

In the third quarter of 2016, sea transport between Malta and Gozo registered increases compared to the corresponding quarter of 2015.

## Sea Transport between Malta and Gozo: Q3/2016

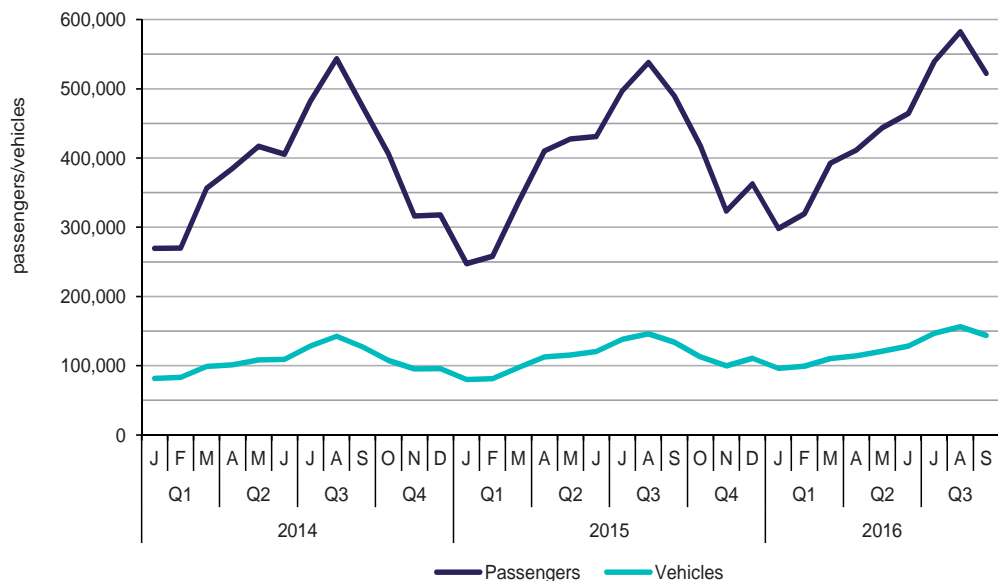
A total of 1,643,898 passengers travelled between Malta and Gozo during the third quarter this year, up by 7.8 per cent when compared to the corresponding quarter in 2015. The highest number of passengers was recorded in August amounting to 582,264 or 35.4 per cent of the total for the quarter. The number of vehicles increased by 6.9 per cent, totalling 446,890 (Tables 1 and 2).

The number of trips amounted to 6,324, an increase of 8.6 per cent over the same period in 2015 (Table 1). The majority of trips took place in August, 2,178 or 34.4 per cent of total trips for the quarter (Table 2).

### January-September

During this period, passenger traffic originating from Ċirkewwa was busiest on Friday and Saturday, whereas highest numbers from Mġarr were recorded on Sunday and Saturday (Chart 4) ■

Chart 2. Sea transport to and from Malta and Gozo: Quarter 3

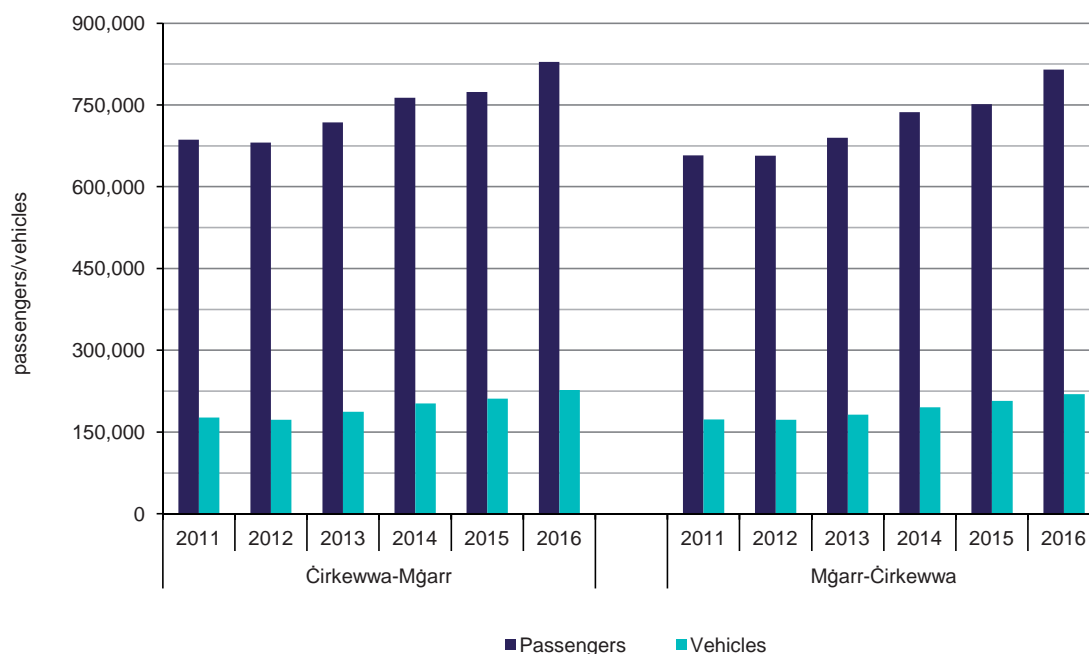

Chart 3. Vehicles to and from Malta and Gozo by day of the week: January-September

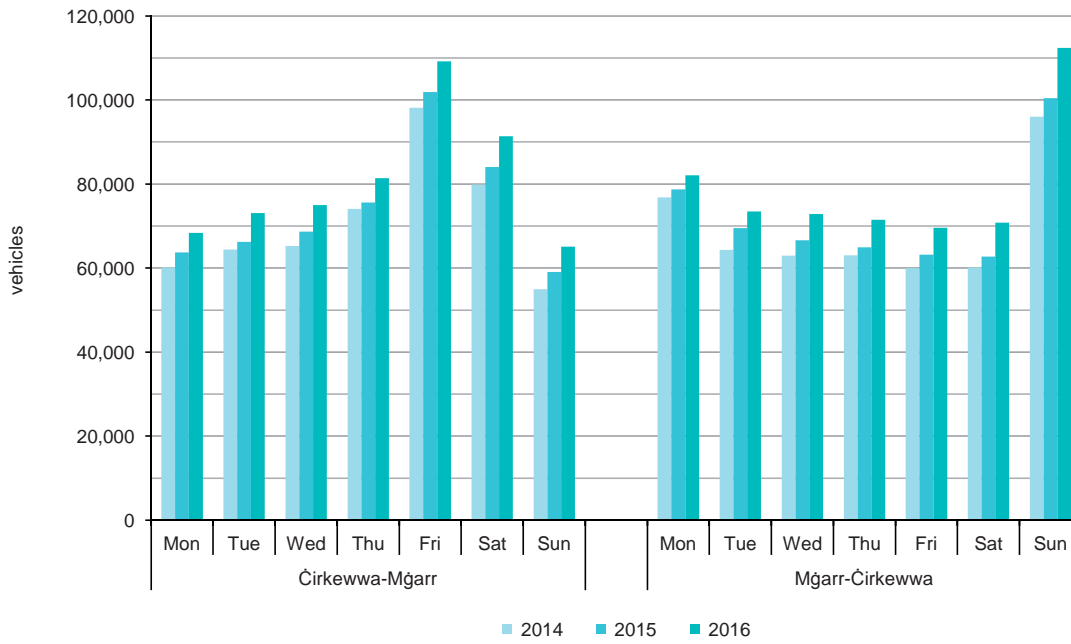
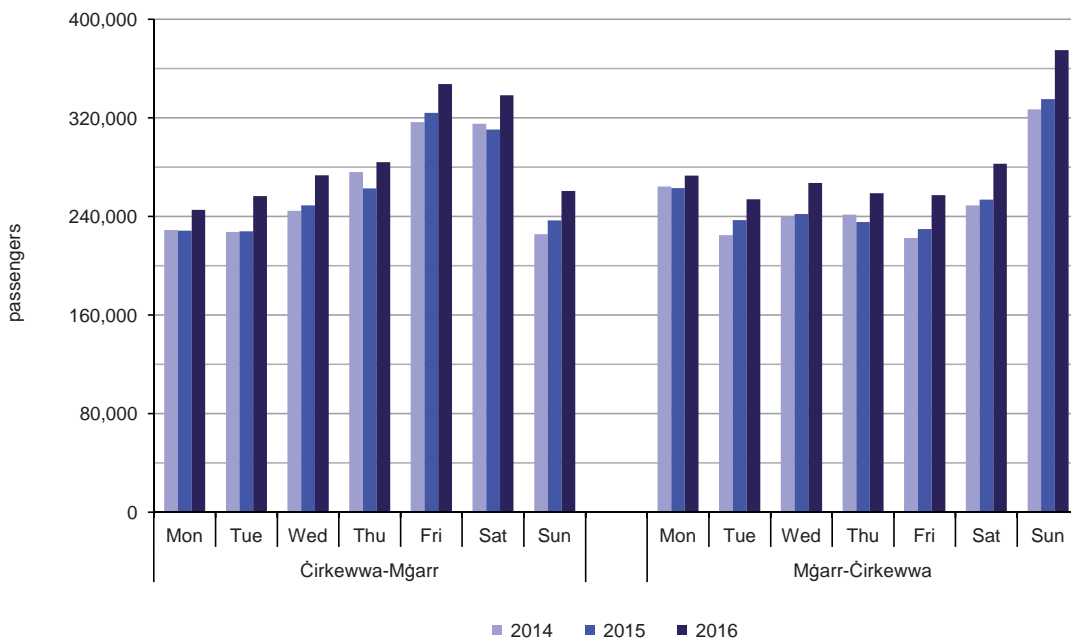


Chart 4. Passengers to and from Malta and Gozo by day of the week: January-September



## Methodological Notes

1. The source for the data included in this release is administrative information provided by the Gozo Channel Co. Ltd.
2. The table below illustrates the passenger and vehicle capacity of each Gozo Channel vessel:

### Carrying capacity

Vessel	Vehicles	Passengers
MV Gaudos	72	900
MV Malita	138	900
MV Ta' Pinu	138	900

Note: MV Gaudos was out of service for docking purposes between the 06/01/2016 - 27/01/2016.

3. Data for passengers comprise: foot and vehicle passengers and vehicle drivers.
4. Different approaches are applied for the collection of data at the Mġarr and Ċirkewwa Harbours, respectively. While the data source for the Mġarr side is the Automated Ticketing System (ATS), data for the Ċirkewwa side is dependent on the manual clicking system.
5. The data are not normally subject to revision.
