Provisional data indicate that the industrial producer price index in March 2016 decreased by 1.62 per cent when compared to the corresponding month in previous year.

## Industrial Producer Price Indices: March 2016

Cut-off date:  
21 April 2016

### Annual comparison

On an annual basis, the industrial producer price index went down by 1.62 per cent when compared to 2015. The downturn resulted from price decreases in energy (14.02 per cent). On the other hand, prices within capital, consumer and intermediate goods rose by 0.73, 0.35 and 0.01 per cent respectively.

Producer prices for the domestic market decreased by 3.33 per cent, mainly on account of a drop in prices for energy (14.02 per cent). Price increases were recorded in intermediate goods (1.59 per cent), consumer goods (1.51 per cent) and capital goods (1.10 per cent).

Non-domestic prices decreased by 0.39 per cent. This was due to drops registered both within the euro area (0.58 per cent) and the non-euro area (0.28 per cent) (Table 2).

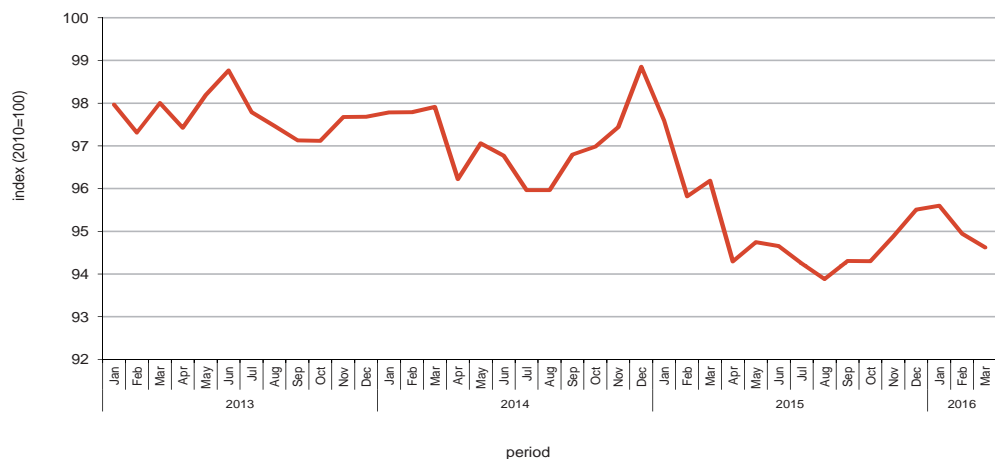
### Monthly comparison

During March, the producer price index for total industry declined by 0.34 per cent. Prices for intermediate goods decreased by 0.64 per cent and by 0.18 per cent within consumer goods. Energy and capital goods prices remained constant.

Domestic market prices increased by 0.04 per cent. This was due to a rise in prices within consumer goods by 0.12 per cent.

Prices for the non-domestic market decreased by 0.61 per cent. This was due to drops registered both within the euro area (0.09 per cent) and the non-euro area (0.91 per cent) (Table 3) ■

## Methodological Notes

1. The industrial producer price index monitors the changes in selling prices of all leading products within a sample of 83 large enterprises which account for over 80 per cent of the total industrial turnover.
2. The pricing point for the monthly price collection is the 15th day of the month or the nearest trading day prior to that date.
3. The methodologies and guidelines used are set by Eurostat and the International Monetary Fund (IMF).
4. For the purpose of calculating the euro area export figures, only transactions between enterprises in countries within the euro area are considered domestic. The euro area includes Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Estonia (from 2011), Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Latvia (from 2014), Lithuania (from 2015), Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, and Spain. Transactions among resident enterprises are considered "domestic".
5. The objective of Main Industrial Groupings (MIGs) is to provide an activity breakdown of industry using the internationally recognised classification of economic activities (NACE Rev. 2 Sections B, C, D and E) in terms of demand-based products: intermediate goods, energy, capital goods, durable consumer goods, and non-durable consumer goods. These regroup NACE Sections B to E and cover the following economic activities: quarrying, manufacturing, electricity and water.
6. Figures for the last three months are to be considered provisional and subject to revision. However, in exceptional cases, back data may also be revised.
7. The figures in this news release are unadjusted.
