 2014 indicate that Gozo's contribution to national Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at market prices accounted to 5.1 per cent, or €409.9 million.

Gross Value Added (GVA) for the region of Malta increased by 4.9 per cent in 2014, while that for Gozo increased by 7.3 per cent (Table 1).

Gross Value Added profile

The majority of the industries in Gozo registered increases when compared to the previous year. The main increases resulted in economic activities relating to information and communication (J), and professional, scientific, technical, administrative and support service activities (M and N). Decreases were recorded in the industries comprising real estate (L), financial and insurance (K) activities. The contribution of the private sector in Gozo accounted to 74.2 per cent of the total GVA. An analysis of the contributions to Gross Value Added by industry and by region (NUTS 3) is illustrated in Charts 1 and 2.

Chart 3 illustrates developments in GDP per capita at market prices for the regions of Malta and Gozo respectively. It also compares Gozo's GDP in relation to the total economy.

Population, employment and unemployment

The total population in Malta increased by 1.0 per cent, whereas that in Gozo increased marginally (Table 3).

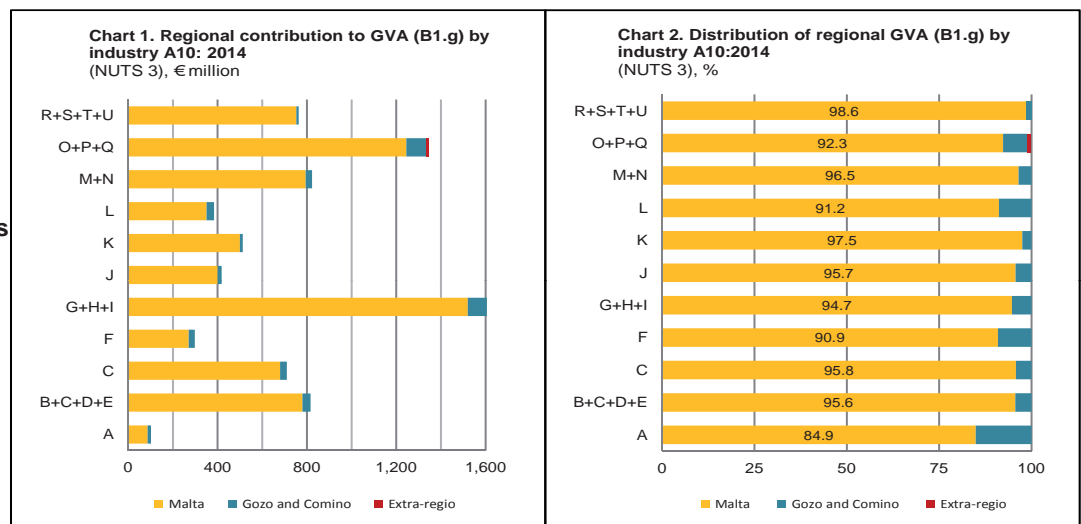
Almost all industries in Gozo registered an increase in employment during 2014. Main increases resulted in professional, scientific, technical, administrative and support services (M and N) and information and communication (J) activities. Drops in employment were mainly recorded in mining and quarrying (B) and water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation (E) activities (Table 4).

The number of unemployed persons (Parts I and II) decreased in both Malta and Gozo, by 5.7 and 1.2 per cent respectively (Table 5) ■

Chart 3. Per capita regional GDP at market prices (NUTS 3)

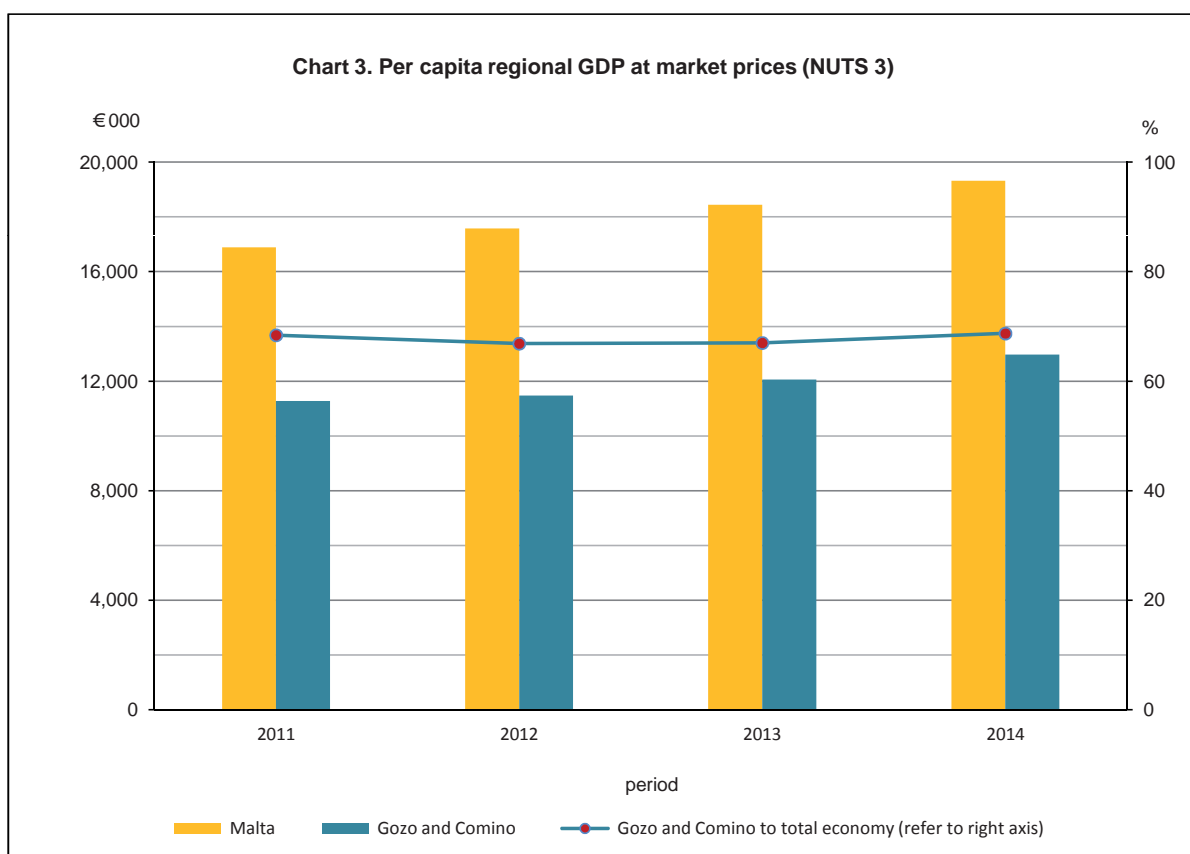

Methodological Notes:

1. The estimates of the national Gross Value Added (MALTA) correspond to the news release Gross Domestic Product: Q3/2015 - NR224/2015. The top-down method is applied to estimate the regional Gross Value Added (GVA) breakdown for the private sector. The Regional Statistics Unit is reviewing the estimation procedures and is targeting revisions that will amend the regional profile of various industries within the private sector. These adjustments are intended to improve the regional estimation methods in line with the residence principle (i.e. allocating the GVA to the region where the producer unit is resident).

Changes will include:

- The further alignment of regional employment data in accordance to the definitions of the residence principle; and
- Estimations based on the mixed method, using a wider array of data sources intended to enhance the quality of regional statistics.

2. Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is an estimate of the value of goods and services produced in the economy over a period of time. GDP is estimated at current prices using the Production Approach, aggregating the output of the various productive sectors net of the cost of intermediate inputs.

3. All data in this News Release is in line with the European System of Accounts (ESA 2010) (ISBN 978-92-79-31242-7) and the manual on Regional Accounts Methods (ISBN 978-92-79-32357-7). The European System of National and Regional Accounts is an internationally compatible accounting framework for a systematic and detailed description of a total economy (whether this is a region, a country, or a group of countries), its components, and its relations with other total economies. Regional accounts are a regional specification of the corresponding accounts of the total economy. 4. The nomenclature of territorial units for statistics (NUTS) provides a single, uniform breakdown of the economic territory of the European Union. The NUTS is the territorial classification for the compilation of regional accounts. The economic territory of a country can be divided into regional territories and the extra-regio territory. For the purpose of regional accounts, MALTA is divided as follows:

The regional territory includes the region that is part of the geographic territory of a country and any free zones, including bonded warehouses and factories under customs control in the region. The extra-regio territory is made up of parts of the economic territory of a country that cannot be attached directly to a single region.

5. Data users must be aware that the industrial activities of General Government are spread over 19 different NACE categories (at A88 divisions) and include local councils and extra-budgetary units that are financially dependent on Government. NACE 84 is the largest category and, in terms of Gross Value Added, represented approximately 36.10 per cent of the General Government sector in 2014.

6. Total employment (Table 4) includes full-time employees, employees with a part-time job as their primary occupation, and self-employed. Employment and unemployment data is based on administrative records of the Employment and Training Corporation (ETC).

7. Those registering under Part 1 of the unemployment register are new job seekers who have left school, re-entrants into the labour market, and job losers who have been made redundant by their former employers. Those registering under Part 2 of the unemployment register are workers who have been dismissed from work due to disciplinary action, left work out of their own free will, refused work or training opportunities, or were struck off the register after an inspection by the Law Enforcement personnel.

8. This News Release is being published at NACE Rev. 2 at A*10. Data should be considered as provisional. Employment data provided by the ETC for the period 2011-2014 was subject to revision.
