In February 2017, the industrial producer price index registered a decrease of 0.38 per cent when compared to the same month last year.

## Industrial Producer Price Indices: February 2017

Cut-off date:  
22 March 2017

### Annual comparison

When compared to February 2016, the industrial producer price index went down by 0.38 per cent. This was due to a drop of 1.41 per cent in the prices of the intermediate goods category. This was however mitigated by an increase of 0.65 per cent in the capital goods prices and by 0.61 per cent in the consumer goods prices. No changes occurred in the energy sector.

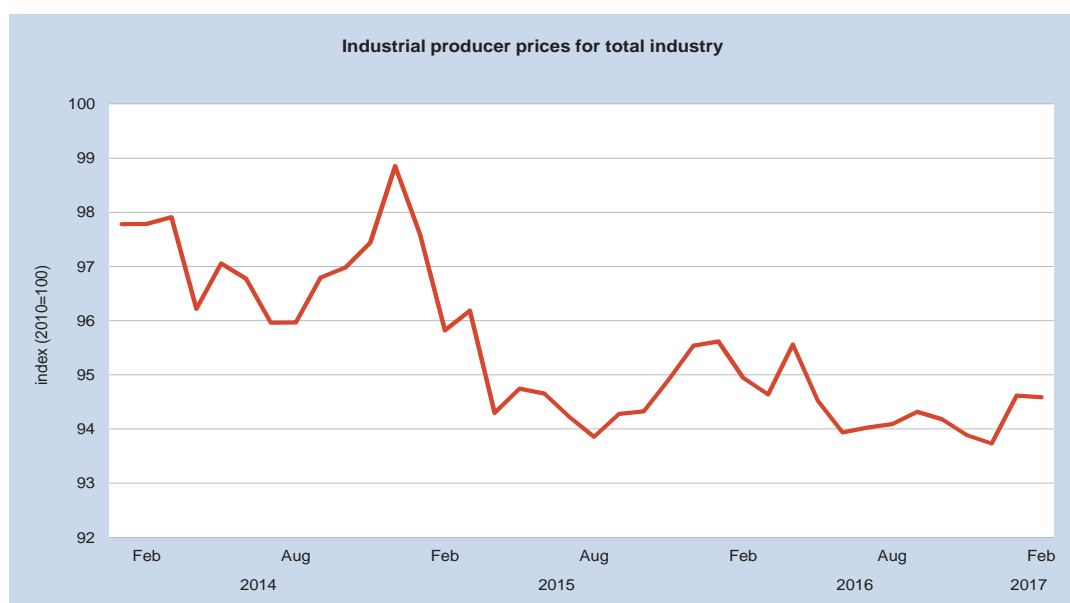
Industrial producer prices for the domestic market increased by 2.43 per cent. Price increases were recorded in the consumer goods (5.55 per cent) and intermediate goods (1.83 per cent) sectors. No changes were recorded in the energy and capital goods prices.

Non-domestic prices fell by 2.35 per cent due to decreases of 2.35 per cent for goods destined to the euro area and 2.33 per cent for goods exported to the non-euro area (Table 2).

### Monthly comparison

In February 2017, the producer price index for total industry decreased by 0.03 per cent over the previous month. This was due to a decrease in the prices of intermediate goods (0.07 per cent). Mitigating this drop was a rise of 0.07 per cent in the prices of consumer goods. No price changes were registered in the energy and capital goods categories.

Domestic market prices did not register any price changes. However, prices for the non-domestic market decreased by 0.07 per cent. This was mainly due to a drop of 0.23 per cent in the prices of goods destined to the euro area (Table 3) ■

## Methodological Notes

1. The industrial producer price index monitors the changes in selling prices of all leading products within a sample of 83 large enterprises which account for over 80 per cent of the total industrial turnover.
2. The pricing point for the monthly price collection is the 15th day of the month or the nearest trading day prior to that date.
3. The methodologies and guidelines used are set by Eurostat and the International Monetary Fund (IMF).
4. For the purpose of calculating the euro area export figures, only transactions between enterprises in countries within the euro area are considered domestic. The euro area includes Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Estonia (from 2011), Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Latvia (from 2014), Lithuania (from 2015), Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, and Spain. Transactions among resident enterprises are considered “domestic”.
5. The objective of Main Industrial Groupings (MIGs) is to provide an activity breakdown of industry using the internationally recognised classification of economic activities (NACE Rev. 2 Sections B, C, D and E) in terms of demand-based products: intermediate goods, energy, capital goods, durable consumer goods, and non-durable consumer goods. These regroup NACE Sections B to E and cover the following economic activities: quarrying, manufacturing, electricity and water.
6. Figures for the last three months are to be considered provisional and subject to revision. However, in exceptional cases, back data may also be revised.
